**WHEN:** Wednesday, May 4, 2022 - Friday, May 6, 2022

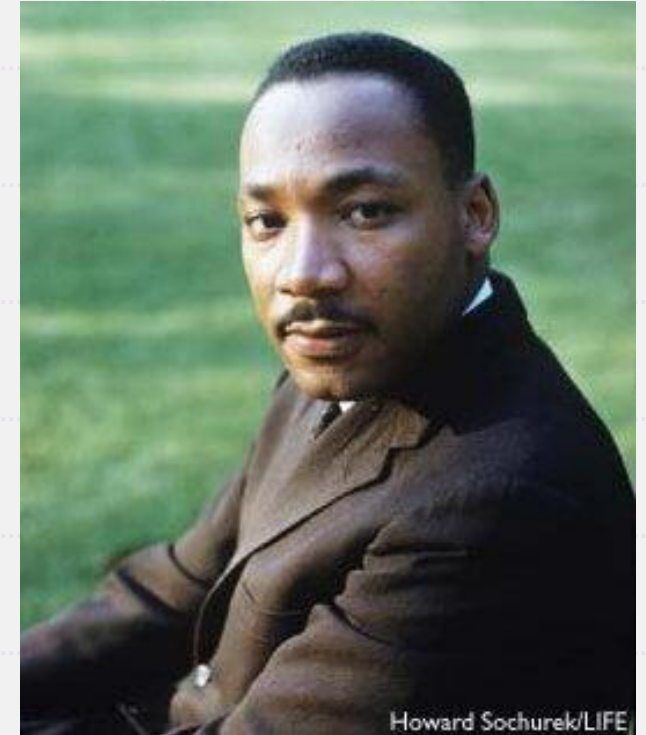
