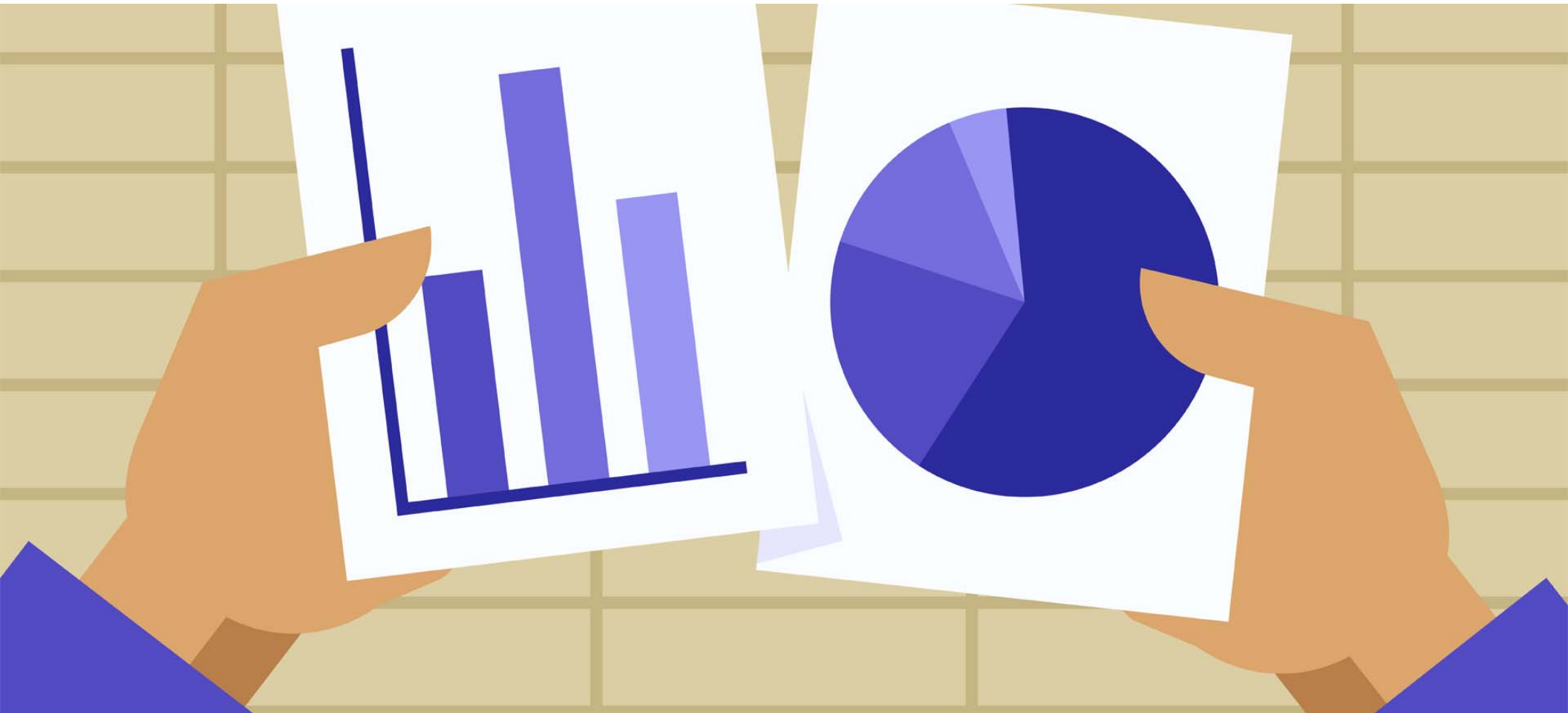

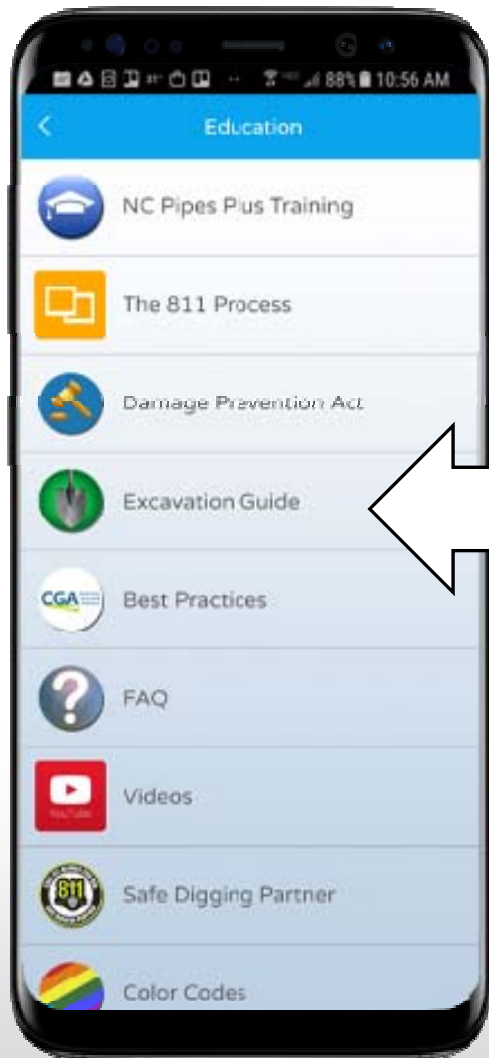

**Meeting Time:** The meeting was called to order by Howard Jordan at 10:03 a.m. Howard, then conducted a level one safety task assignment as to who would notify 911, etc, in the event of an emergency.

**Total Members Present:** There were Ten members.

**Recent Damages:** There were no significant damages that this group were aware, within Randolph, since our last meeting.

**New Business and Projects:**

Clint Foulks, with NCDOT, stated they have the following road surfaces. 14 Roads throughout Randolph County  
US29 From Guildford Co. line to 158/NC14 27 Roads throughout Rockingham County  
US29 Bus. From US29 to Freeway Drive  
NC 87 from Cox Street to the Virginia state line  
US220 Bus. From Main St. US 220  
NC 65 from Guilford County line to Sylvania Road  
NC 770 from US 220 to Lemons Street  
US311 / NC 135 from Young Road to Harrington Highway (NC770)  
14 Roads throughout Randolph County  
27 Roads throughout Rockingham County

Dylan Kirk, with USIC, stated as of April 4<sup>th</sup>, USIC will no longer be locating for Centurylink

Ann Stanfield, with Duke Energy, stated over the next few months they have several people retiring.

Don Langley, with NCDOT, stated they are having some issues, in having backflows, etc. being relocated on several job sites.

Jeffrey Lovings, with PNG, stated they are removing a valve from an underground vault and making the valve operational, above ground.

David Nylander, with Ditech, stated they are currently burying fiber for AT&T.

**NC811 Presentation:**

Kevin Smith gave the NC811 presentation and gave considerable time on the importance of contractors not updating a ticket until the twelfth day, having the locate request accurate in the description of the address, if white lining, do not include, locate entire property, and not to call in locates for area's which will not be worked immediately upon locates. Kevin also reviewed the NC811 app and went over key features of this app. He stressed the importance of having the "App" as one of the most important tools all utility personnel could have.

Kevin also asked contractors / companies not to request locate tickets for which the actual work will take place immediately. Several companies call / request locate tickets for projects that are months down the road.

**General Discussion:**

Group discussion then turned to the companies that are abusing the NC811 system by calling in several hundred locates and not working onsite until months down from the request.

**Meeting concluded after the general discussion. (above)**
