

- <u>Damage Reporting</u>: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is <u>your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro</u>.
- Below is the website where you can go to communicate "Damage Violations."

- **Remember!** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
 - Call 911 to report the accident!
 - Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!
 - Call 811 to report the accident to our office!
- <u>Damage Reporting:</u> It is <u>YOUR</u> responsibility to report ALL damages to underground utilities. The reports must be reported to the NC 811UCC offices in Greensboro.

Brian Morehouse - NC 811 Comments:

• If you have any of the NC811 Banners at you work location, please take a picture of it, and forward it to Brian at his email address. Brian's email address is: bmorehouse@nc811.org

- If you do not already have the NC811 app installed on your mobile device, get it, it is a helpful tool to use in your daily jobs.
- If you have damages made to your systems, you can look into filing a complaint with the UGDPRB. File the complaint against the parent company involved. Remember, to take several photographs from various angles to be submitted with your written claim.

Round-table Discussions:

<u>Mark Delehant – Burke County:</u> Not a lot is going on. Brian Morehouse is going to do a training session for the county employees.

<u>David Perkins – Brentwood Water:</u> Nothing major going on. Install installing a few new taps, and still have a few water line leaks. We are getting ready to begin a new water line replacement project. This consists of 3,000 feet of new six" line replacing an old outdated 2" line. Should begin over the next few weeks.

<u>David Wortman – Town of Rhodhiss:</u> All is good, nothing to report.

<u>Jim Buckner / Rodney Roland – REMC:</u> Still in the pole replacement project. We have replaced several hundred poles within the system. Approximately 300 poles have been replacing in Burke and McDowell counties. When you are having locates done, it is good to take photographs of problems and any questions about the location. It will become in helpful in the event of an accident or problem occurs.

<u>Chris Banietti – Badger Transportations</u>: Badger has recently changed their corporate name from "Badger Daylighting" to "Badger Transportations." He has been working on a new distribution center for Macy. This center is in Rowan County.

Badger is also working on a new development (River District). This is a 20-year project which consists of homes, hotels, retail space etc. It is located near the Charlotte Airport.
