



Remote Ticket Entry





April is National Safe Digging Month and April 22-27 is Locator Safety Awareness Week.

NC811 presentation given by Tami Stout.

We discussed locate ticket statistics and the average request plus updates. Make sure you talk with your contractors to determine that they are not updating unnecessary tickets or calling in projects too far in advance that will have them updated numerous time prior to permit issuance or before the work begins.

Ann spoke about the possibility of going to a project ticket (30 day). Everyone give this thought and come back next month to discuss.

Enhanced remote ticket entry or RTE will be able to give more information to everyone who participates. You will have the ability to add maps/photographs.

Survey tickets do require a response. As discussed previously, the utility provider is responsible for indicating utility presence in one of three ways; by marking in the field, by providing maps, or by providing access to maps.

The Piedmont/Duke live line strike was a successful event. Ronya & Dan are very appreciative of everyone who attended.

Piedmont Natural Gas had over seventy damages for March. City of Charlotte had twenty, eleven water service hits, six mains, and three sewer. Blythe had six damages.

Piedmont Natural Gas has a plan in place to help with the influx of three-hour tickets.

We discussed creating a spreadsheet with local supervisor names to keep from have to call district managers. Tami Stout will be emailing and asking for names and information.
