NC811 Presentation by Howard Corey

### ❖ Let's look at Wayne County:

- 3-hour tickets have decreased by 65% since 2019
- January 2019 vs. January 2020 we show a decrease of 9 % in tickets and a 4 % difference in transmissions
- Wayne County is averaging 77 locates per day

### ❖ There have been 637 damages in 61 counties and according to the charts 2 of those are in Wayne County.

- Telco -45%
- CATV- 19%
- Electric- 16%
- Water & Natural Gas – 6%
- Unknown- 7%

### ❖ Locates are horizontal in the ground and are not determined by depth- always assume that a shovel in the ground can hit something.

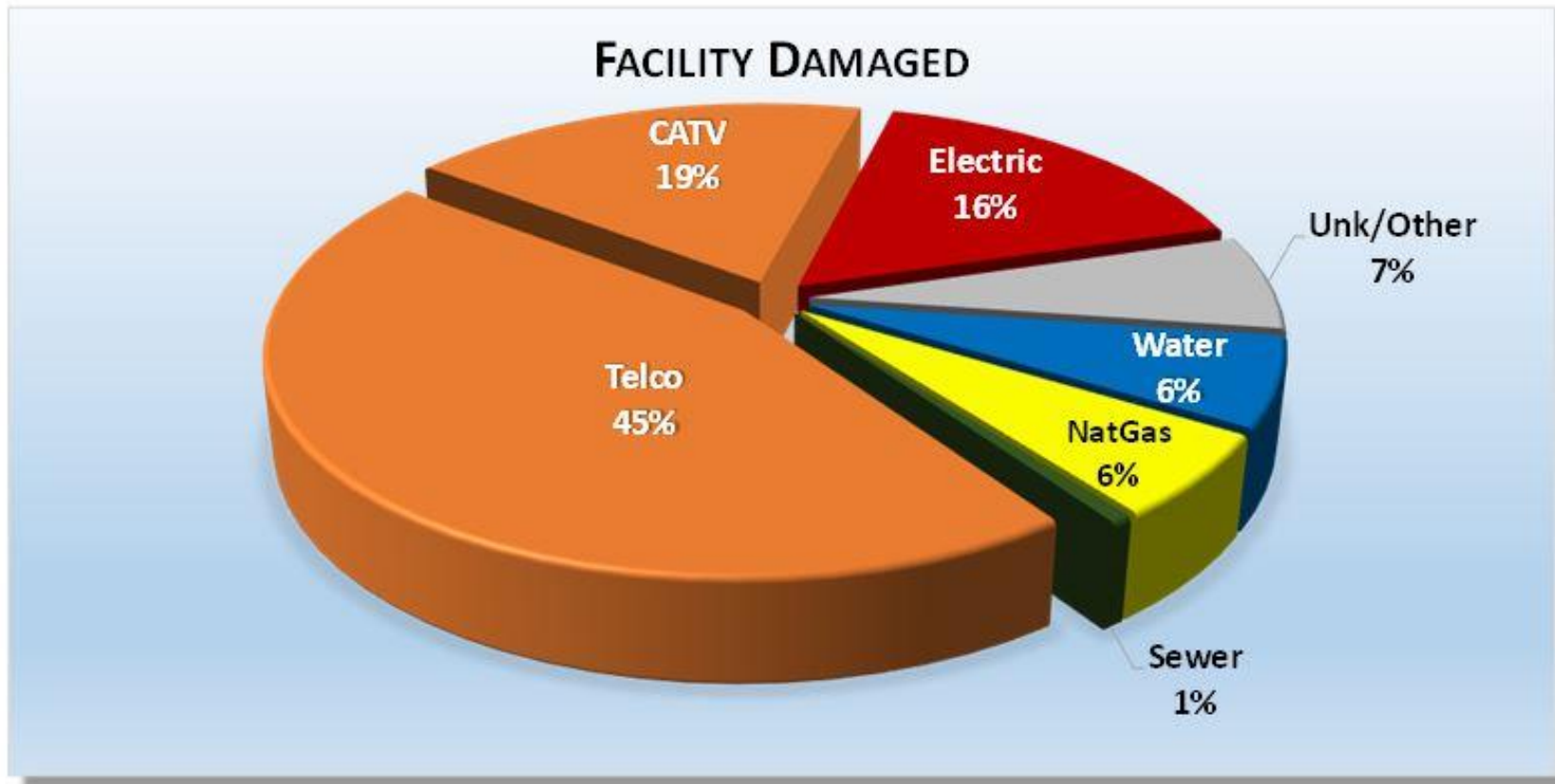

# NC UDPRB

## Update of Activities: February 2020



- 258 Cases heard since initiated in 2014.
- A memorandum of understanding in place with Deputy Attorney General for legal counsel to the UDPRB.
- 200,000 being billed out to top 50 NC 811 transmission recipients.
- A memorandum of understanding in place with Department of Commerce for placement of funds received.
- ***Reminder: Facility Owners, Excavators and Notification Center are the ONLY parties that may be named in a complaint.***
- NC 811 providing research to all complaints received after October 1, 2019.
- To date, 77 recommendations have resulted in orders being issued by NC Utilities Commission.
- Once funding is received, next steps are to secure administration through an rfp process and to develop a dedicated UDPRB web page.
