LOCATION: Hyatt Regency, 220 North Main St, Greenville, SC


WHEN: Wednesday, May 4, 2022 - Friday, May 6, 2022



- 5. NC 811 will continue to have Virtual UCC Meetings: within some areas .6. SPECIAL REMINDERS:
- · Damage Reporting: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 Offices in Greensboro.
- · Remember! If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
- o Call 911 to report the accident!
- o Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage! o Call 811 to report the accident to our office!
- · Damage Reporting: It is YOUR responsibility to report ALL damages to underground utilities. The reports must be reported to the NC 811 offices in Greensboro.
