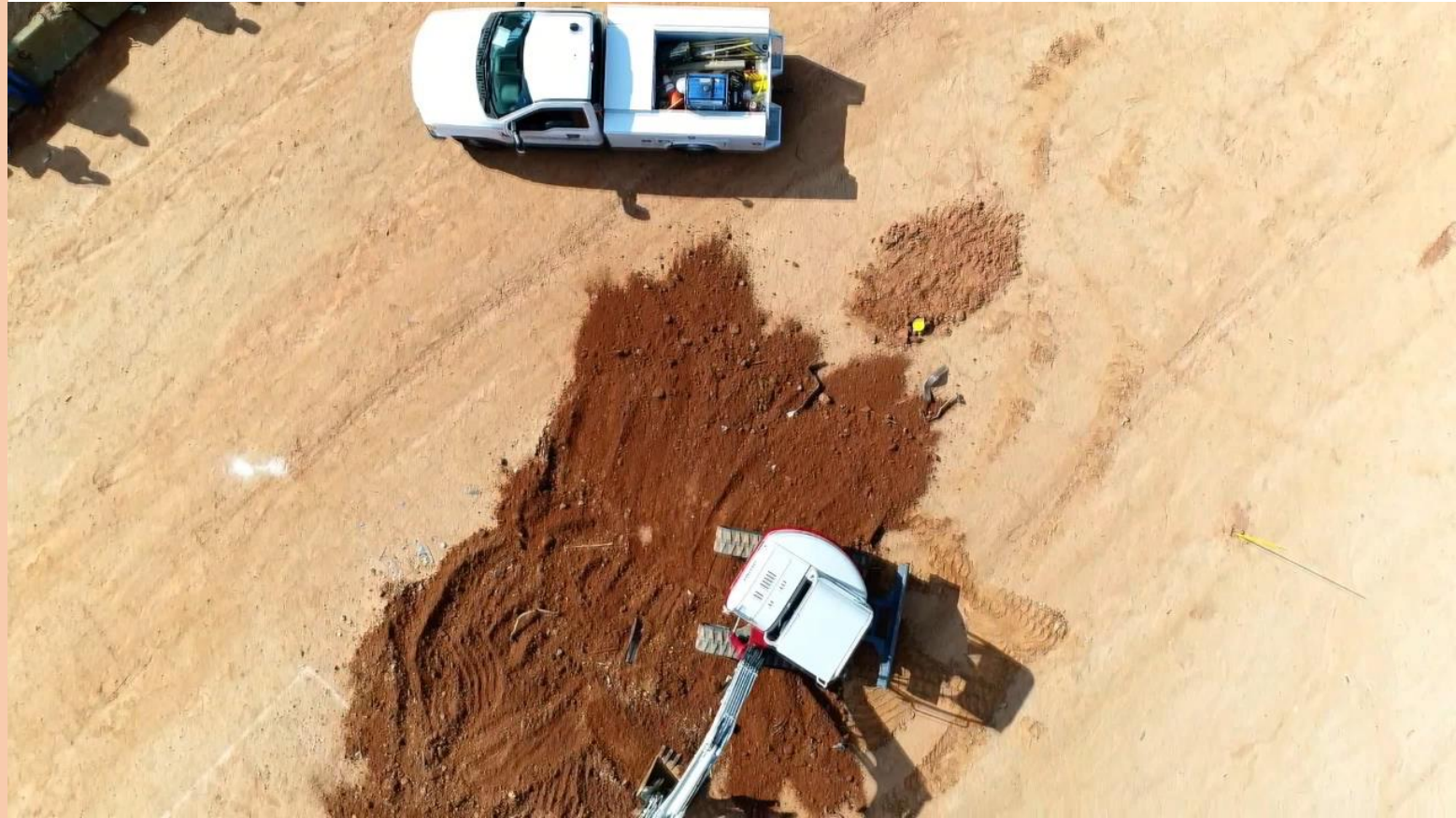

### Meeting Time:

The Wake County Utility Coordinating Meeting was called to order by Sandra Johnson with Dominion Energy on Tuesday, September 24, 2019 at 11:05 am filling in for Guy Smith-Chairman due to him being sick. Thank you for attending the Wake County Utility Coordinating Committee Meeting. This is a forum for developing relationships with focusing on damage prevention and public safety.

**Lunch Provided by:** *Derrick Farrar and Kevin Comalander with Segra.*

**Blessing of Food:** Given by Sandra Johnson with Dominion Energy

**Break for Lunch at 11:05 am and started back up at 11:25 am**

**Housekeeping Rules and Emergency Exits:** Sandra Johnson with Dominion Energy welcomed everyone and provided housekeeping rules given out for newcomers. Bathrooms are located out the double doors and straight down the hallway to the left. In case of a fire emergency, everyone should exit out through the double doors turn right into the hall way exiting out the door and walk towards the street and wait at the PSNC Energy Logo sign at the front of the entrance.

### Total Members Present:

There was a total of **49** members that signed the roster and present. **Members have been asked to please sign in so an accurate count of attendees for each meeting can be documented.**

### Safety Moments:

Safety moment given by Marc Worth with Dominion Energy. Right now, you are supposed to pull over to the left lane and slow down if there's an emergency vehicle. Please do that any time when there's any vehicle on the shoulder and you can change lanes and move over. You

never know when someone is trying to walk around their vehicle and get in their door or any time you have a vehicle on the shoulder if you will move over.

Tim Yarbrow with Ansco & Associates commented about the folks following too close in their vehicle. Our following distance for our company is four seconds.

Sandra Johnson with Dominion Energy commented that as she was going home about 5:40 pm and from New Bern Avenue to Buffalo Road traffic was backed up in both lanes. She drove down to New Hope and Buffalo and there was a paving company paving where some excavation had been done putting back curb. Now the City of Raleigh you are supposed to be out of the street at 4:00 pm. She obtained the name of the company and reached out to Lee Mai with the City of Raleigh this morning and told him that people were traveling in the center lane and moving up to the stop light to make a U-Turn and it was just a really bad situation. It was about 30 minutes before she could make that turn. Lee said if you see anything like that and if you can call or take a picture of the company and even in that area it's a DOT road and they had worked together in that instance and they should have been out of the street at 4:00 pm. At the end of the day we are all impatient and have worked all day and just want to go home as we are tired. She was very frustrated by the time she could make a turn and go home.

**Introduction of Members and Guest:** Sandra Johnson with Dominion Energy welcomed everyone to the 9<sup>th</sup> UCC meeting and a formal introduction of the members and guest starting to the right announcing their name along with the company they are affiliated with.

**New Business:**

Tom Miller with ITS advised a lot of work being done on I-40 and a lot of hard rock being busted.

Nash Hardy with Hardy Landscapes commented that the locate community is **NOT** doing a great job of creating trust with the contractor community when they tell you that they will come out and mark when we tell them when we are doing the work. That's not acceptable. Nash advise he's currently working on a job right now that is geometrically challenge among belief and he was told by two locators that said they were not going to work it on Monday. His job is crisscross with a seven-foot excavator with everything in the world and he need to be able to resolve those conflicts and determine how to avoid those conflicts. The locator community decides because he tell them that he is not going to excavate until Monday that they are not going to mark it until Monday. He is following the law and he called in a ticket that should have been located by last Friday morning. He called in (3) three-hour tickets with no response. He doesn't know what we are supposed to do as a contractor when the trust isn't there and he had one of the responders responded clear when it was quite clear that their facility was in the area and they just didn't want to come before work closed out. They documented on the ticket **CLEAR**. It was not clear!! It immediately creates a distrust by the contractor to see **CLEAR**, but the facilities are clearly there.

Marc Worth with Dominion Energy thanked Mr. Nash for coming to this meeting to discuss this issue. That's the purpose of this meeting to discuss issues. Let's get together first and discuss this issue in this room and see what we can do to resolve it. I would hate for this issue to go to the damage review board. Nash Hardy stated that he believes that it will be going to the damage board because he was told that he needed to play a game by him telling them a lie and he stated he is not in it for telling a lie. He was told that what you tell them when you send in your ticket that I am going to go to work as soon as the paint is on the ground. Well that's not true! He is not going to excavate when the paint goes on the ground. He's going to resolve the conflict that he know he's going to have to deal with. It's not the locate community as the law

says that you have 72 hours and then for you not to respond to the three hours ticket twice. My ticket stated if there's a question or a problem contact me at this number. No contacting me at all!!!! No phone call no nothing.

Marc Worth with Dominion Energy stated that filing a complaint with the damage review board file the complaint against the company that they work for. You can not file a complaint against the locator contractor. It must be with the company they are working for. Just want to take out a step in the process for you. A lot of time the locate company get to address the complaint and the locate company is not following the damage prevention law. It would be the company that hired them. Mr. Nash stated the utilities involved were the City of Raleigh, Spectrum, AT&T, and Duke Energy.

NC811 and the City of Raleigh said I had to make a false statement. When he called back on 3-hour ticket the lady on the other line said Mr. Hardy what you need to do is **NOT** tell them when you're going to work. When he got the return telephone call from the City of Raleigh the response was from the gentlemen that he spoke to and he said well you are not going to work until Monday and I told him sir your facility are in my excavation zone and there may be a conflict and I need to figure out how to resolve it before Monday. It's not your place to determine that. Marc Worth with Dominion Energy said Mr. Hardy was very compassionate and just bringing up an issue that needs to be discussed.

Lee Mai with the City of Raleigh handles the permits in the Right of Way. There was a transitional period starting July 1, 2019. Well we have determined that we will be going with the new system and if you guys are not already familiar with it it's called the Raleigh Development Corridor. All you need to do is go to Google and type in the City of Raleigh online permit corridor and you go in and create an account by setting up your email address and then you will apply under street, lane, and sidewalk closing.

Right now, our group has determined due to the resources that are available to us what I can do as I am the only person who can approve the permit. Any time you are excavating in the Right of Way especially for new install and that would be for Verizon, MCI, DOT, Public Utilities, Storm Water Maintenance, or any time working in the downtown Raleigh area you need to enter a permit so Lee can coordinate and make sure you are not conflicting with any other projects. If you are downtown, then you need to make sure that you are not interfering with parking and you coordinate that. This is the reason that you need the permit. All the maintenance permits Dominion Energy, Duke Energy, Pike, all your small jobs that take a day or two we haven't taken the determination yet, but it will follow the rule that you get an encroachment from the state. If you are doing main installs or new infrastructure, then you will need a permit.

Member spoke about Design tickets need to be called in due to the variance as designs are just as important. A lot of conflict could be avoided in the design ticket is called in and the facilities located are there. When we start talking about road way project and utilities owners then we



are dealing with a whole new ball game putting in curb drains, etc. Design tickets are needed to avoid conflict.

#### **NC811 Presentation:**

- Parrish Reddick, Liaison with NC811, presented the NC811 report for the month of September 2019.
- The NC811 Center statistics show that we received locate request totaling **195,594** in 2019 compared to **190,779** in 2018. That's a difference of 2.5%. Year to date tickets show **1,072,084** in 2019 and **1,028,103** in 2018. That's a difference of 4.3%.
- Transmissions locate ticket request show **1,537,829** in 2019 compared to **1,358,544** in 2018. That's a difference of 13.2%. Year to date tickets show **8,352,845** in 2019 compared to **7,403,070** in 2018. That's a difference of 12.8%.
- There was a total ticket volume of **25,852** for Wake County in August 2019. The average locate per day was **1175**.
