Update of Activities: February 2020



- 258 Cases heard since initiated in 2014.
- A memorandum of understanding in place with Deputy Attorney General for legal counsel to the UDPRB.
- \$200,000 being billed out to top 50 NC 811 transmission recipients.
- A memorandum of understanding in place with Department of Commerce for placement of funds received.
- ***Reminder: Facility Owners, Excavators and Notification Center are the ONLY parties that may be named in a complaint.***
- NC 811 providing research to all complaints received after October 1, 2019.
- To date, 77 recommendations have resulted in orders being issued by NC Utilities Commission.
- Once funding is received, next steps are to secure administration through an rfp process and to develop a dedicated UDPRB web page.

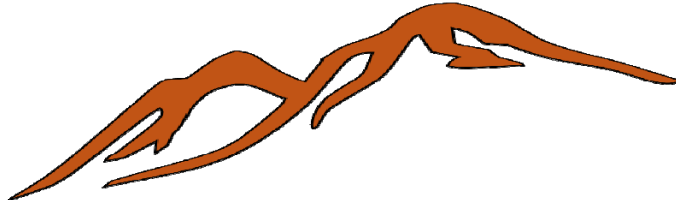

- **NC 811 / One Call** presentation was given by Brian Morehouse:
- **Attendance was** "VERY" low with only (2) people attending. There were bad storms within the area and others were unable to come due to rain and flooding in the area.
- NO issues with locates in the area reported.

Open Discussion Reports

- NC 811 / One Call – Brian provided us with the monthly 811 update. NC811 mentioned that they will come out on site to speak with crews about the 811 process, please let NC811 know and they will schedule a date.. Brian Morehouse went over the January 2020 presentation giving the totals for YTD and Monthly number for Tickets called in, average locates per day and (3) hour tickets. (This is included as a PDF on the UCC website) Brian Morehouse went over with the group definition for locates with ¼ mile, 1,320', single address locate and are to be located. Spoke with those in attendance of meetings coming up in the area with 811

present through April 2020. Reminded everyone that April is Safe Digging Month and we would like to get everyone on board to spread the message. Whether it is with your organization, a school in the area. GIVE US IDEAS. Spoke about Proclamation and how NC811 would like to obtain those within the area. Brian Morehouse gave an update on UGDPRB, cases that were heard at the last meeting in January. Safety Sam is here !!! Matter of fact he will be everywhere. Safety Sam will be on billboards, company vehicles, banners, excavation guideline books and many more things. Please help NC811 spread the message. If interested, please ask to have Safety Sam attend your company function. Visit the nc811.org website for more details and sign up today. Spoke with the group about being a Safe Digging Partner. Encouraged all to download the NC811 App.

- B. NC811 Banners were given to those that expressed interest and were asked to hand them in a location for all to see. PLEASE keep up though the month of April to represent April being Safe Digging Month. Instructions were given to either download the QR Reader or how to use it with an IPHONE.
