

Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting

October 10, 2017

Meeting time: The Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting was called to order by Shad Brady at 1:30 P.M.

Total Members Present: There were a total of 10 members present at the October Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting according to the sign in sheet.

Current concerns: Shad Brady, RTMC, spoke on the number of contractors working without a ticket, and asked what measures can be taken to prevent this. He has made contact with these companies, but they continue to dig. Jeff Bartley with NC811 said that he would try to reach out to help resolve these issues.

David Owens with NCDOT told of seeing contractors digging before a ticket cleared, and Jeff explained how it's possible for the ticket to be good before the 3 days if everyone populates a positive response.

Shad spoke of receiving tickets that RTMC locators cannot find, and Jeff said it would be good if everyone would white line to avoid this confusion. Jeff said 811 is always ready to assist if they can.

Jamie with NCDOT spoke of contractors not letting anyone know they are working in an area then damaging facilities and leaving before anyone can find out who they were. Justin with NCDOT said they probably did not get an encroachment to work in the area.

Shad said it would be nice if more companies attended the UCC meetings to establish better working relationships.

Upcoming and In-Progress projects: Jamie with NCDOT said the Presnell St. Project would be re-let in November. The Asheboro By-Pass is on-going.

Damages: No one had damages to report.

NC811: Jeff spoke on and had a video about the dangers of directional drilling and what could happen if a natural gas line was cross bored through a sewer line.

Jeff covered his monthly handout from NC 811 which is attached and shows the statewide ticket and transmission data, and ticket volume. The handout also has important safety information and upcoming events.

Meeting adjourned: The Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting adjourned at 2:30 P.M.

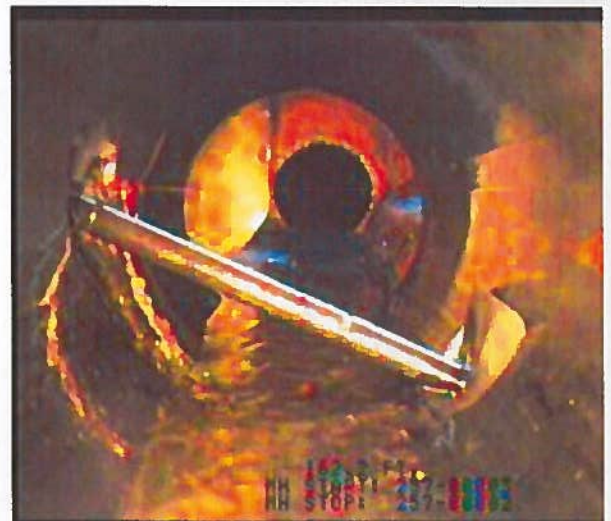
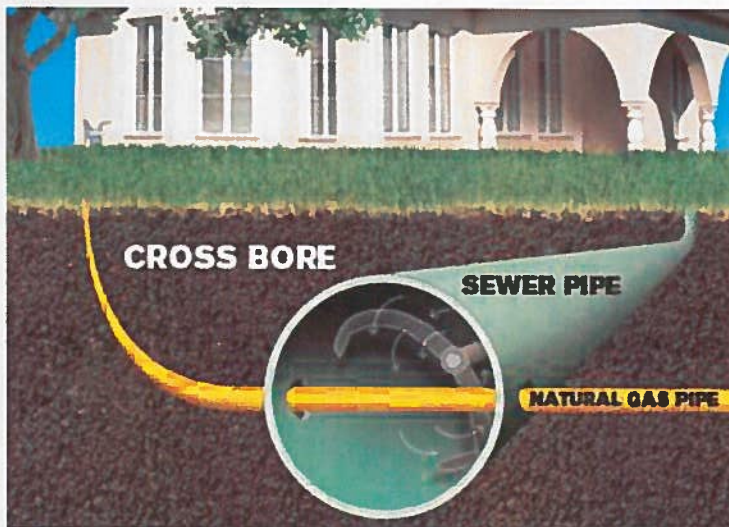
