

- <u>Damage Reporting</u>: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is <u>your</u> <u>responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro</u>.

- **<u>Remember!</u>** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
 - Call 911 to report the accident!
 - Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!
 - Call 811 to report the accident to our office!
- **Damage Reporting:** It is **YOUR** responsibility to report ALL damages to underground utilities. The reports must be reported to the NC 811UCC offices in Greensboro.

New Business

 NC 811 / One Call presentation was given by: <u>Brian Morehouse went over</u> issues within the area, spoke about the contractors that he has spoken with since the last meeting on line. Please remember if you or your organization needs any training- please contact Brian Morehouse to schedule a date and time for this training to take place.

Reports

- A. NC 811 / One Call <u>Brian Morehouse went over the issues with calling in Updates for</u> <u>locate tickets when there is no need to do so. Also disused in detail the Underground Damage</u> <u>Prevention Review Board</u>
- B. N.C.D.O.T Work from DOT is rolling out and look for plenty of work over the summer and fall of 2022. Hwy 26 project continues with great progress, still another year or so to complete project. Small work and bridge replacements throughout the county will take place.
- C. Dominion Energy <u>New work and maint staying busy, no issues with locates at this time</u>
- D. USIC Busy is the name of the game. Had 21 locators in the area and are down to 13 at this time, training new locators and brining them on board, tickets are high at this time.
- E. Ansco- Plenty of work within the area, not having to many issues, staying on top of things.
- F. City of Asheville Water- Continue projects referred to as Right Away Project. General Maintenance work continues throughout the area. Work will begin from Nasty Branch to Livingston Rd. Work will begin on Victoria and Hazelwood, and tap services down to Patton Ave. Staying busy and have had a few emergency calls since the last meeting. Work continues to come in and staying very busy leading into the summer months. This will take some time. Have a ton of locates coming in.
- G. Southern Cross Inc- Tickets are at an all time high, staying on top of these tickets. Talked about certain contractors that they are having problems with and they are handing out Excavation Guideline manuals on site.
- **H.** AT&T A lot of work is coming this way in the summer of 2022 with pole replacements and fiber work continuing in the area. Having a problem getting fiber material may slow production up a little.
- I. Several organizations are having a problem receiving Constant Contact invites. NC811 will be working on this issue.
- **J.** Duke Energy- Mentioned the issues that they are having with Charter/Spectrum getting located. Have had this issue since April 22nd, Charter codes are not appearing on tickets and this is holding a lot of their work up. Have three phase pole replacements, new underground services. With the Asheville area growing, look to see a very busy year in 2022. Went over issues with tickets not being grided correctly and spoke with locators about that issue. Duke Energy gave detailed info on work around the area.

- K. MSD- Replacement jobs are going on and don't seem to be having an issue with locates. 2022 expectations—going to be busy and seeing some new work being designed and coming into the system by mid-summer
- L. Badger- New to the meeting, went over what Badger does and looks forward to being part of this UCC.
- M. Southern Cross- Everything is going fine. Fully staffed with no issues at this time.
- **N.** NC811 noted that reports have been given on Charter/Spectrum codes not appearing on locate tickets. 811 has reached out to Charter and informed them about this situation. 811 has been told that Charter/Spectrum is working on this issue
