- Damage Reporting: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is **your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro.**
- Below is the website where you can go to communicate “Damage Violations.”

- **Remember!** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
 - **Call 911 to report the accident!**
 - **Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!**
 - **Call 811 to report the accident to our office!**

- **Damage Reporting:** It is ***YOUR*** responsibility to report ALL damages to underground utilities. The reports must be reported to the NC 811UCC offices in Greensboro.

Round-table Discussions:

Ralph Johnson – Brentwood Water: We will be starting a new installation project on the David Bryant Road off the Kathy Road soon. The contract has been awarded to the Iron Mountain Contract of Mountain City, TN. This project will consist of installing new water line on the state highway right-of-way and getting our current line off private property and out of wooded area which is extremely hard to service. We have a bid of \$99,500 for this project.

Currently doing the engineering and getting ready to go out for bids on the Bradley Road Project. This project is about one mile, and we estimate it to run around \$200,000.

Will Dennis – Town of Rhodhiss: They been experiencing significant issues with DOT contractors installing guard railing within the town. They have penetrated sewage lines while driving the post in for this railing. Causing extra work for his department.

Richard Lawrence – Duke Energy: The current project in Morganton (across from the Deaf School) should be completed by early Spring 2022. Everything is going well with his company.

At this meeting we will be electing new officers for the 2022 year. Hope to see you then!
