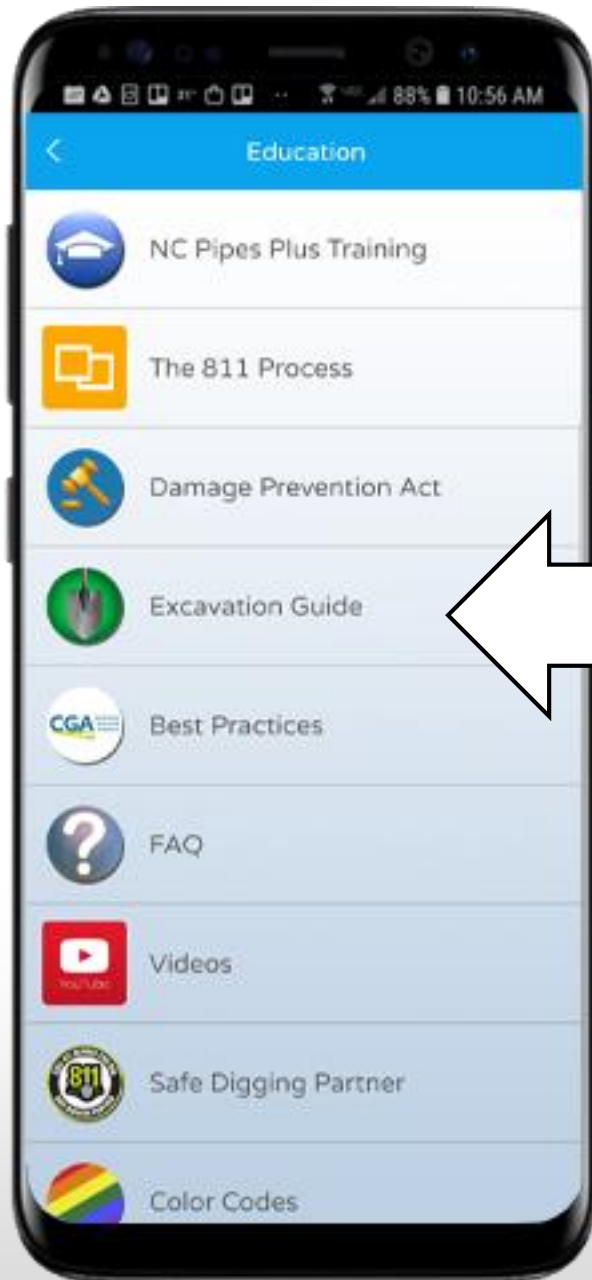

Richmond County UCC Meeting  
March 2019

Meeting opened by Chair, Ted Cagle at 10:01 am.

Level One Safety discussion.

The policy of horizontal drilling has changed in the last six months for Duke/PNG. Capture/retain must be removed to approved site. Bill of lading has to be kept. Using bentonite and water. It is expensive to remove. In case of frack out, there is a procedure in place to contain then have professionals come in to clean the site.

Self-introductions around the room.

Reminder about ticks. They are active in spring. Be careful while out in wooded/grassy areas. Check yourself. There has not been enough cold weather to get rid of some of the insects. Be aware of snakes as well.

NC811 presentation given by Tami Stout.

Piedmont Natural Gas-

River Road-boring at railroad tracks, right of way. Will be 24-hour day boring. It has to be continuous until completed. 12" casing for an 8" pipe. Sandhill Road-new regulator station will be removing old and returning the land to its natural state. Lot of transmission work and cathodic protection of systems. Mears, SEC, and North Star all doing work for PNG. Cascade is up and going. Retirements. Locating Hwy 74 business for DOT. They have to get lines located. Doing some encroachments, leak survey, and logging moving skimmers. \*PNG employee happened to drive by an area where a cable crew was working. Tickets had been called in and cleared, but the site needed a PNG employee on site while work was occurring. There was no one on the site that was bilingual. Crew could not understand that a PNG employee needed to be there. Make sure that at least one employee on your job sites is bilingual.

NCDOT-

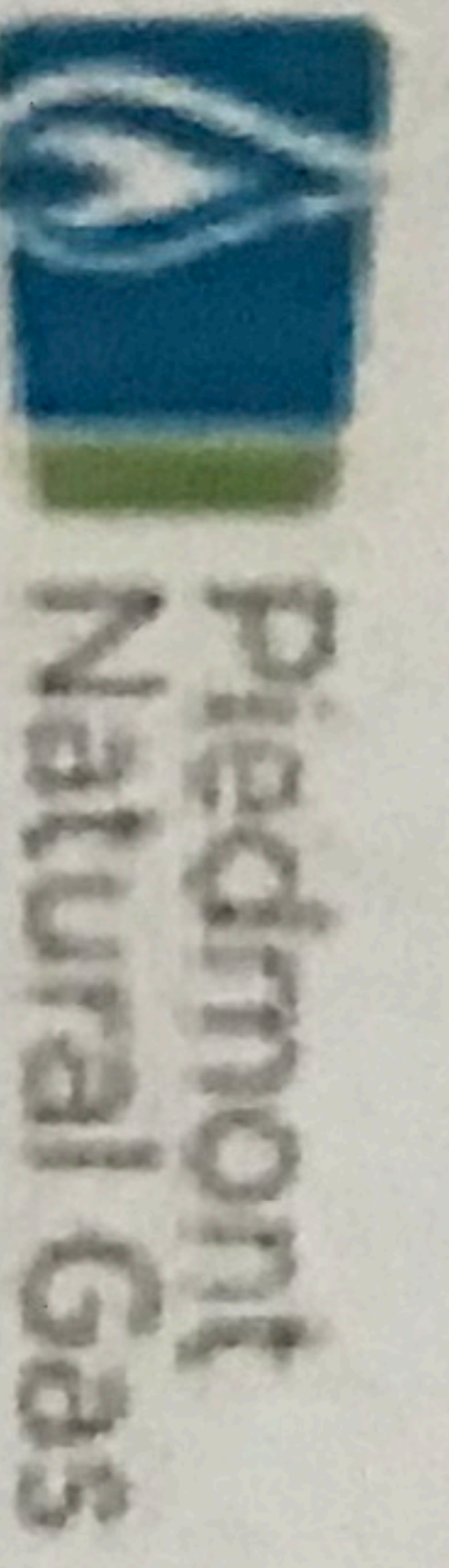
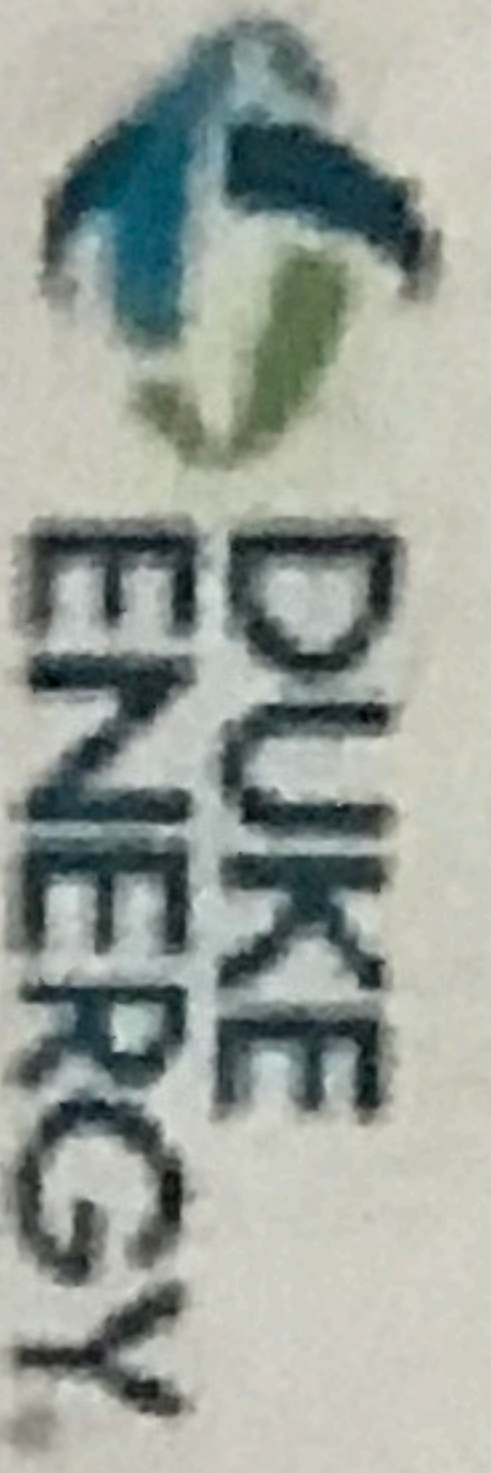
Project at Mill Stone Road-bridge is out. Culvert work ongoing. The 220 bypass, phases A & B are coming. Green Street project, Long Drive alternate, both projects are still on the books.

City of Rockingham-

Pump station replacement but no utilities in the area. Will move out of flood plain. Waste treatment plant, unknown extent of work.

Utilities Commission-

Business as usual. Reidsville had a mishap with an end cap. Fortunately, everything ended well.
