

- <u>Damage Reporting</u>: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is <u>your</u> responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro.

- **Remember!** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
 - o Call 911 to report the accident!
 - Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!
 - o Call 811 to report the accident to our office!
- <u>Damage Reporting:</u> It is <u>YOUR</u> responsibility to report ALL damages to underground utilities. The reports must be reported to the NC 811UCC offices in Greensboro.

<u>Brian Morehouse – NC 811 Comments</u>: Working on issues with Locate tickets not being responded to in a timely manner. Our UCC has created a new Letter for us to keep in touch since we meet every three months.

New Business

o NC 811 / One Call presentation was given by: Brian Morehouse went over issues within the area, spoke about the contractors that he has spoken with since the last meeting Please remember if you or your organization needs any training- please contact Brian Morehouse to schedule a date and time for this training to take place. Our UCC will have a Pipes Plus Training class at the October 2022 UCC Meeting (After) If you have any new employees please make sure to have them attend. This training is free and there is a certificate issued to those that pass the test with an 80 or greater.

Reports

- A. NC 811 / One Call Brian provided us with the monthly 811 updates. Also, Brian talked to us about having 811 come to your office and do an 811 Safety Presentation. NC811 has improved the 3-hr notice as described in the presentation. Everyone has been asked to send issues to Brian Morehouse at bmorehouse@nc811.org, please don't wait to the next meeting since we meet every three months. NC811 needs the ticket # to review the issues being sent over.
- B. N.C.D.O.T projects continue within the area, not having issues, bridge work and maintenance works continues around the area..
- C. **Bryson City-** Very busy, have had some gridding issues with our 811 tickets but have reached out to Member Services and we have that issue resolved.
- D. **Dominion Energy** No issues, things are going well. No major issues at this time.
- E. USIC NA
- F. Spectrum- New work coming to the western region of North Carolina (2022)- 2,900 miles of new cable. Went over all this information and timeline of project. Very good information given. Was given an update that crews are in the area and working. It was reported by others that contractors are calling locates in way ahead of where they are working and needing to update those numerous times. Brian Morehouse will be reaching out to them.
- G. Town of Sylva- busy is booming, staying on top of things, having issues with contractors not giving enough information on tickets or they will give info and then do something else not noted on the locate ticket.
- H. **Duke Energy** <u>Plenty of work with underground, pole replacements and 3 phase work in the surrounding areas.</u>
- I. Sumter-Very busy. Having issues getting things marked on time. Over 50% are not marked on the required date and (3) Hr tickets called in and still no response. This is holding work up within the area.
- J. Frontier -NA
- K. RKK-NCDOT- Bridge work and guardrail work continue within the area.
- L. BalsamWest- NA.
- M. TWSA- NO new work to report, General Maint work continues. Area is growing. Locates are up. Having issues with getting things marked by USIC, over 70% of the tickets called in are not being responded to on time. Brian Morehouse has informed them that you are required by law to call in a (3) Hr. ticket. Was asked what happens after that, we can not advise on that matter. If digging was to take place the excavator takes on that responsibility.
