# PREPARING FOR BACK TO SCHOOL IN 2021

- **Address nervous feelings**  
Validate their nerves and set a positive tone.  
Establish a beloved goodbye ritual.
- **Encourage school readiness skills**  
Encourage responsibility and independence.  
Explore math and literacy concepts.  
Ask your child open-ended questions to promote more complex thinking.
- **Create routines and schedules**  
Establish clear routines to eliminate daily decision-making and increase efficiency.  
Maintain a bedtime and sleep schedule.
- **Communicate with your child's teacher**  
Be proactive about communication.  
Be supportive of your child's teachers.  
Focus on your child's best interests.
