Welcome to NC811 TICKET REVISION or simply "REVISE"

Ticket revisions will allow you to:

1. request a destroyed marks ticket for an existing notice,
2. cancel an existing ticket, or
3. request a 3-Hour notice on an existing ticket.

To process the ticket revision, you will need:

1. the existing ticket number and
2. the phone number that was provided when the request was made to perform these revisions.

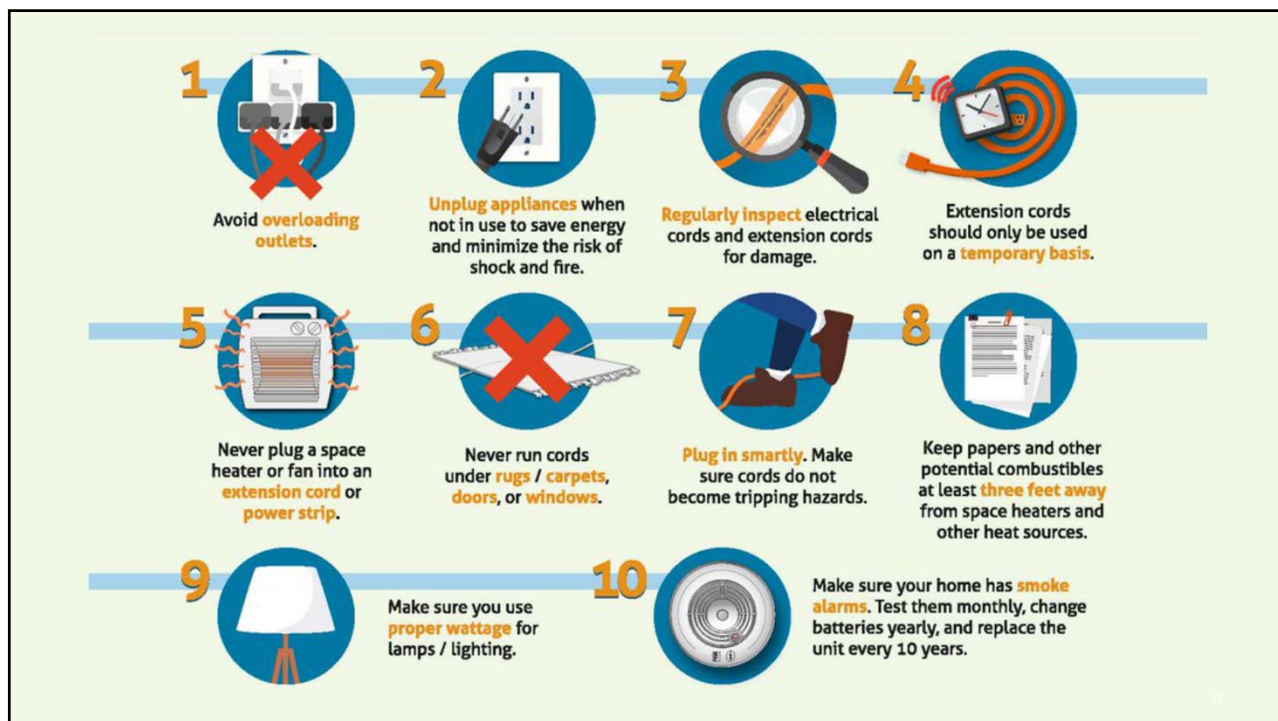

Possible Upcoming Projects

Karen @ Pluris spoke about all of the requests they have received concerning PROPOSED new construction:

Turkey Point Rd. RV Park – 200 to 300 new RV sites

Jubilation project – 1300 homes

Winery Rd./Hwy 172 – 1300 to 1400 homes

Hwy 172/Sneads Ferry Rd – 300 RV sites

Wynne @ ONWASA spoke about requests they have received concerning PROPOSED new construction:

550-acre subdivision on Morris Landing Rd @ the county line

Townhomes at Morris Landing Rd/Jolly Ridge Rd

RV Park in Holly Ridge off Ocean Rd

Onslow Bay – next phase of Stones Landing (500 homes)

Hwy 111 and Hwy 258, 40 – 50 homes

Cow Horn and Gum Branch Rd up to 700 homes

2 Subdivisions on Gum Branch Rd – a couple of hundred homes each

Apartment project in Richlands

Off Cowhorn Rd, a subdivision near Maidstone

****LOCAL UTILITY UPDATES****

Piedmont Natural Gas – Joe Keily – installing gas main in several areas: Drummer Kellum Rd., from Hwy 17 to Ramsey Rd., 3 sections on Gum Branch Rd., on Hwy 210, Hwy 258 from Burton Park to Pony Farm to Hwy 53 and down to Onslow Pines Rd.

Vermeer All Roads – Matt Sharpe - Discussed supply chain issues, expects those issues to last the next several months. If you need to order anything, call it in ASAP, so it can be on order!

Mid-Atlantic Cable – Hershel Oxford - Next phase at Stateside, small projects, maintenance. Lots of new installs for fiber. He has heard that in the next 6-12 months, there will be a lot of fiber lines being installed in all of the rural areas to supply high-speed internet across the country. Spectrum staff should be able to inform the committee.

USIC – Jeff Parker – Very busy. Hiring aggressively. MetroNet fiber is coming to install in NC, down Hwy 17 from New Bern through Jones and Onslow county to come.

The Committee discussed safety concerns dealing with traffic at the worksites. Brian Terry with ONWASA showed how he was hit by a car while locating a line in Sneads Ferry recently. Brian is doing fine, but he was injured and out of work for a week and a half.

This meeting ended at 1:22 pm. There were 12 attendees.
