Meeting called to order by Brian Morehouse-NC811

Meeting started at 10:12 AM

Brian Morehouse-NC811 showed up at 10 am and was running late

Brian Morehouse was representing NC811 for Tami Stout.

Before meeting started there were a number of complaints about locate issues, Brian Morehouse suggested to all to have the presentation and then at the end to go over these issues and we would get together with those companies that located in the area and look over these complaints.

Brian Morehouse, Western Region Education Liaison, gave the March 2019 Presentation.

Gave the overall stats for this area for the Month of February 2019 compared to the Month of February 2018, gave the YTD totals. A short video was shown to the group in regards to calling 8111 Before You Dig!! The video showed an incident that involved a gas company and what can happen when someone doesn't Call 811 Before You Dig!!!

Brian Morehouse told the group that there are openings throughout the year if anyone is interested in having 811 come in and speak to their organization about 811, when, why and how to contact 811. Also, went over the new 811 app, encourage all to download the app. Went over with the group on how to navigate the app and showing them how to get to the Damage Prevention portion of the app.

Brian Morehouse went over with the group that if they have any issues to make sure to reach out to him with those issues and please don't wait to the meeting to address them. Reason-he doesn't want to have them waiting two or three weeks to get an issues resolved, he would like to jump on it ASAP

April will be National Safe Digging Month, event will be held at 1770 Shopton Rd, Charlotte, NC, Piedmont Natural Gas/Duke Energy will be handling this program. 90 People will be able to register for this event and should get with Ronya Nabors of PNG.

Mentions that there were around 89 people whom attended the State UCC Meeting on March 12th 2019 at Dominion Energy, Raleigh, NC

Sam Gonzales-Co Chairman UCC- Windstream- spoke to the group and wanted to make sure that we talk about the locate issues at the end of the meeting, we went through the presentation and did as stated.

There was some talk about how locates were being done in the area. It was brought up by Fiber Compass and ULCS that they are having issues with getting locates done in a timely manner. The companies that located these utilities were in attendance and met after the meeting to go over these problems and find a way to communicate and get these located done properly. Cell #'s were handed out to those that needed them to get in touch with the locate supervisors and make them aware of the issues at hand.

Positive Response needs to have an actual field rep and not a 1-800 number listed, people are complaining that they don't have a good contact given to them on the Positive Response. Members stated that they have a number that no one ever answers or if so they know nothing about the project that is being worked.

Introduction of all of those in attendance, discussion roundtable took place as the group spoke more about locates issues within the area. As the numbers show, this area is very busy and work load is heavy. There was concern that the locates are not being done properly because there may not be enough staffed by the locate companies. Many concerns over Positive Response being coded as the Locator is stating that they have contacted the caller (Contractor) but no one is actually doing any type of responding.

Town of Mathews- Large number of projects are coming in with the weather clearing up. Facing many challenges in getting locates done on time. That issue was addressed with Heath and USIC that were in attendance.

ULCS- Very bust and see work staying heavy through the summer of 2019 with Duke Energy releasing major work around the Mecklenburg area.

Group was told that 811 T-Shirts were in and that Tami Stout would be getting with those that ordered them over the next week.

Brian Morehouse will be looking into locate issues reported to him on how locates are called companies.

Next meeting will be in April 2019
