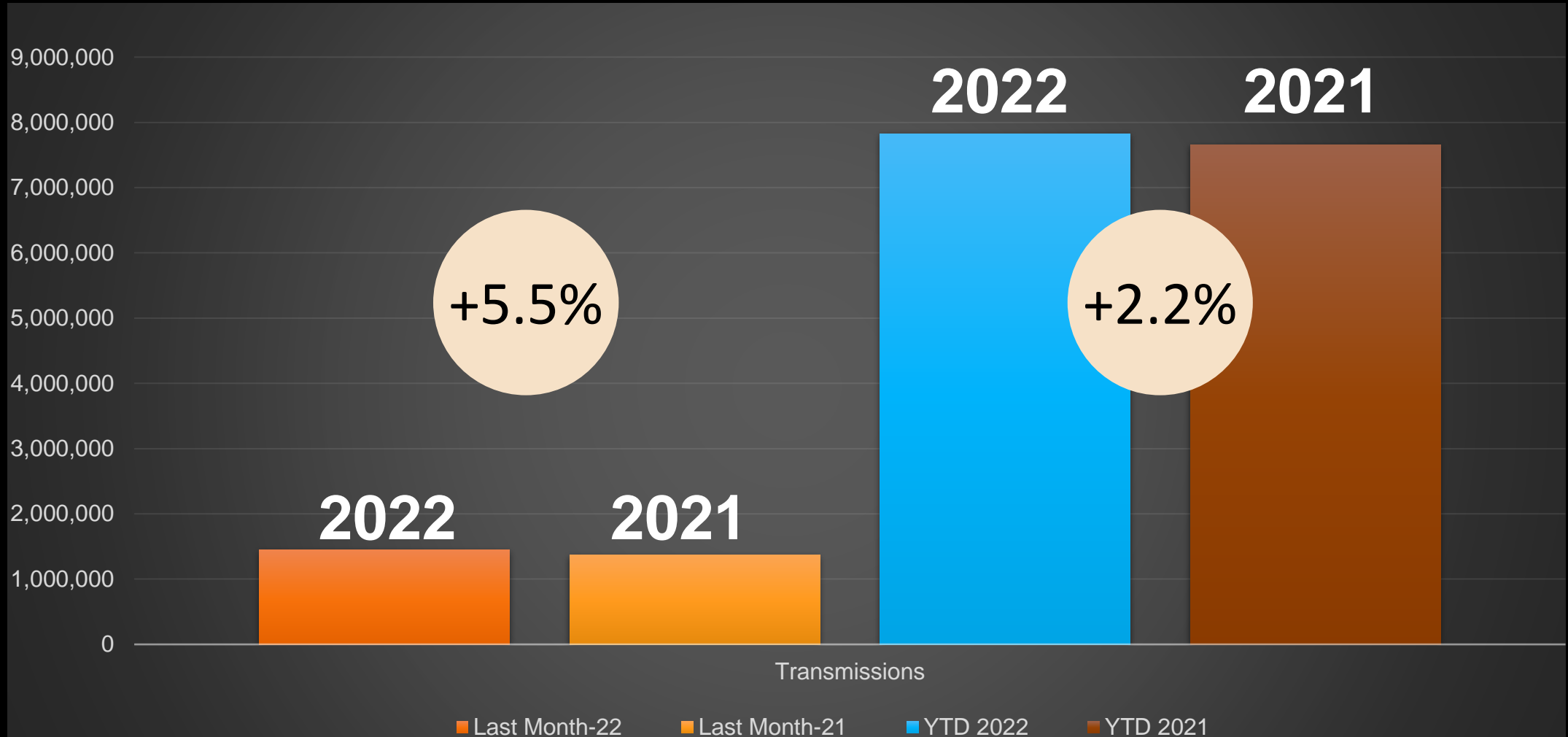

- **Damage Reporting:** Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is **your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro.**
- Below is the website where you can go to communicate “Damage Violations.”

- **Remember!** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a Gas Line, do the following in this order:
  - **Call 911 to report the accident!**
  - **Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!**
  - **Call 811 to report the accident to our office!**
- **Damage Reporting:** It is **YOUR** responsibility to report ALL damages to underground utilities. The reports must be reported to the NC 811UCC offices in Greensboro.

## Reports

- A. **NC 811 / One Call** – Brian provided us with the monthly 811 update. Also, Brian talked to us about 811 having 811 come to your office and do an 811 Safety Presentation. Brian Morehouse went over the July 2022 presentation giving the totals for YTD and Monthly number for Tickets called in, average locates per day and (3) hour tickets.
- B. **N.C.D.O.T** – 221 Project is rolling right along, R/W being cut and this will be a very busy job over the next two years. Things have really picked up on this work since our meeting in June. Having no issues with locates on this project.
- C. **Dominion Energy** – Staying very busy in the area of Gaston County. Tickets are not as high as the last few months but still very busy. Fiber Projects within the area have slowed down
- D. **USIC** – **Was not in attendance for this meeting. It was mentioned that they have been busy and are keeping up with locates.**

City of Kings Mountain- stated that things are going well, locates done in time, still having issues with companies calling in Emergency tickets in the area.
