


County ticket volume and distribution





Meeting opened by Chair, David Burr at 10:10 AM

PeeDee Electric- Finished project on Stanback Ferry/Mill Orchard. Pole replacements. Load driven because of poultry houses. PeeDee wants to be bottom on the trench. Sometimes hard to do. Don't want to share trench. Morven area-pole change outs. PeeDee covers Union, Stanly, Anson, Richmond, Montgomery, Scotland, and Moore counties. Had a few outages from Hurricane Ian. More trouble in Moore and Scotland counties.

Town of Peachland-seeing a lot of growth. Not currently a member but working with Lesley currently. Condos being constructed in Peachland on US74.

NCDOT-Few small pipe replacements. Smaller jobs. City Pond Road bridge project.

Anson Co Schools-main things located between buildings. Lots of private. New high school possibly in the works.

Colliers Engineering-Project Atlas discussion. Collect layers of utilities. Burial, wetland, etc. Trying to build around for planning purposes. This information stays with NCDOT. Will not be shared outside.


742 bridge- 25% plans on bridge work. Minimum utilities in the area as of right now. 2024 to let project.
