

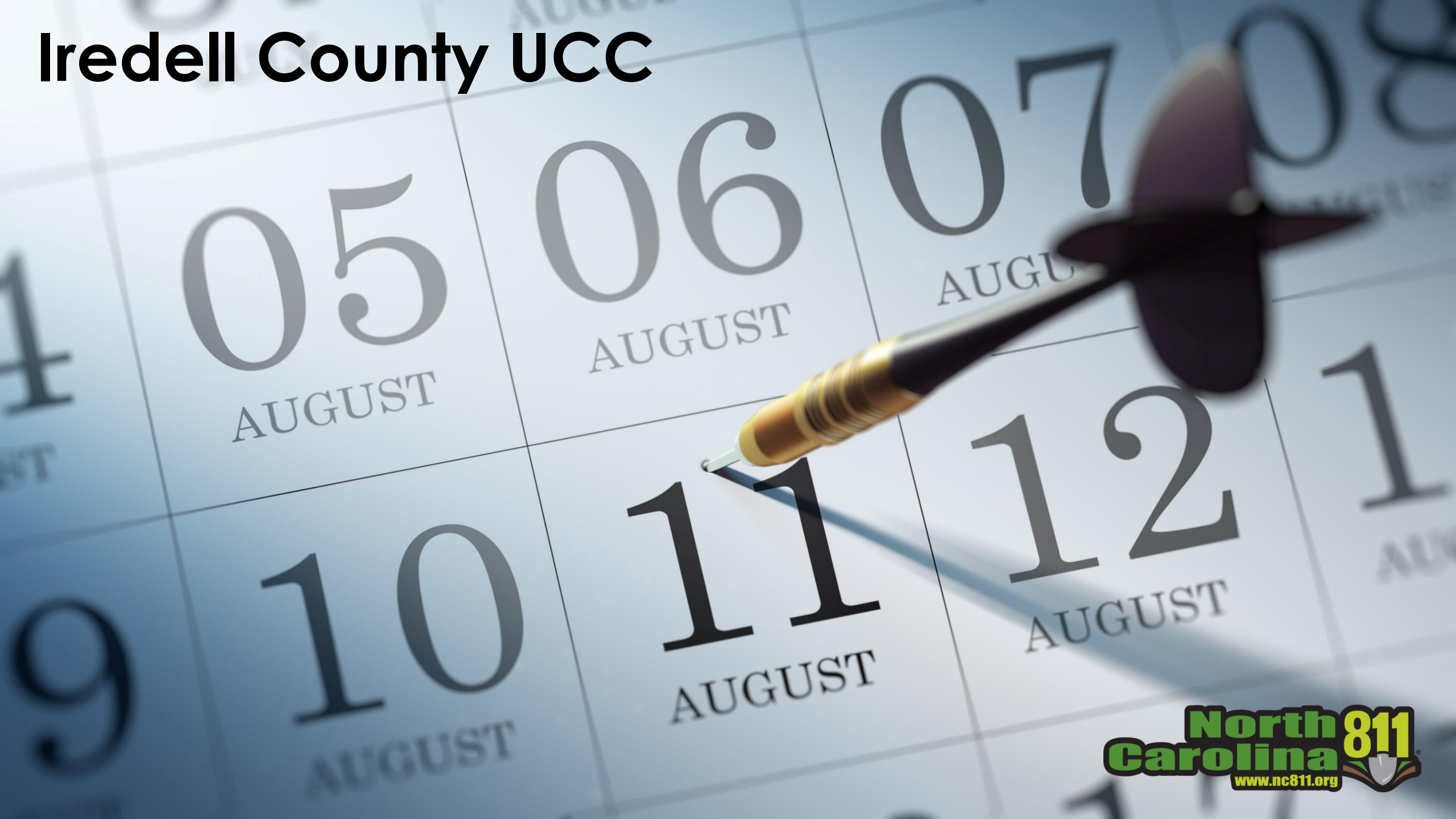
Virtual UCC Meetings with Zoom

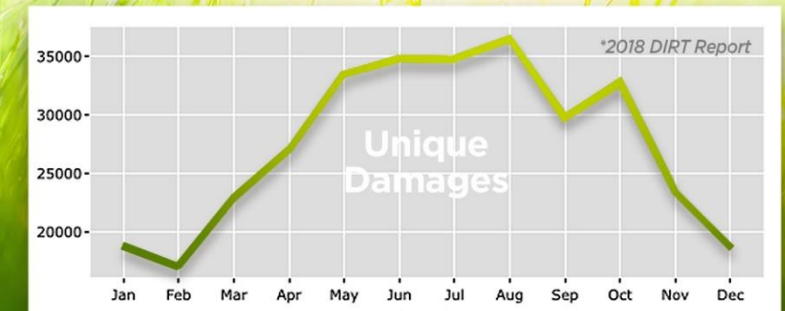

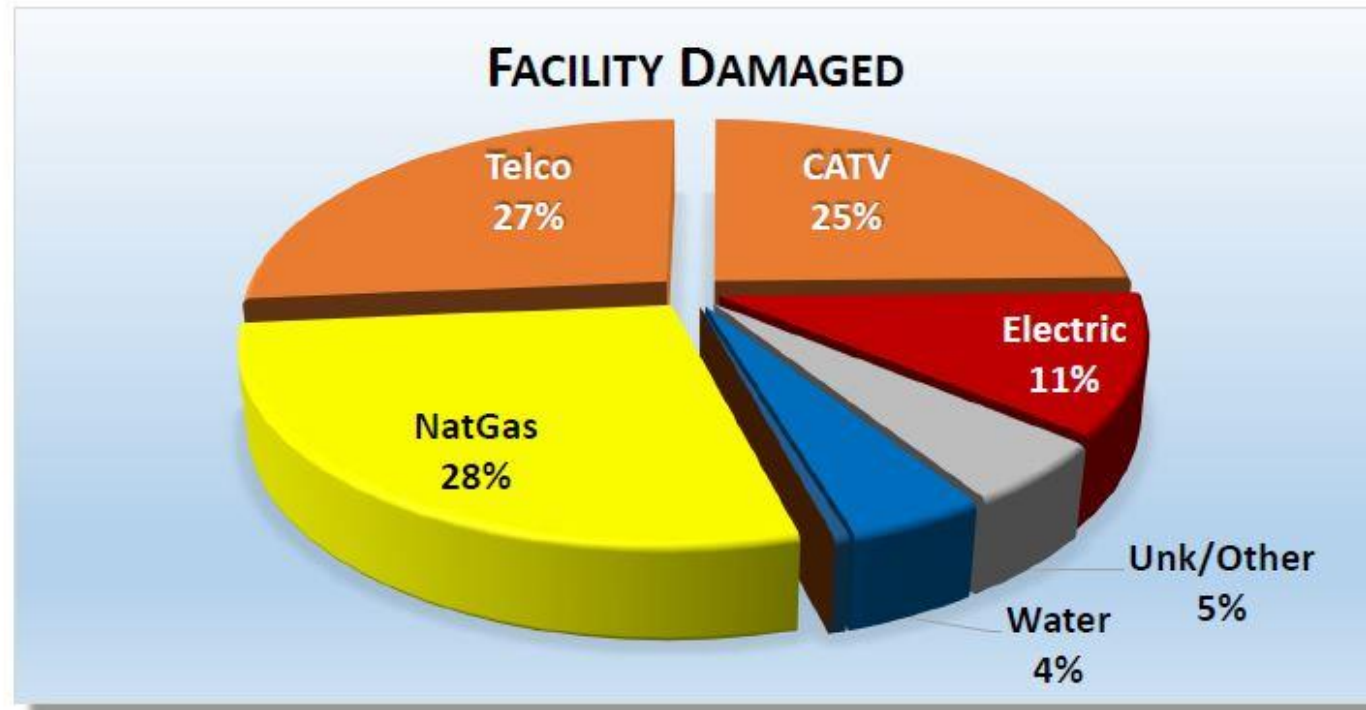

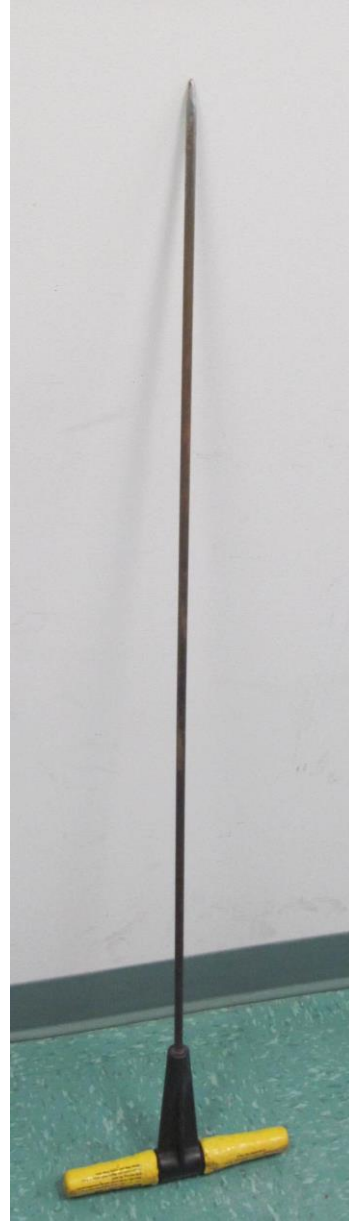


NC811, Year 2019: 15,621 Damage Events in 99 Counties
