





Meeting opened by Chair, Jamie Yow at 2:02 pm.

Welcome and self-introductions.

Safety moment from Jamie Yow.

Reviewed minutes from the previous meeting.

NCDOT-

No changes from previous meeting.

Spectrum-

Lowell Ridge subdivision, Vass/Camille Drive, and Shepherds Trail in Aberdeen. All subdivision work.

Piedmont Natural Gas-

Airport Road 1100' of 4". Valley Road-200' of 2" and Southern Pines 1700' on Carlyle Street at the new elementary school. Magnolia will have 800' of 2". It has already been let to the contractors.

Dixie Pipeline-

Finishing the right of way and main mowing. Should be done by the end of November.

Southern Pines-

Wisconsin storm drainpipe has been completed. It is currently drivable until the overlay goes on. Working on 300 NE Broad adding parking spots. Add two more blocks of one way on Broad Street (laundromat)

Moore County-

Water (sewer) done in subdivisions. Laurel Road is completed. Several developer projects ongoing. East Moore Phase 4 water-hope to get started soon. Landfill is running out of space (cell 5). Cell 6 is coming by unknown where to go when it comes time to cell seven. FYI, Megan is leaving Moore County and will be working in Pinehurst.

Windstream-

Working in Aberdeen, phase one, fiber overlay project. Highway 5/11. Mostly aerial work (Globe).
