Meeting Time: The Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting was called to order by John Conner with NC 811 at 1:30 p.m. and introductions were made.

Total Members Present: There were a total of 11 members present at the March Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting according to the sign in sheet.

Upcoming Projects and New Business: D.J. with the City of Archdale said they are dealing with real estate issues on a couple of their upcoming projects. Lee with the NCDOT said they have two bridge projects, one on Carl Allred Rd. and one on Brantley Gordon Rd. Jimmy with NCDOT said he has a couple of Pipe replacements, but mainly routine maintenance. Daniel with Heath Consultants attended for the first time, and made himself available to answer any questions or address concerns. John Connor with NC 811 is making his transition and will take over from Jeff in April when Jeff retires. Keith with PNG said they are currently on projects in the area on Gumtree Rd installing a 4" main, and also preparing for a relocate on Old Cox Rd. for the NCDOT as part of the Hwy. 64 by-pass.

Damages: D.J. with the City of Archdale said they had suffered some overhead damage caused by a bucket truck, and Terry with PRG also reported some overhead damage from a motor vehicle accident.

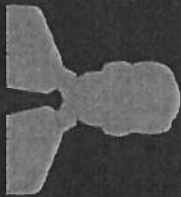

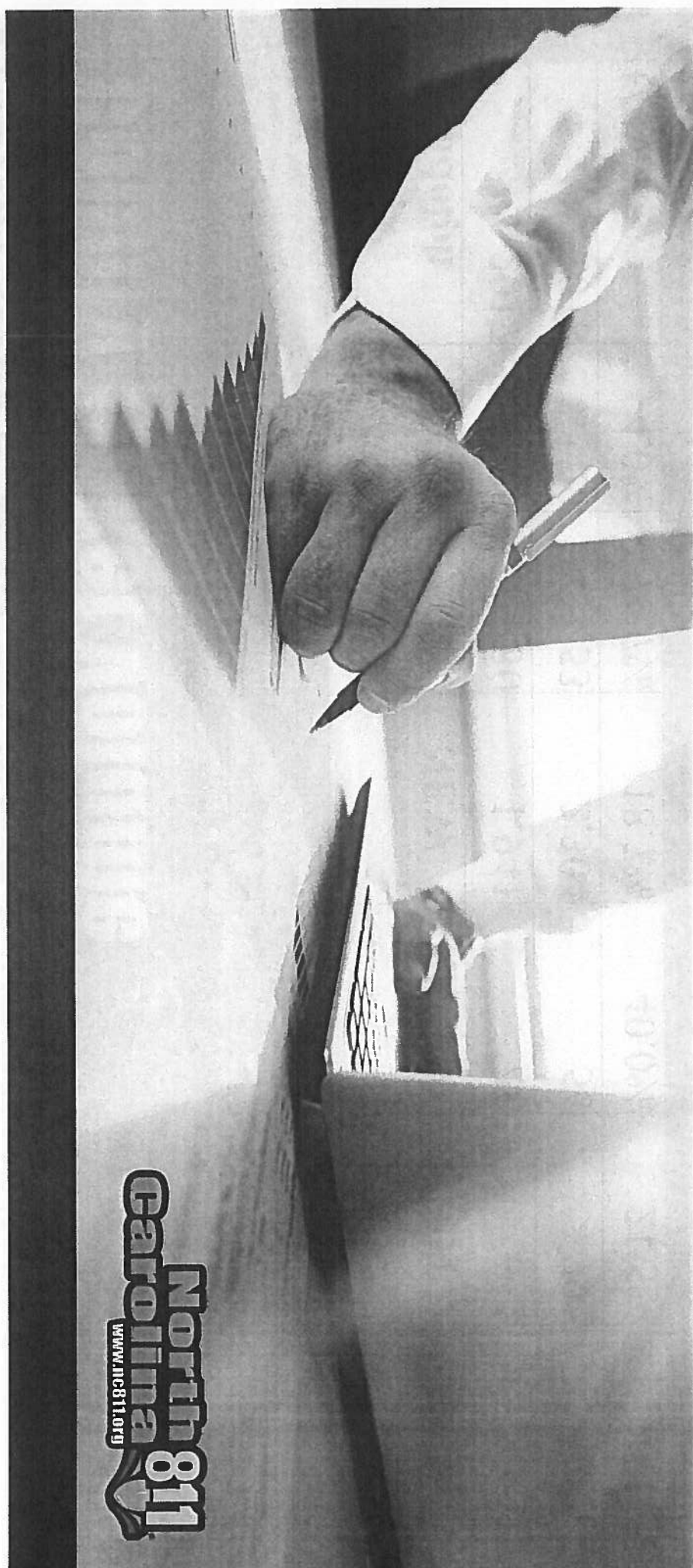
