**January 28, 2020**

Level 1 safety brief was conducted- all emergency procedures were reviewed

Eddie Sykes welcomed everybody and introduced Howard Corey from NC811.

The minutes were reviewed from our last meeting in October 2019. Eddie handed out an informational pamphlet for us to review.

Wayne county was reviewed: We had a 4% increase in tickets in December 2019 from 2018 as well as a 8 % increase in transmission tickets.

YTD: Wayne county had a 10.5 % increase in total tickets called in as well as a 11% increase in transmission tickets.

Wayne county is averaging 61 locates per day currently.

Howard reviewed the county ticket distribution as well as the incidents happening across the state.

  - **PNG-Construction-** N William St and Hood Swamp Rd- rerouting for expansion  
Bridge-Mark Edwards Rd to begin soon-utilities are being relocated  
Royall Ave extension still being worked on  
Linda was able to answer questions regarding the Elm St. project
  - **City of Goldsboro-** Center Street- sewer project – dirt streets being resurfaced (Hawthorne, Chestnut, Oak Hill, Mimosa)
