Level 1 safety brief was conducted- all emergency procedures were reviewed

Eddie Sykes welcomed everybody and introduced Howard Corey from NC811.

Howard did a quick video update and reminded us that April was National Safe Digging month.

Wayne county was reviewed: We had a 15.8% increase in tickets in the month of April of 2019 from 2018 as well as a 13 % increase in transmission tickets.

YTD: Wayne county had a 17 % increase in total tickets called in as well as a 16 % increase in transmission tickets.

Wayne county is averaging 72 locates per day at this time.

Howard reviewed the county ticket distribution as well as the incidents happening across the state. In 83 counties where incidents were reported from there were a total of 2609 of damages. The top ones that were damaged the most were: telecommunications, cable, natural gas and electric.




