WHITE PAINT OR FLAGS ON A JOB SITE ELIMINATES GUESSWORK.

Sometimes it is difficult for excavators to relay the exact location of their dig sites to the one call center. Even clear and accurate information relayed in writing or verbally to one person may not be clear to another. With white lining, locators have excavation information on paper, and also have a clearly marked excavation area. White lining helps to avoid misinterpretation and allows for more accurate locates.

Meeting opened by chair, Roger Richards at 10:02 am.

Safety information and safety minute given by Shuhurah Lee, City of Charlotte.

Attendees made self-introductions. (28 present)

Roger Richards spoke briefly about staying safe in the rain.

The NC/SC State UCC Conference was the first week of May and was well planned, well attended, and highly recommended if you have not gone before. 2019 will be hosted by the state of SC in Myrtle Beach. More information will be forthcoming.

Review of the minutes from the April meeting. No changes or additions.

NC811 presentation given by Tami Stout. (See NCUCC.org for presentation information)

Discussion about why the uptick in three hour tickets. (200% and 100% increases). Possible causes weather and not using the destroyed marks ticket correctly. If you do not get a response (or a positive response that makes no sense) please contact NC811 for assistance. As always, remember to take pictures/video of your job site to protect yourself.

Remember that there are underground utility lines that are not part of 811. There are private lines as well. (This includes on commercial properties) You may end up hiring a private line locator to locate private lines-be sure to cover all your bases. Communicate with the property owner and the excavator.

Several people are seeing Code 80 on projects that should not have them. *Call 811 (or just call Tami) and let us try to assist.

White lining discussion after video presentation. White lining (as long as it matches the scope of the ticket) eliminates guesswork. There is a video on the NC811 website, as well as a handout to share. White lining is required if you cannot adequately describe the area to be located. This video incorporates CGA best practices.

Next meeting will be at the Town of Matthews, June 27.
