Update of Activities: February 2020



- 258 Cases heard since initiated in 2014.
- A memorandum of understanding in place with Deputy Attorney General for legal counsel to the UDPRB.
- \$200,000 being billed out to top 50 NC 811 transmission recipients.
- A memorandum of understanding in place with Department of Commerce for placement of funds received.
- ***Reminder: Facility Owners, Excavators and Notification Center are the ONLY parties that may be named in a complaint.***
- NC 811 providing research to all complaints received after October 1, 2019.
- To date, 77 recommendations have resulted in orders being issued by NC Utilities Commission.
- Once funding is received, next steps are to secure administration through an rfp process and to develop a dedicated UDPRB web page.

Discussion about code 32.

Discussed Locate Resolution Partnership Committee and destroyed marks from December. Update tickets-one day work orders-make sure to update the necessary stuff.

Google is starting installs again in Charlotte area in the spring. Will be doing roughly 10,000 feet per month. May/June/July will be doing more. Raleigh area is going to be busier. Will be doing micro trenching.

Piedmont Natural Gas-sixty-two damages for the month.

City of Charlotte-they had nineteen water services hit, eight sewer services, four forced sewer mains, and nine water mains struck. They hit fifteen utilities.

PRG-Charter had twenty-seven damages.

Duke-Verizon in the Ballantyne area struck Duke. Need a good contact.

Discussion about who is responsible if utilities are not located on new installations. Master contractor may not have turned the project back over to utility. Mapping may not be complete.

Metrolina Landscaping-Cut one AT&T line that was not marked. Cut one Spectrum line that was not marked.

Sanders Utility-they struck two water lines that were not marked.

Next meeting is March 25 at Piedmont Natural Gas.
