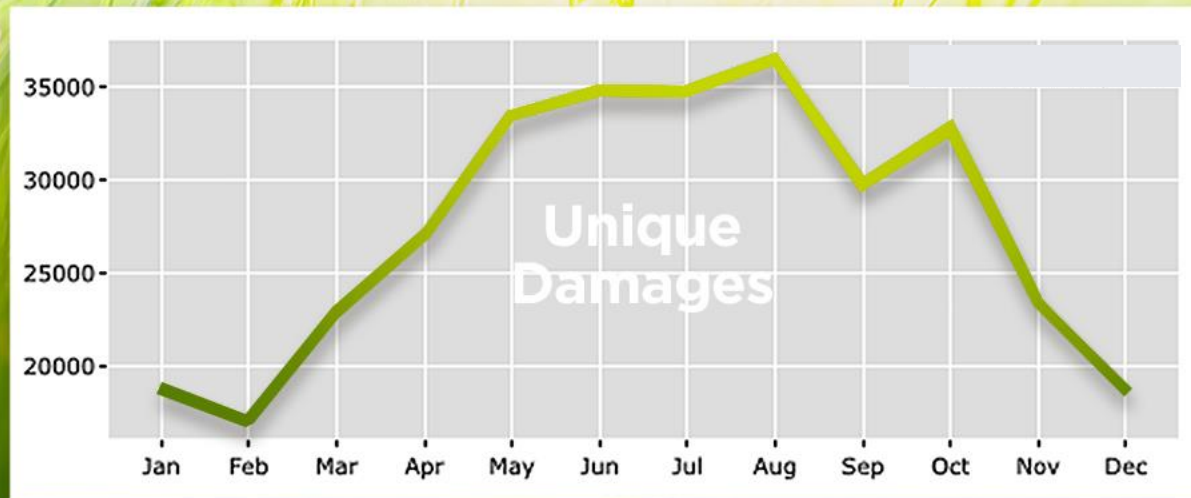

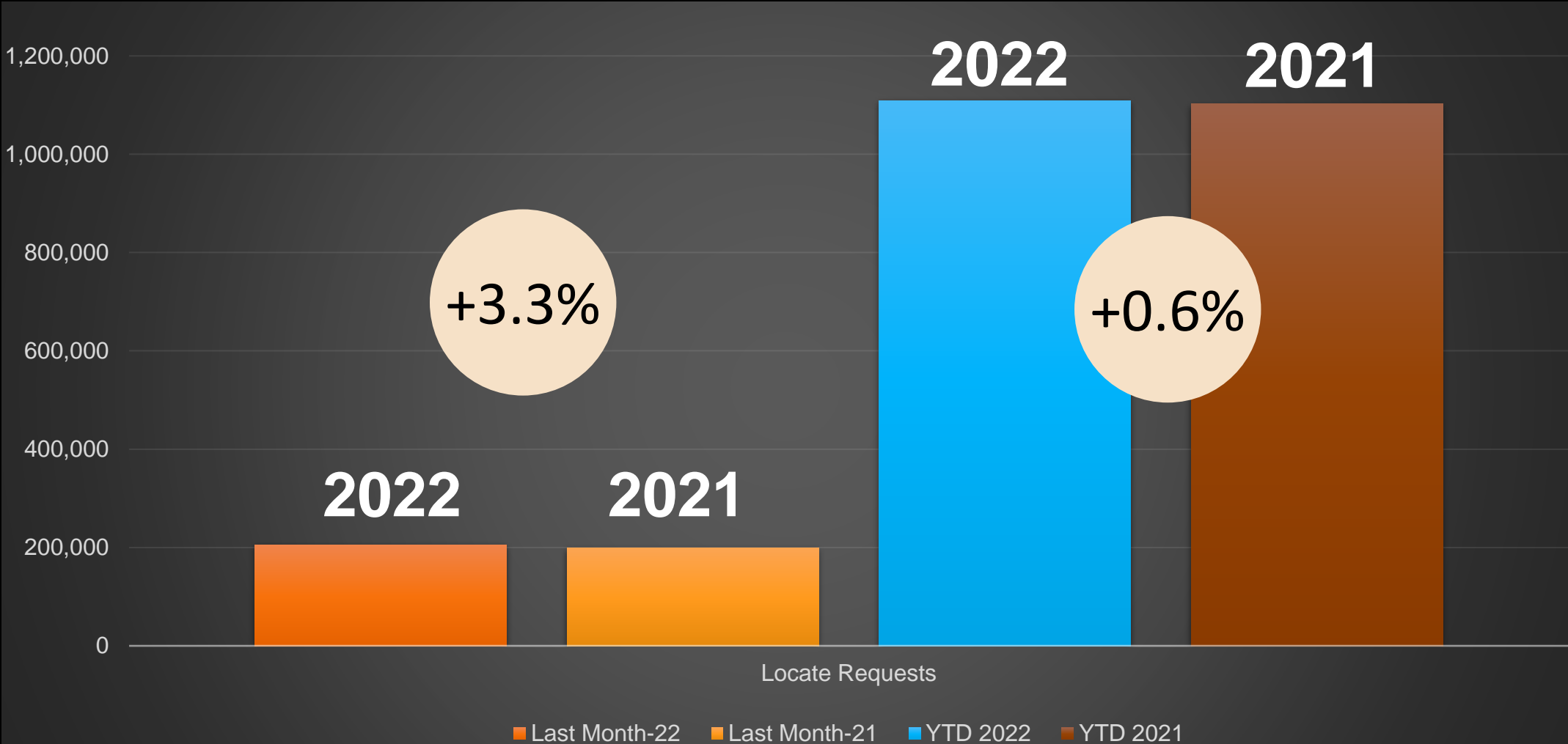

July 2022 vs 2021

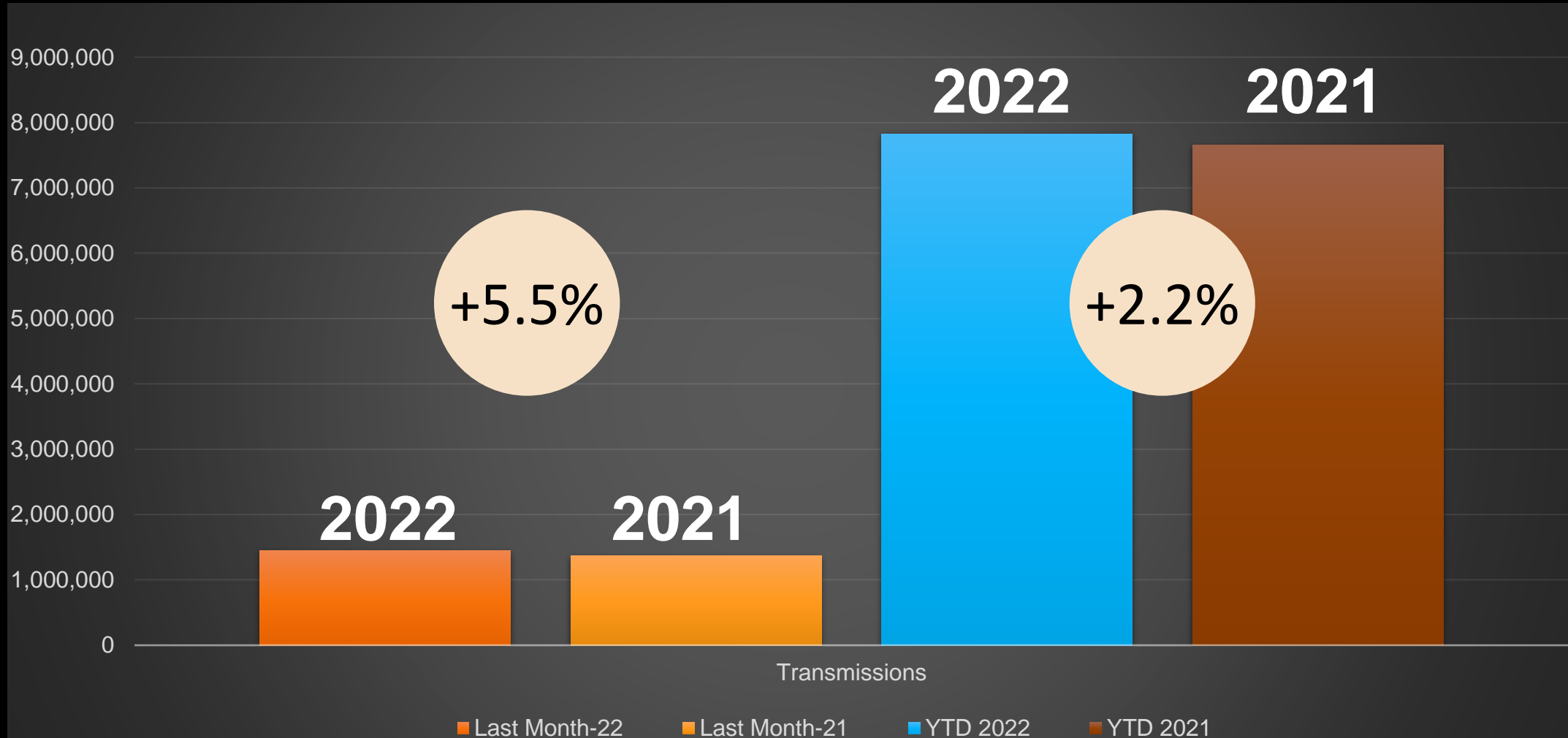
YTD 2022 vs 2021

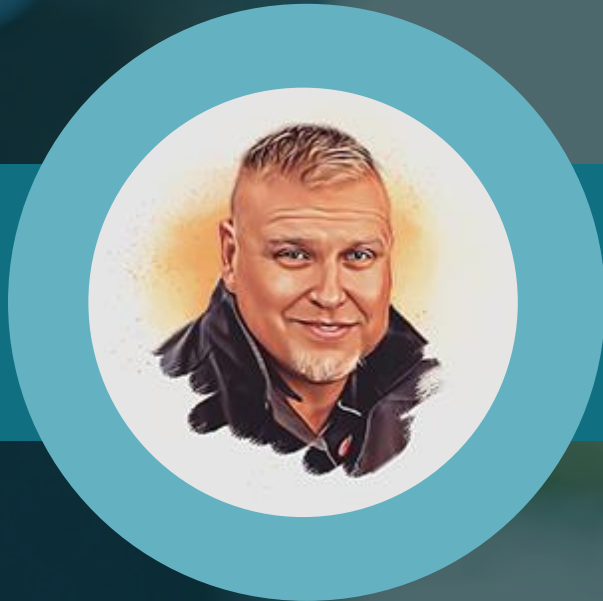

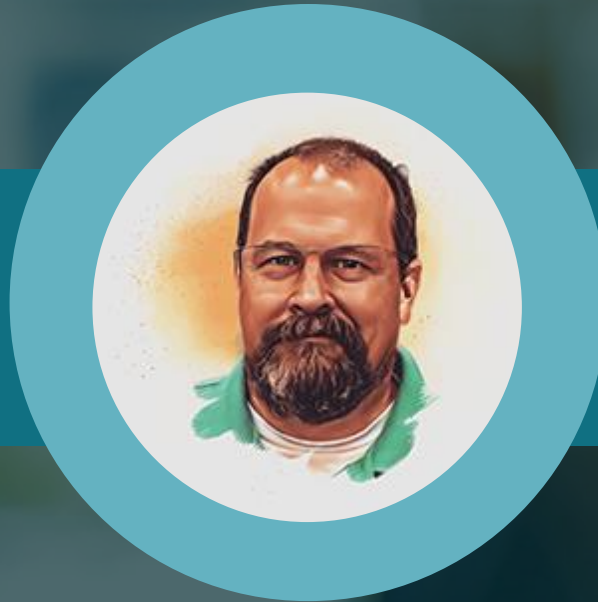

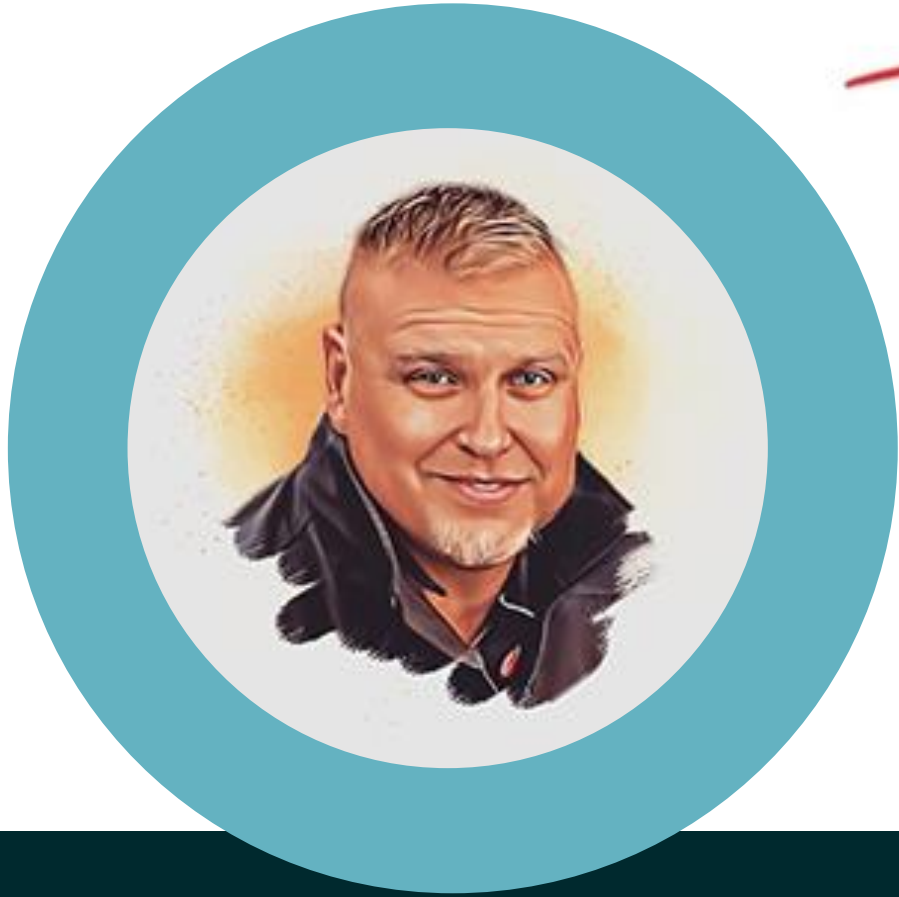

Union County UCC

August 2022

Meeting opened at 9:03

City of Monroe- Lot of subdivision work ongoing. 2" gas line cut doing road work. It was not hand dug. The excavator did not spot. Rocky River Road is having exploratory work done to see if there needs to be an increase in pressure. Making sure gas is in compliance. Union Co water main ongoing. DH Griffin is installing a thirty-six" main. V1 Fiber is calling in large amounts of locate requests and then not able to work them and updating. JAG was hoping to get a contract, calling in locates, did not get awarded the contract in certain areas.

Russ LeGault- First Call Locating Business is good. Staying very busy working with the community. If you need anything marked privately, please let him know.

Centerline Construction- Mostly working new construction in Union Co. Sewer outfall and water line 218 project. Couple of jobs at Waverly. Secret Shortcut project, Stonebridge golf course, and in Wingate at Lyncroft.

Piedmont Natural Gas- Price Dairy Road to Stanfield will be putting in a high pressure gas line (24") Cuthbertson to Providence (Appalachian Pipeline) will be another high pressure line. From Davidson to Locust will be retiring a sixteen" gas line. Price Dairy to Stanfield will be retiring a high pressure line. PNG had five hits on marked lines and four with no markings.

Comment- Reach out to Union Co see if someone will start attending again. *(I did reach out) Union Co is putting office numbers on locate requests. Please ask them to list field personnel to have someone to reach out to. *Reach out to USIC for attendance.

Next meeting will be Wednesday, Sept 7th at 9:00 am at PNG.
