

County ticket volume and distribution







4. **SPECIAL REMINDERS:**

- <u>Damage Reporting</u>: Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro.
- Below is the website where you can go to communicate "Damage Violations."

- <u>ALWAYS!</u> If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a <u>Gas Line</u>, do the following in this order:
 - Call 911 to report the accident!
 - Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!
 - Call 811 to report the accident to our office!

5. <u>Tami Groves - NC 811 Comments</u>:

- Tami announced that Tyler Ross from Asheville will become the new NC811 UCC "western region" representative. He will begin meeting with our chapter in January 2023.
- Remember, if you request a locate via the telephone, use the call back feature if you are put on hold. It works well, and they will call you back!

- You MUST have voicemail if you call in a locate. This is because if a utility
 needs to get additional information, you will receive the message and can get
 back to them to help resolve any problems that may come up on the locate.
- <u>Important:</u> If you have damaged made to your systems, be sure and file a COMPLAINT. File the complaint against the parent company not the locator service provider. Remember, to take several photographs from various angles to be submitted with you written claim.
