

Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting

April 10, 2018

Meeting Time: The Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting was called to order by Ann Rushing with NC 811 at 1:30 P.M.

Total Members Present: There were a total of 15 members present at the April Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting according to the sign in sheet.

New Business: Ann Rushing with NC 811 introduced Kevin Smith who is replacing Jeff Bartley who entered into retirement this month. Kevin comes to NC 811 from Ansco. His telephone number will be the same one Jeff had. Ann also introduced Tami Stout with NC 811. Jeff McDuffie with Randolph EMC informed us that Mike Hodges with REMC is retiring after more than 40 years with the company.

Ongoing and upcoming projects: D.J. with the City of Archdale said they are still dealing with issues on acquiring right-of-way for some of their projects. Jamie with NCDOT has some resurfacing projects coming up on 421 and 220 Business and a number of secondary roads. Aaron with NCDOT said his group is building Brookwood Acres Dr. and doing a lot of storm drain replacements in the county. Keith with PNG has a 4" natural gas main going in on Gumtree Rd. and is also working on the 4" natural gas main relocation for the Highway 64 by-pass. Shannon with SEC, contractor for PNG said they are working on random natural gas services in the county.

NC811: Tami Stout went over the NC 811 narrative, reporting on the ticket and transmission data, the county ticket volume and the top callers for the month. Also, Locator safety awareness week is coming up giving us a chance to show appreciation. Tami pointed out that Ingles stores are putting NC 811 safety messages on an insert in their circulars being distributed in NC, SC, and GA. These will be going out from April-August. Lowes and Home Depot will be sharing the 811 safe digging information on their tree wraps. Tami also filled us in on the upcoming Board and State UCC meetings.

Comments: Ann would like to see more contractors attending the UCC meetings such as Heath, Century Link, Randolph Telephone, and Duke Energy.

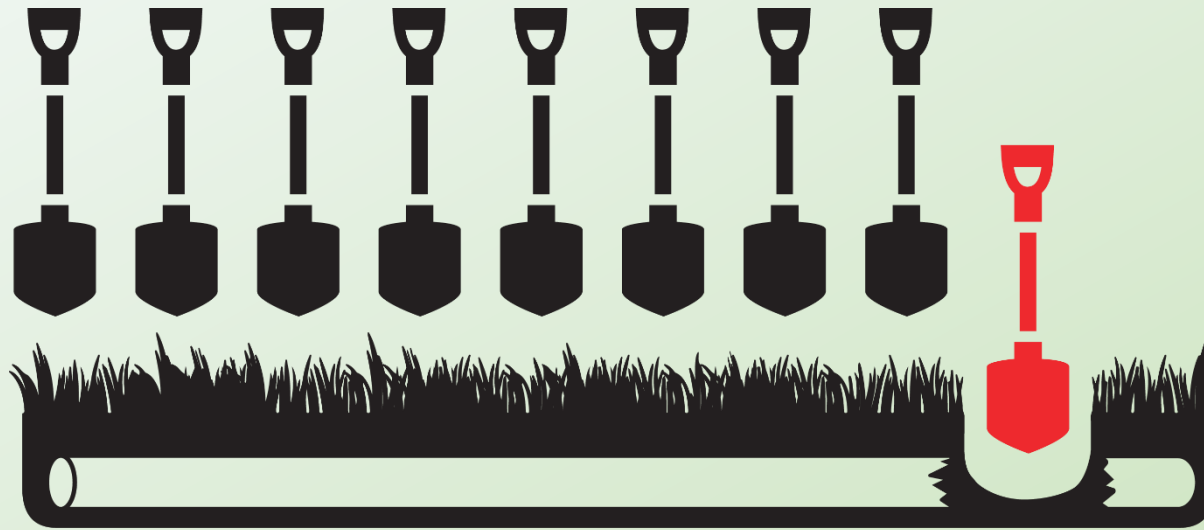

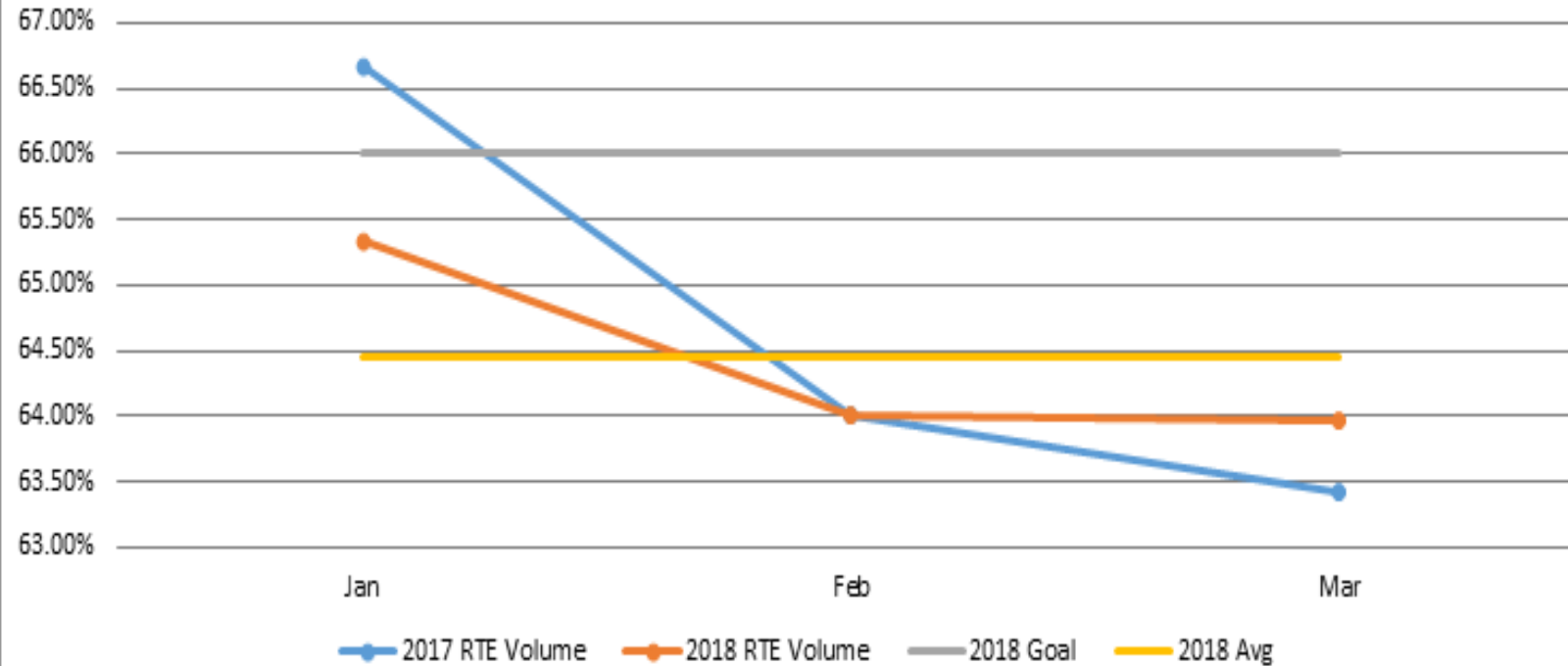
