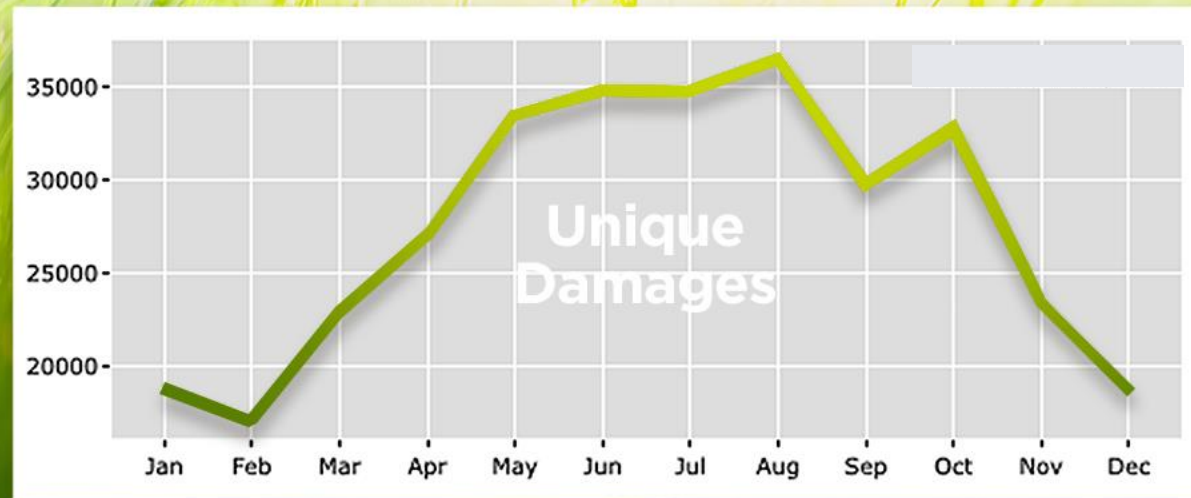

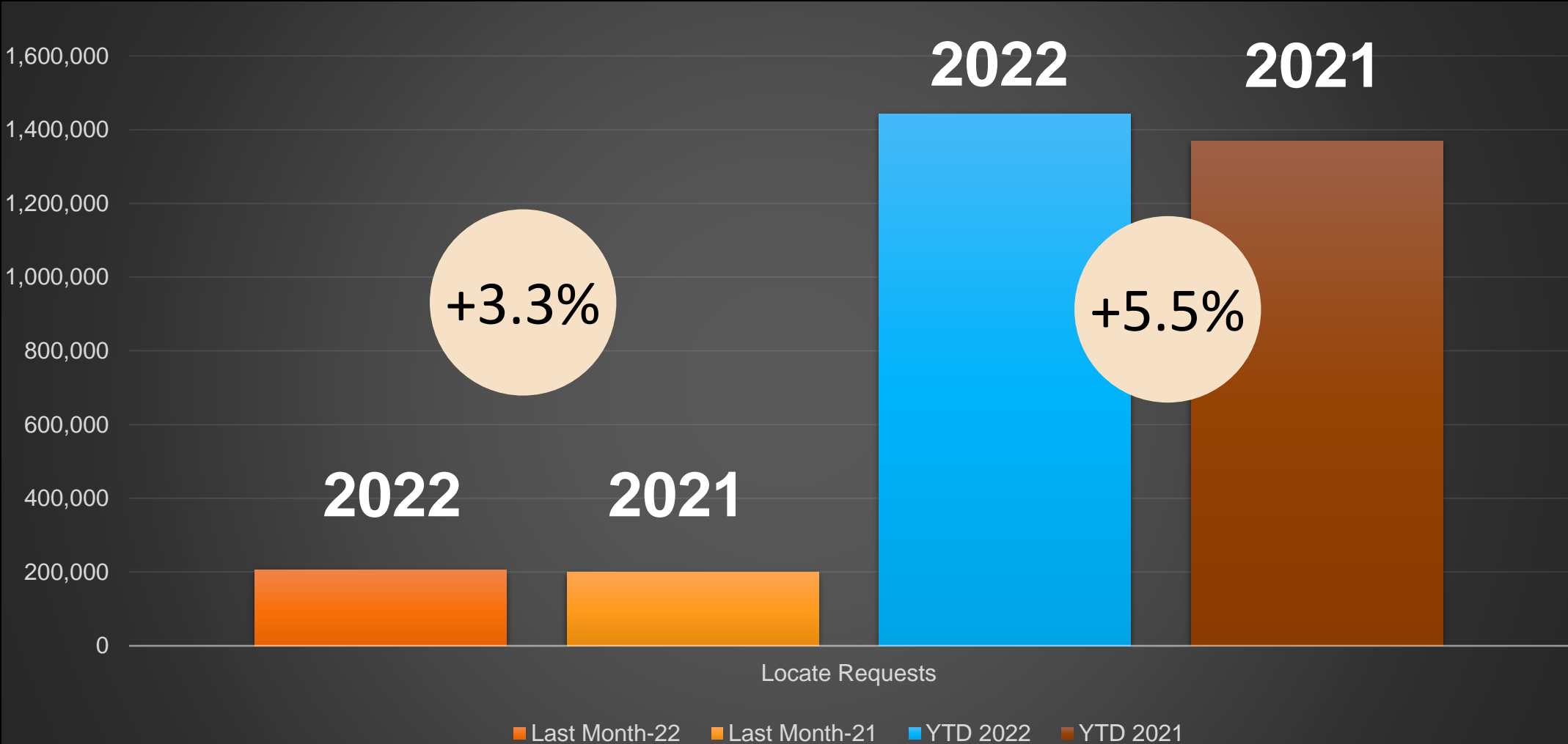




# LOCATE REQUESTS IN NORTH CAROLINA

July 2022 vs 2021

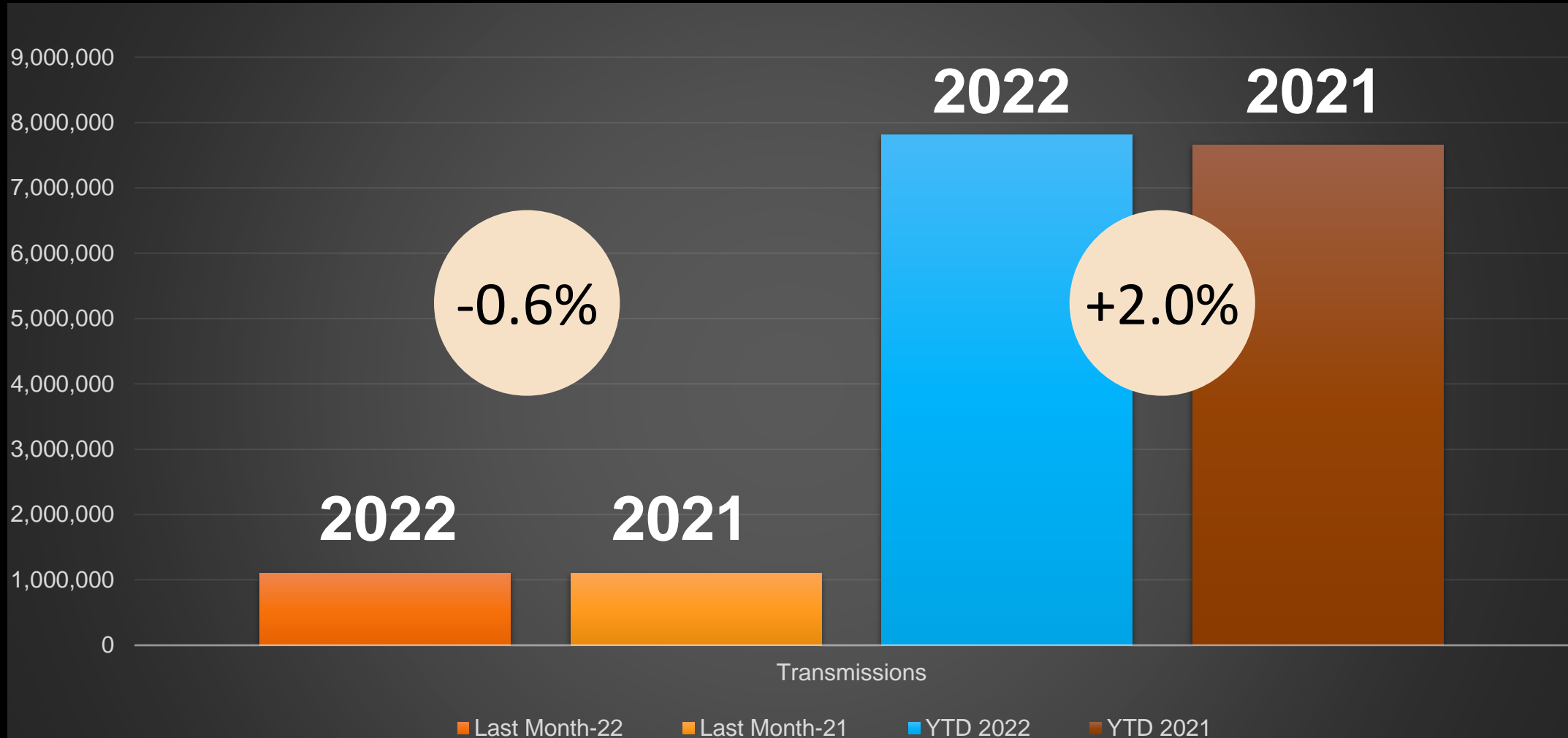
YTD 2022 vs 2021

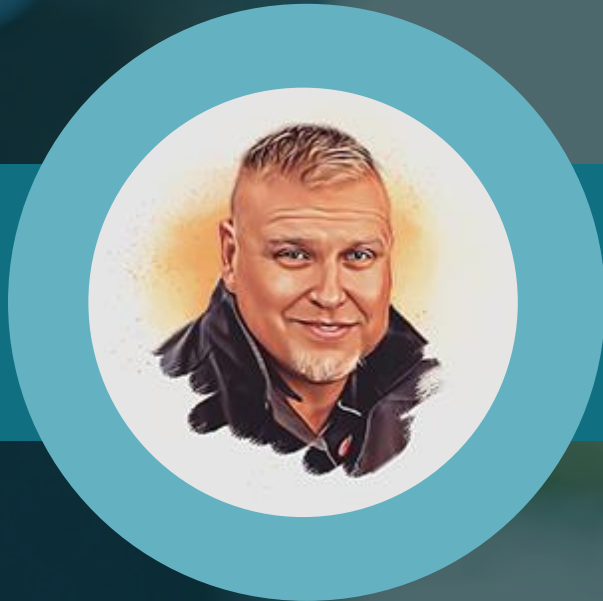

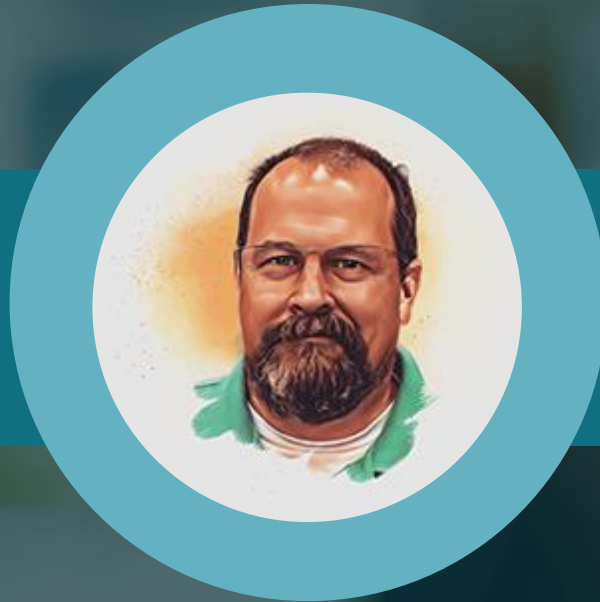

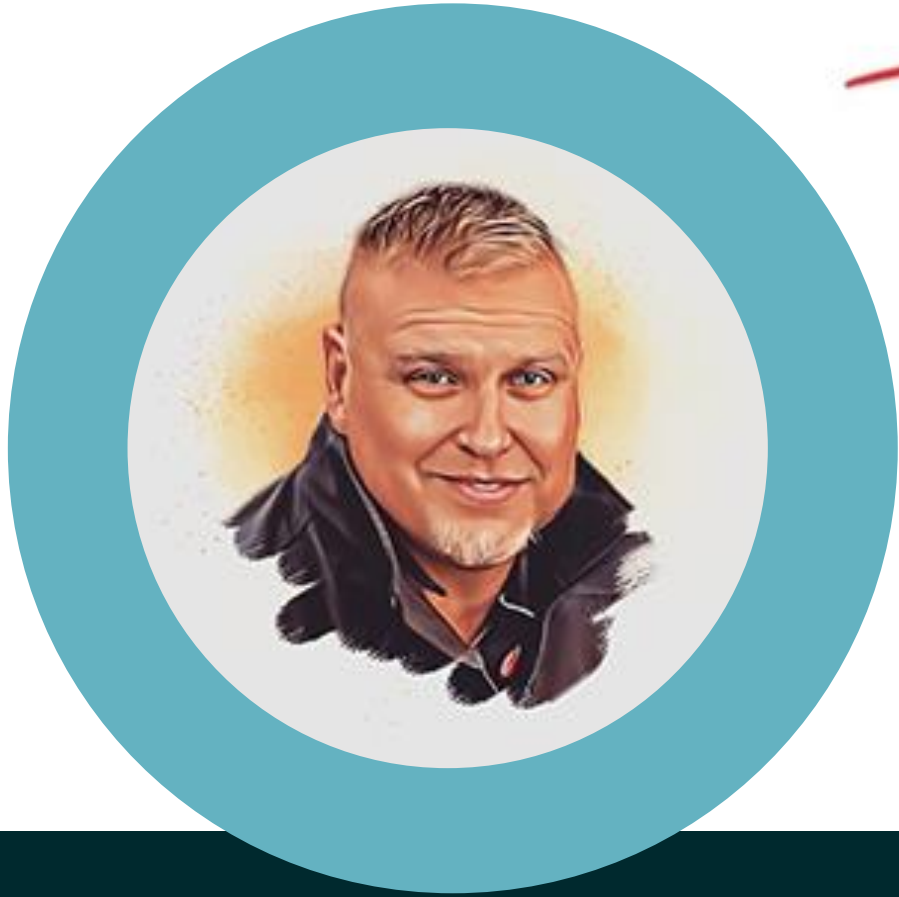
