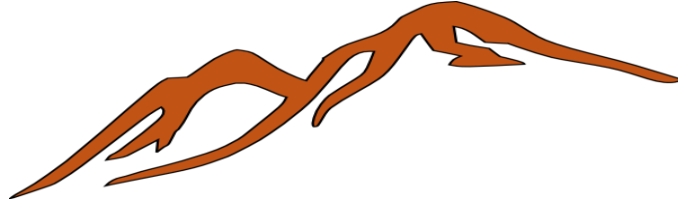

No need to panic, NC811 has just what you are looking for NEAR TICKET allows you to see a listing of active excavation notifications in your immediate vicinity. - Correct Address of locate request.
- Correct Contact Telephone Number
- Contact person's Name.
- Will the area to be located marked with "White Lines".

- Brian would like for us to remember to continue documenting any locating issues that might develop during work during the coming months. Be sure to report these to NC 811 office.

- Damage Reporting: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro.
