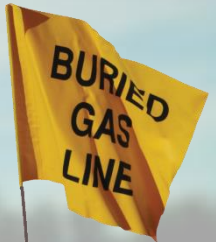

September 2017

Meeting opened at 10:03 by Chair, Ted Cagle.
Level one Safety briefing given by Chair, Ted Cagle.

NC811 presentation given by Tami Stout.

Question-Are retransmit tickets charged at the same price as original tickets?-Chad

Photos of gas line strikes and damage incidents reports used provided by Ted. Damage incidents require customer information, who struck the line, third party information, tickets, maps, pictures, etc. Hit kits.

PNG-

System strengthening project on Hawthorne. Should be completed within one week. Installing a 4" plastic line. Sandhill Road-put in new city gate to feed backside of Rockingham. 2000' of 8" line. Second phase-11,000' of 8" Eason Road cross US1 to river down Bird into Cascade. 600 lb transmission to 60 lb distribution. Also-lot of retirement work. Kill some old services. School Street, Entwhistle. PNG will be moving lines to get off Vulcan Property.

DC has been absorbed by SEC-both are owned by PowerTeam

PeeDee Electric-Annual meeting coming up in October.

City of Hamlet-Service work. Connection blew out on School Street. Worked about 6 hours + on a 6" New 6" water main on Lillian Lane. Will have to go thru City Council for approval. Global packaging doing expansion. No particulars known at the time. Benny advised he would be retiring at the end of October.

DOT-

HWY 1 project has kicked off. Iviva BioMass is meeting on site next week. Three bridge projects in Richmond County. Long drive alternate study is in process. Doing a study and public hearing soon.

Dixie Pipeline-

Hwy 1 near racetrack-will be replacing 180' of pipe and will be dropping the pipe down 6-8'. This is the only Dixie project in Richmond Co at this time.

The 220/73/74 bypass is on hold. No work going on at this time.
