
LOCATE REQUESTS IN NORTH CAROLINA







Meeting opened by Chair, Leo Brooks

Level One safety

Safety moment- School is resuming. Be on the lookout for kids and for school buses. Be aware of laws surrounding school bus safety.

NC811 Presentation given by Tami Groves

Chad - Prince TeleCom doing work for Google Fiber. Doing a few projects in the Charlotte area.

Hyper Networks – Doing work for Google Fiber. Working projects in the Cabarrus and Mecklenburg Co areas.

Scott – Piedmont Natural Gas Finished a project in Mt. Ulla.

Davon with SEC – he is a mainline supervisor with SEC. Just wrapped up a Salisbury job. Getting ready to start a project in Rowan County.

Jennifer with Compass Utility – They do mostly power. New installs and drop work for Utility Lines Construction.

Vickie Eddleman with the City of Salisbury - Sidewalk projects that I am aware of for the City Engineering:

Actively working is the sidewalk project on Ryan St starting at the Old Concord Rd in. I am not sure of the extent of this project. They are working on curb and guttering this week. If on schedule, they plant o be pouring sidewalk next week.

Upcoming projects:

Lash Dr sidewalk project: Bids are in and R&P Eudy won. City Council is to review and award the contract at their next meeting on the 16th. At which point the contractor can begin work. Sidewalk will be installed on one side of the roadway, not both sides, for the full extent of the street.

We have other projects in the works for sidewalks, but none that are at a stage which will affect this group any time soon. We have no greenway projects at the moment.

I am working to get a project going to install a city owned, decorative street light pole. This will be at the dead-end of E Franklin St, off of N Lee St. If it would not be inappropriate, could you ask the group if they are aware of any contractors who might be interested in installing the pole base and conduit stub outs. If they know of any, I will be glad to include them in the quote request that I will be sending out. Please make sure they understand, any suggestions will not be considered an endorsement but rather information sharing for the competitive bid process. Often these contractors are few and can be hard to find.
