

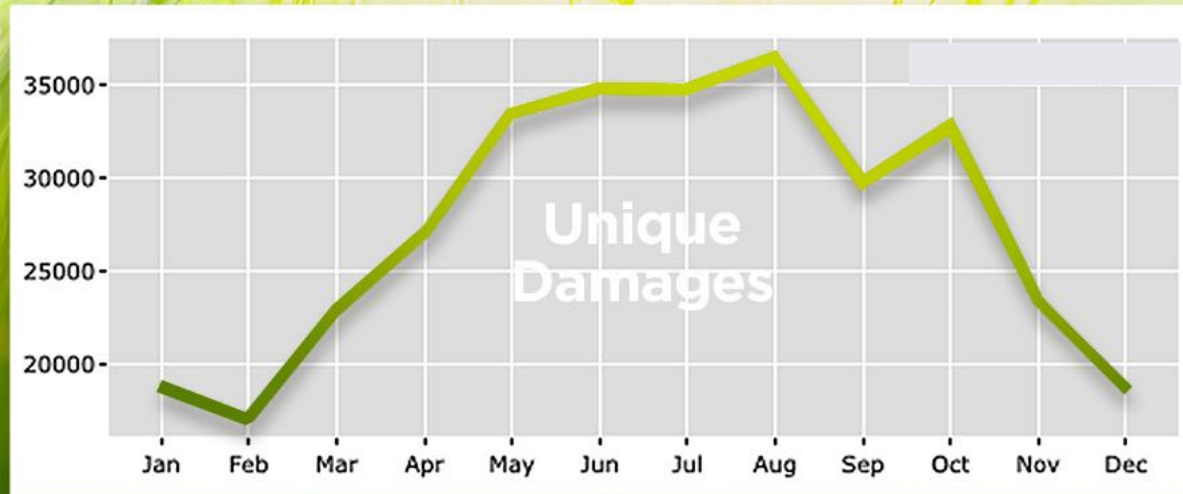

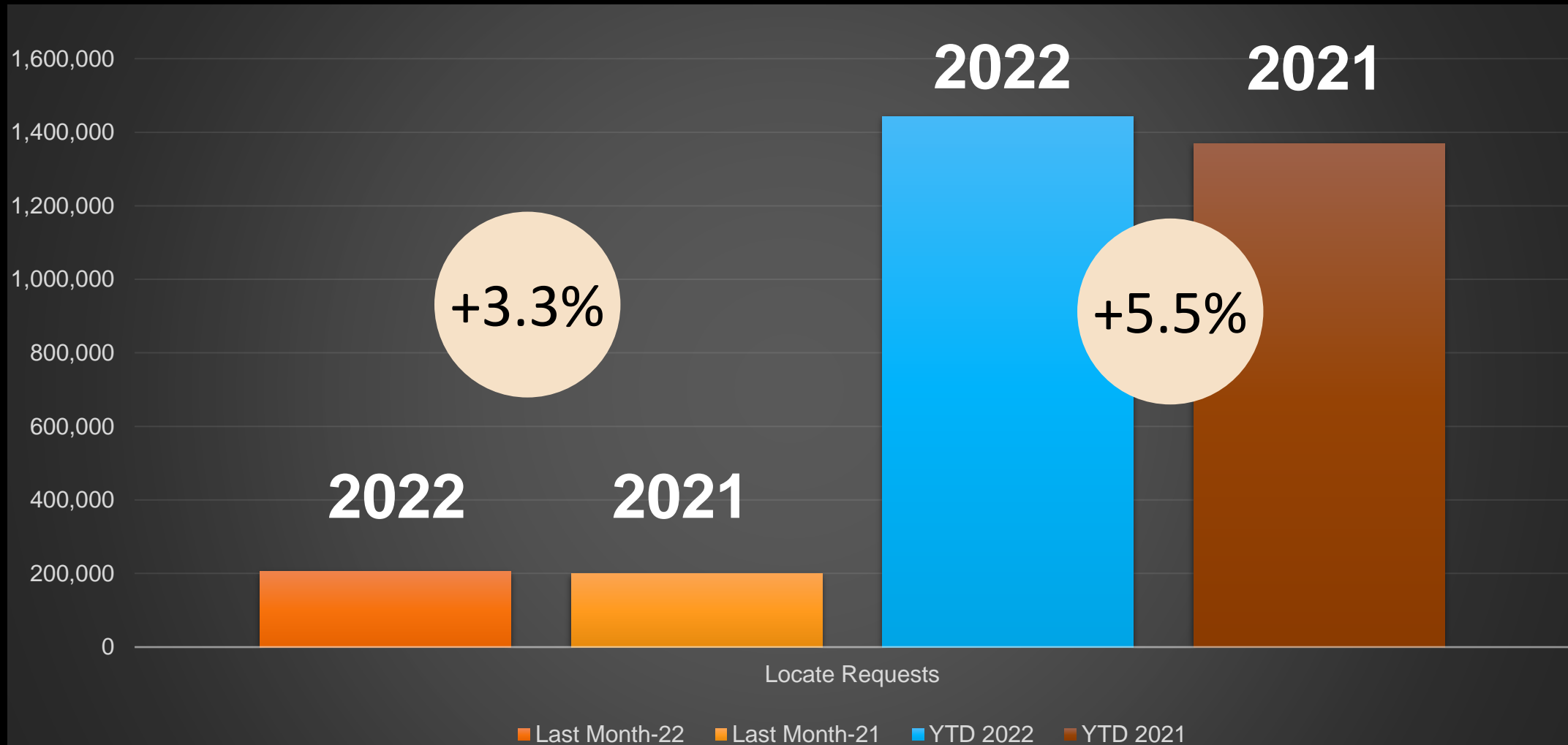

July 2022 vs 2021

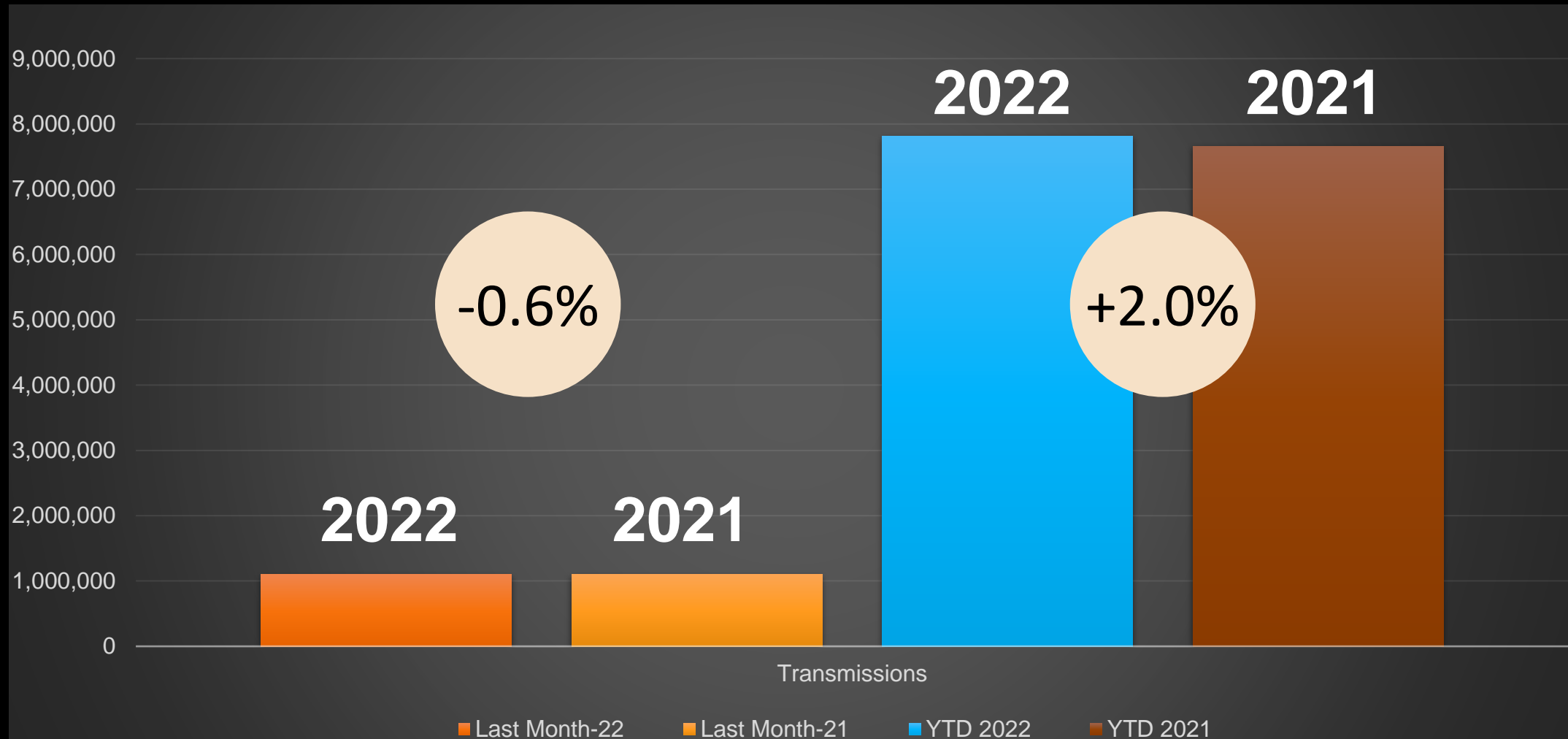
YTD 2022 vs 2021

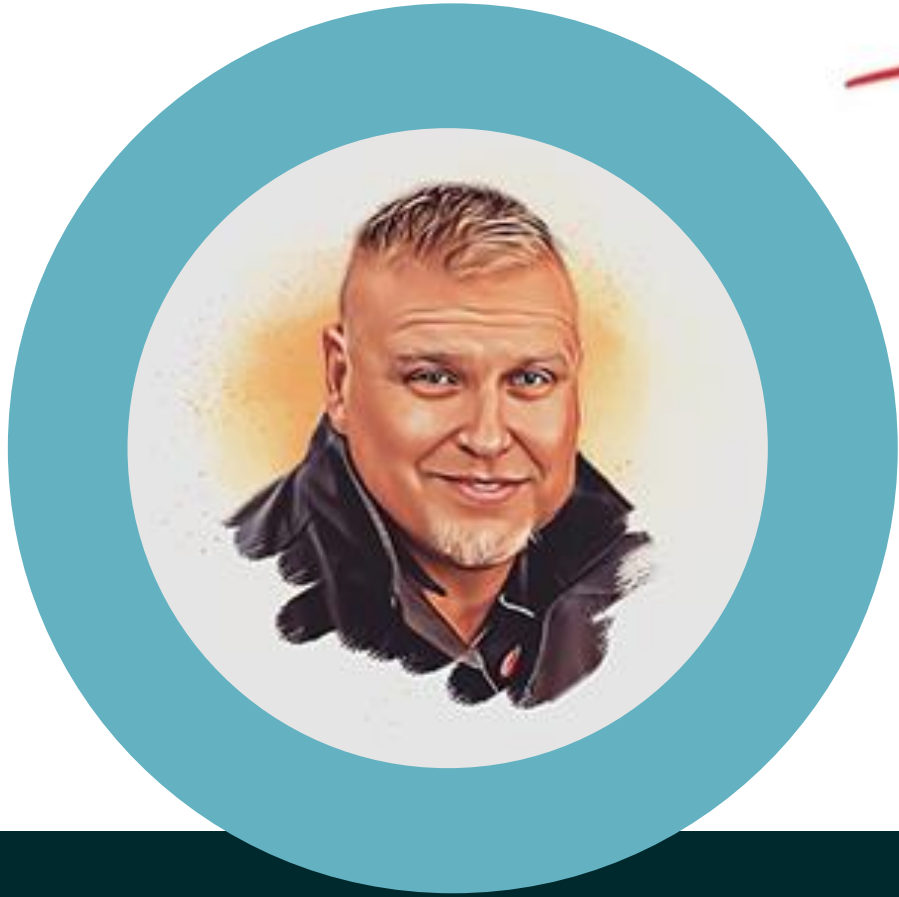

North Carolina 811 presentation given by Tami Groves

Round table discussion –

Heath Consultants – no concerns at the current time. Staying busy.

There is a new contact with Metronet. Will reach out to see if we can get information. They may be using missiles and digging where they indicated.

City of Newton – Working on grants to extend sewer service toward Charlotte. Very busy. “A” street residential sewer has been completed. Working on sewer test on 2nd Street. Not quite complete. New neighborhoods going in with over 2300 new homes to be constructed. Waiting on supplies. Ductile iron is fifty two weeks behind. Meters won’t be in stock until after February.

City of Hickory – like everyone else. Very busy and running behind.

Dominion Energy – Town of Taylorsville – working on gas to Alexander County Courthouse. New washerette and forensics spot.

Neill Grading - a lot of business. They have a tremendous amount of work both residential and commercial. They purchased Hickory Sand. Doing industrial work in Gaston. Apartment complex on Startown Road. Townhouse project at the past Trivium. Finishing project in Conover and still working on project at City Walk.

City of Hickory – traffic division – retiring 321 corridor. Same issues with supply chain. Can not getting controllers right now. Trying to keep up with shortages and locates.

Phillip Lowe introduced at the new Operations Manager for Hickory.

Next meeting September 21st at PNG, 10:00AM
