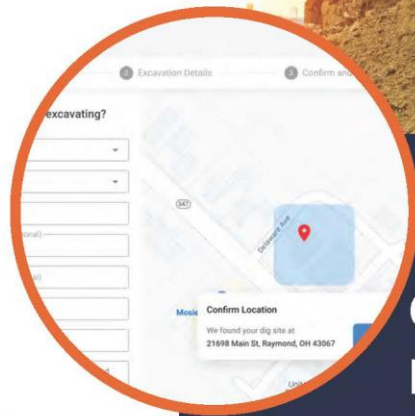

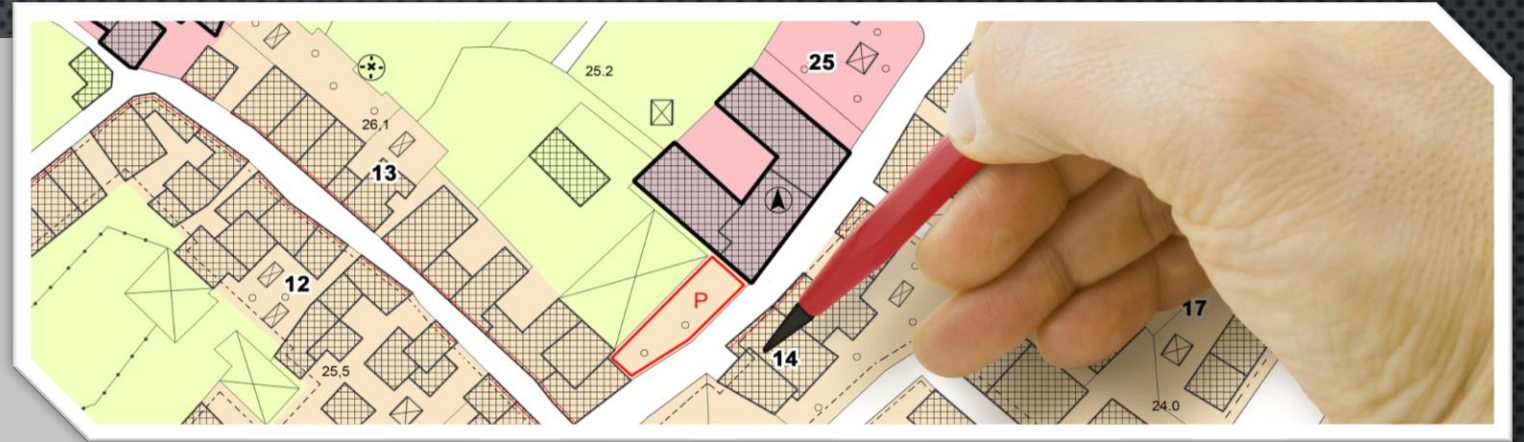

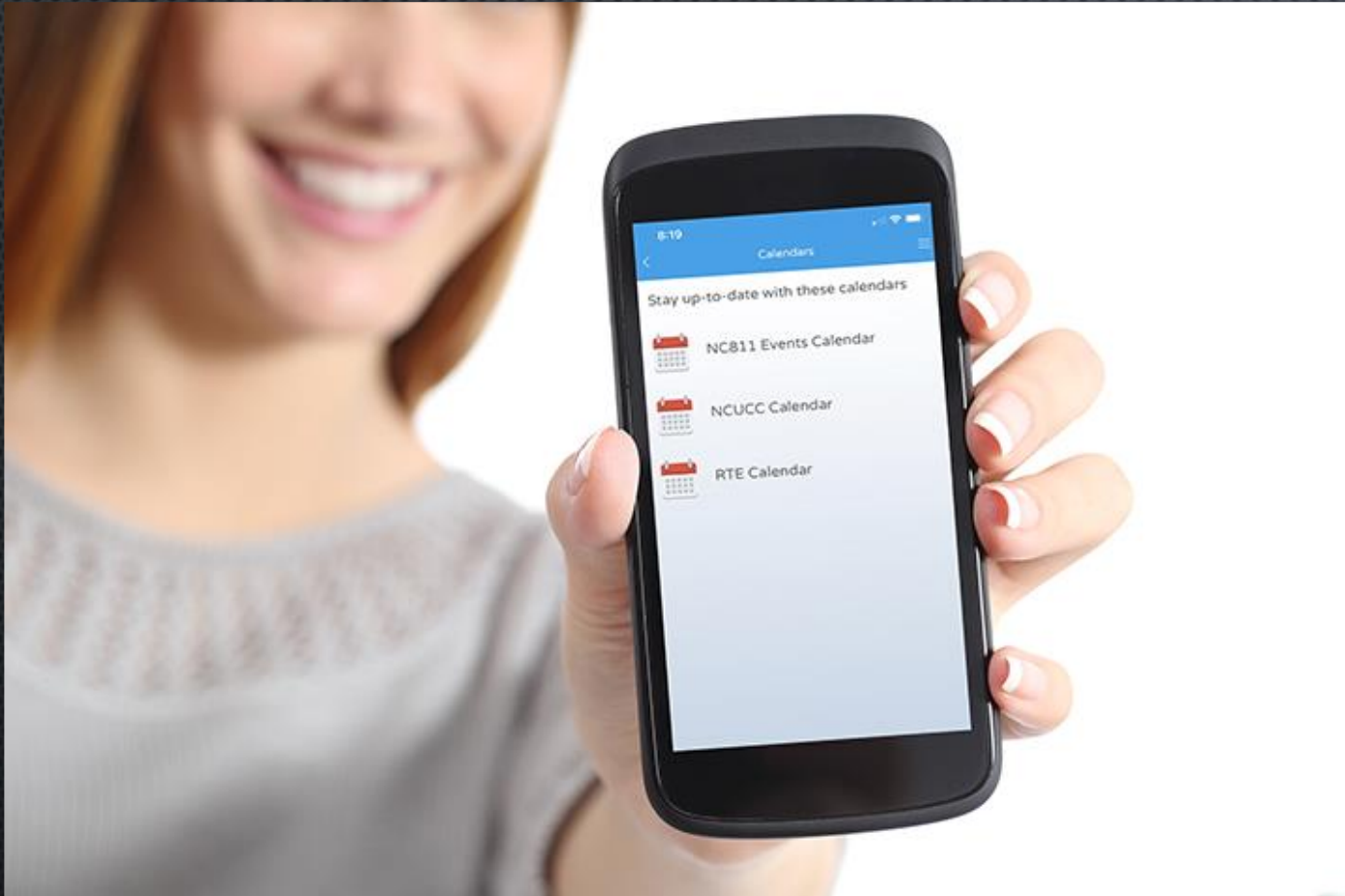

Piedmont Natural Gas- PNG has done some hiring. 24" main from Union to Stanly. Working around all the water/sewer and fiber going in around the county.

City of Monroe working on forced main sewer.

PNG had nine hits on marked lines and three hits on lines with no locates.

City of Monroe had two cut gas lines. One with no locates and one was mismarked.

It is so important to keep the lines of communication open between the excavator, the utility, the utility locator, NC811, and all other interested parties.
