LOCATION: Hyatt Regency, 220 North Main St, Greenville, SC


WHEN: Wednesday, May 4, 2022 – Friday, May 6, 2022



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5. SPECIAL REMINDERS:

- Damage Reporting: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is **your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro**.
- Below is the website where you can go to communicate "Damage Violations." <u>https://www.nc811.org/report-a-violation.html</u>
- **<u>Remember!</u>** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
 - Call 911 to report the accident!
 - Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!
 - Call 811 to report the accident to our office!
- **Damage Reporting:** It is **YOUR** responsibility to report ALL damages to underground utilities. The reports must be reported to the NC 811UCC offices in Greensboro.

Round-table Discussions:

<u>Robert Turner – Brentwood Water:</u> Nothing major going on. We have started a replacement water line project on David Bryant Road. We have some employees currently with the COVIA Virus.

It is noted that Ralph Johnson, longtime President of the Brentwood Water Board of Directors has resigned and moved away from Burke County. Ralph also served as the Chairman of the Burke / Caldwell Counties NC 811 UCC Association.

Will Dennis - Town of Rhodhiss: Nothing to report.

Mark Delehant – Burke County: Things are going on fairly well. Nothing major to report.

John Leger – Town of Rutherford College: a few projects in the works. Major problem is getting the materials needed to do these jobs.

<u>Mike Sheffield – PRG</u>: PRG is does the major damage investigations for all telecommunications except for: ATT and Verizon. Still have some damages to underground lines.

<u>Alan Glines – Burke County:</u> We were joined today by Alan who is the Planning Director for Burke County. He is interested in meeting with varies towns, water, and sewage providers within the county. Major part of his interest is mapping of varies systems within the county as they pertain to possible future projects that maybe going on in the county.
