### **Meeting Time:**

The Wake County Utility Coordinating Meeting was called to order by Mazetta Wynn at 10:03 am on February 27, 2018 due to no volunteer for lunch during this meeting.

### **Total Members Present**

There was a total of **37** members present at the February Wake County Utility Coordinating Meeting according to the sign in sheet. **Members have been asked to please sign in so an accurate count of attendees for each meeting can be documented.** 

#### Welcome of Members and Guest:

Mazetta Wynn with PSNC Energy welcomed everyone to the **2nd** UCC meeting of the year. Housekeeping rules given out for newcomers. Bathrooms are located out the double doors and straight down the hallway to the left. In case of a fire emergency, everyone should exit out through the double doors turn right into the hall way exiting out the door and walk towards the street and wait at the PSNC Energy Logo sign at the front of the entrance.

#### Introduction of the Members and Guest:

Mazetta Wynn with PSNC Energy welcomed everyone to today's meeting again and a formal introduction of the guests and members from left to right announcing their name along with the company they are affiliated with.

#### Safety Moment:

Fred Hawley with the Town of Cary stated that they have seen an increased number of tickets lately. As far as safety wise for the locators sometimes we are put out in the middle of traffic

and it increases our chances of being hit by a vehicle. If you can please white then please white or send us a map of the area you want located.

### **Second Safety Moment**

Jimmy Petrie, with the City of Raleigh, discussed a recent accident he had where he slipped, fell and broke his arm in five places near his elbow. You might think that it can't happen to you, but just be aware as I was the same way. I thought that it would never happen to me and the next thing I know I am in the emergency room. Just be mindful of your surroundings as it's just not worth it getting hurt.

Donna Zuniga with Duke Energy advised that it had been raining and it wasn't ice on her deck, but it was still slippery from the fog so even now it might not be snow or ice on the ground, but your deck can be very slippery.

### **Third Safety Moment**

Member stated there have been about 200 North Carolina residents that have died from the flu. Just take personal precaution by using hand sanitizer and washing hands. If you are sick or feel that you are getting sick then just stay home and don't be around other people. Don't drag that stuff around in the office for others to get sick. Mazetta Wynn with PSNC Energy advised of the different places our hands touch that we could get germs or the flu such as ATM machine, pumping gas, picking up a faucet behind someone, opening the door, or shaking someone hands. We wash our hands, but then we shake someone hands and we don't think about the places our hands go. That hand sanitizer and washing your hands you just can't do that too much.

### Old Business:

Mazetta Wynn reminded everyone of the **36**<sup>th</sup> Annual Joint NC/SC Utilities Coordinating Committee Conference that will be held at the Harrah's Cherokee Casino Resort located at 777 Casino Drive, Cherokee, North Carolina 28719. The conference will begin on **Wednesday, May 2, 2018,** with a Golf Outing, and will conclude on **Friday, May 4, 2018** at 12 noon.

If you haven't registered, you can register online by going to NC811 website. The conferences are always great and if you haven't registered to attend, I would suggest you do so as it will be worth your while.

**Registration:** \$80.00 per attendee (\$90.00 after April 4, 2018); Spouse is \$60.00 (\$70.00 after April 4, 2018.) Registration includes the Reception, All Breakfasts, breaks, and the Thursday Dinner Meal. Hotel rates will be \$109.00 valid 5/1/18-5/3/18.

#### **New Business/Concerns:**

Mazetta Wynn with PSNC Energy advised that she received a couple of emails. Lee Mai with the City of Raleigh will not be attending today's meeting. Also, Robert Yu with USIC will not be able to attend. He is out with a sick child, but he wanted to let everyone know that the challenge is Spirit backbone fiber build in Raleigh especially in Durham. This job is keeping us very busy. Our team met with Spirit last week to level their expectations and it was a very productive meeting.

Representative from Vermeer advised just trying to get a pulse on what's going on in the industry. We are adding staff and providing training support and we are working on keeping good and qualified trained people. We are making sure that we are helping the contractors about the operations of machinery and location aspects out there and being productive as possible. We continue to hear good things about the Atlantic Pipeline. Good things are coming around for fiber built and dirt is starting to be turned around everywhere. Everyone in this room is a part of that and we are excited about 2018 going to be a steady growth year.

Vermeer representative spoke about Durant Road spreading a project along Honeycutt Road at Falls of the Neuse Road. The state will be replacing a bridge around March 17 and 18<sup>th</sup> and then again on March 24 and 25, 2018. The road will be closed if you're trying to go through there. They will be working on getting the pipe in and tied in. John Conner with NC811 advised while talking with other UCC's they spoke about the lack of labeling of that pipe line. I guess that was done to prevent protesting along the pathway. This is going to be a very huge project. The biggest challenge is that this is going to be the largest size project that we have ever tackle from the equipment supplier stand point. Land clearing is in that market so just the scope and good coordination of this project and getting folks trained up.

Cardinal Representative advised of the I-40 expansion is in its early states. It's going to be activity there and there will be thousands and thousands of subdivisions. We are watching crossings every day and we are very busy with tickets. In the first three weeks of March we will be doing the PIG Run and we will be coordinating with Piedmont Natural Gas and PSNC Energy. We will be using smart tool instead of the E-Map.

Donna Zuniga with Duke Energy advised if anyone has damaged Duke Energy power line, the bill may be delayed. We have gone to a new computer system and with training, glitches in the system, the billing process is slower than usual. If you are waiting on a bill, please just give it a little bit more time. The new system is taking the place of about four, so everything is now being rolled in to one.

Member advised that the Town of Cary are dealing with a lot of tickets that is essential a survey job. Both side of and in the road or in the drive way that is unacceptable. I know the NC811 call representative has to accept what's being called in, but we are spinning our wheels wasting

our time doing that stuff when we can actually be putting paint on the ground for someone who will be digging.

John Conner with NC811 advised that they are enhancing the system to have the ability to report where these projects are going on or to allow more remarks to be made so there's greater communication between the organizations to coordinate amongst each other. Louis Panzer with NC811 explained one enhancement of the program is to positive response. Locators will be able to provide images and links and share what's being done and more details regarding what they did onsite.

Louis Panzer with NC811 advised contractors are calling after hours for an emergency locate for a repair and we can only take an emergency locate. Something we are changing after hours is that if someone is calling to report a damage the representative will ask you if you want to report a damage and they will ask are you accompanying an emergency locate. If the party say yes then they can take that information. If they say no then they will let them know that they don't take that kind of request after hours.

Justus Everett with ABE Utilities advised that the 60 code is still an on-going issue and will continue to do what we need to do.

Francois Boston with Fielder's Choice Enterprise base out of Virginia indicated that he's involved with the project of the Laurel Hills Road Dam in Raleigh.

### NC811 Presentation:

- John Conner is the new liaison for the Piedmont Triad Region and Brian Morehouse is the new liaison for the Western Region. Welcome to the Team!!!! John Conner presented the NC811 report for the month of January 2018.
- The NC811 Center received locate request totaling 152,459 in 2018. The total locate request in 2017 was 147,568. This was a decrease of -+3.3%. Transmission Locate request was 834,883 in 2017. Current Locate request in Transmission was 864,096 in 2018. This was an increase of +3.5%.
- There was a total ticket volume of **21,121** for Wake County in 2018. The average locate per day was **960** base on 22 work days.



**Destroyed Marks & 3 Hour Tickets** When to properly use each

### **DESTROYED MARKS**

If locate marks have been destroyed, the excavator must contact NC811 to issue a Destroyed Marks ticket requesting a remark of the area from the original ticket. A Destroyed Marks ticket does not extend the life of ticket; it will expire the same day as the original locate request. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in case of destroyed marks.

### **3 HOUR TICKET**

If an operator fails to respond to the positive response system, the excavator may proceed if there are no visible indications of a facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, such as a pole, marker, pedestal, meter, or valve. However, if the excavator is aware of or observes indications of an unmarked facility at the proposed excavation or demolition area, the excavator shall not begin excavation or demolition until an additional call is made to the Notification Center detailing the facility and an arrangement is made for the facility to be marked by the operator within three hours from the time the additional call is received by the Notification Center. A 3 Hour Ticket should not be used in the case of destroyed marks.
