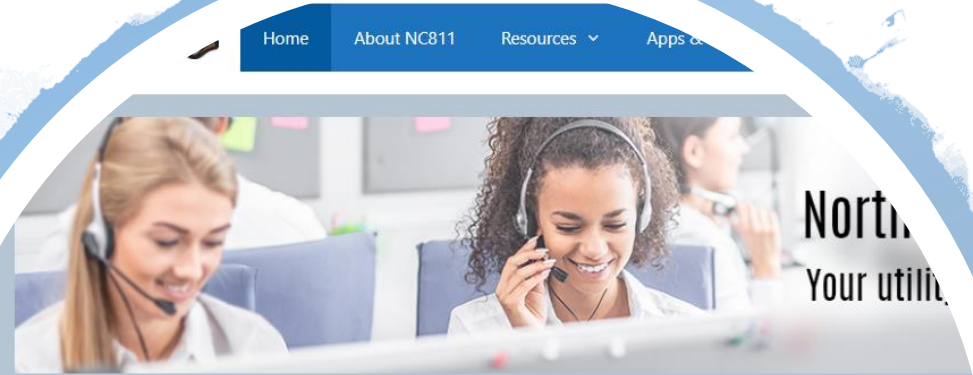

The new and improved, self-sufficient **Single Address Ticket** application for the excavation community. The improved application will allow for **IMMEDIATE** processing and delivery of the excavation/demolition notice. No more waiting for NC811 to view and process the notice on your behalf. The confirmation locate request number will be presented to you directly on the screen! Email Confirmations will continue to be sent as well.



Single Address Ticket can be used by a homeowner, contractor, or anyone who needs to request utility lines to be marked at a single address. The form is designed for simple requests. No training needed.

Single Address Tickets are valid for 15 business days and will need to be updated on the 12th business day. The ticket only needs to be

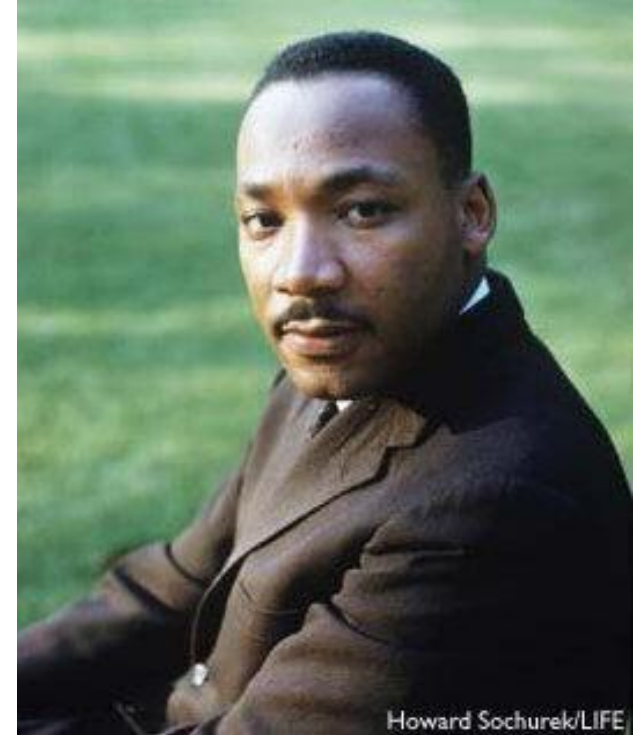
