Meeting Time: The Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting was called to order by Jeff Bartley with NC 811 at 1:30 p.m. and introductions were made.

Total Members Present: There were a total of 12 members present at the February Randolph County Utility Coordinating Meeting according to the sign in sheet.

Upcoming projects: The City of Asheboro is recouping from water main breaks and they have some industrial projects coming up with a large animal hospital, Fibertex, and at the old Goodyear plant. One residential project off of Hub Morris Rd. The City of Randleman has two water projects going out for bid. Lee with NCDOT said the Foushee Rd. project is complete and conditions are very wet right now for work. Aaron with NCDOT said they are continuing with storm drain replacement, and also a project building Brookwood Dr. off of Highway 311.

Keith with PNG has a project on Gumtree Rd. off of Spero Rd. and said PNG has two crews in town repairing gas leaks. The relocation project for the 64 by-pass is continuing on Old Cox Rd. Rob Sledge with SEC, contractor for PNG, explained that an increase will be seen in locate tickets for the leak repair projects. He said as much white lining will be done as possible.

Damages: There were none to report this month, however Don with the City of Randleman reported some concerns he has had with tickets for gas locates. Much discussion took place about Heath Consultants the new contractor locating gas lines for PNG. Judy with PNG will ask a manager about getting a Heath Representative to attend the next meeting to answer any questions and see that any concerns are resolved satisfactorily.

NC811: John Conner went over the attached NC 811 monthly narrative, touching on the State and County wide ticket and transmission data, and ticket volume. He explained the difference in tickets for Destroyed marks, and Three Hour Tickets, and when each is to be used. He pointed out that we now have the ability to

create a link to NC 811 on our Company websites. John also made note of the upcoming Board and State UCC meetings.

Destroyed Marks & 3 Hour Tickets When to properly use each

DESTROYED MARKS

If locate marks have been destroyed, the excavator must contact NC811 to issue a Destroyed Marks ticket requesting a remark of the area from the original ticket. A Destroyed Marks ticket does not extend the life of ticket; it will expire the same day as the original locate request. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in case of destroyed marks.

3 HOUR TICKET

If an operator fails to respond to the positive response system, the excavator may proceed if there are no visible indications of a facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, such as a pole, marker, pedestal, meter, or valve. However, if the excavator is aware of or observes indications of an unmarked facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, the excavator shall not begin excavation or demolition until an additional call is made to the Notification Center detailing the facility and an arrangement is made for the facility to be marked by the operator within three hours from the time the additional call is received by the Notification Center. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in the case of destroyed marks.
