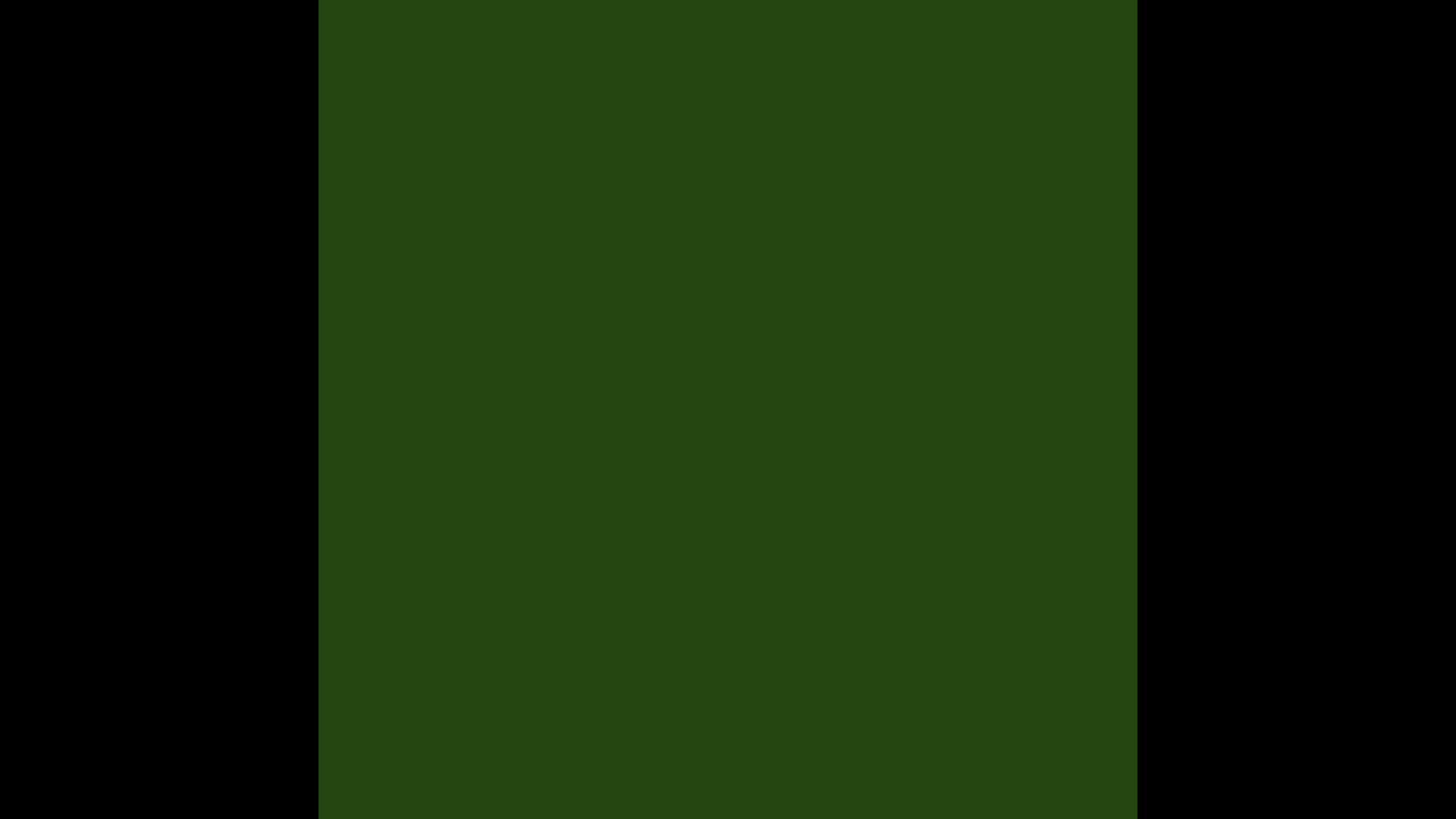

Creating a Damage Ticket vs. Reporting damages with Dirt Lite

Report a Damage

It is the LAW for excavators to report damages to NC811 and the facility owner/operator. At this time, this can only be done by calling 811 to speak with an NC811 representative.

DIRT LITE

DIRT Lite is solely used by the member facility owner/operator to report an incident that occurred to their facility only; **member facility owners must contact NC811 directly** in the event they have caused a damage to another member facility owner/operator's facilities.

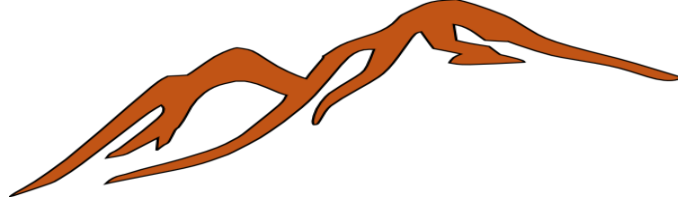

4. SPECIAL REMINDERS:

- **Damage Reporting:** Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is **your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro.**
- Below is the website where you can go to communicate “Damage Violations.” <https://www.nc811.org/report-a-violation.html>
- **ALWAYS!** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
 - **Call 911 to report the accident!**
 - **Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!**
 - **Call 811 to report the accident to our office!**

Brian Morehouse – NC 811 Comments:

- Brian made an announcement that effective August 5th, 2022, he will be leaving the NC811 organization. He is going to pursue other employment opportunities.
- **Important:** If you have damaged made to your systems, be sure and file a COMPLAINT. File the complaint against the parent company not the locator service provider. Remember, to take several photographs from various angles to be submitted with you written claim.

New Business

- NC 811 / One Call presentation was given by: Have had a few tickets not get marked on time but have reached out to that company. Skyline has reached out to the facility operator and notified them of these issues and went over that problem to see about getting it corrected in the future.

Open Discussion

Reports

- A. NC 811 / One Call – *Brian provided us with the monthly 811 update. Also Brian talked to us about 811 having 811 come to your office and do an 811 Safety Presentation. Brian Morehouse went over the October 2019 presentation giving the totals for YTD and Monthly number for Tickets called in, average locates per day and (3) hour tickets. (This is included as a PDF on the UCC website. Brian Morehouse gave everyone the supervisors numbers for locating companies that are within this area. Encouraging others to reach out to those supervisors if they are having issues with getting tickets cleared. Had an open discussion with all in attendance about how to make our local UCC better and what type of information they may be looking for now and in the future.*
- B. N.C.D.O.T – Bridge work continues throughout the area; it was reported that certain projects may be put on hold due to the budget. culvert repairs still on schedule. 221 work is continuing and is going along well and staying on schedule as given
- C. Skyline Communications- **Everything is going really well, no locates issues, no damages to report. Been very busy with new installs and fiber work in the area.**
