- **5.** Brian announced, that Monday is the busiest day to call in your locate request. NC 811 has set up a "Callback System" that you can use to receive a return call to schedule you locates. Just be sure when you call that you request a callback if you want a return call. This is reducing greatly the time you spend on the telephone trying to register a needed locate request.
- 6. Brian wants to continue to go out into the field and visit with companies who need to be involved with NC811. He wants to offer teaching on how to use the mobile app and to properly complete the locate requests. This means: Communicate! Communicate!
- 7. When field employee misplaces their locate request number? Resident with mystery markings in the yard? No need to panic, NC811 has just what you are looking for <a href="MEARTICKET">NEAR</a> TICKET allows you to see a listing of active excavation notifications in your immediate vicinity. - 8. When calling in for a locate to be done make sure that you include the following information:
  - Correct Address of locate request.
  - Correct Contact Telephone Number
  - Contact person's Name.
  - Area to be located marked with "White Lines".
