ID Your Marks



Locators, be sure to identify the facility operator who owns the line being marked.

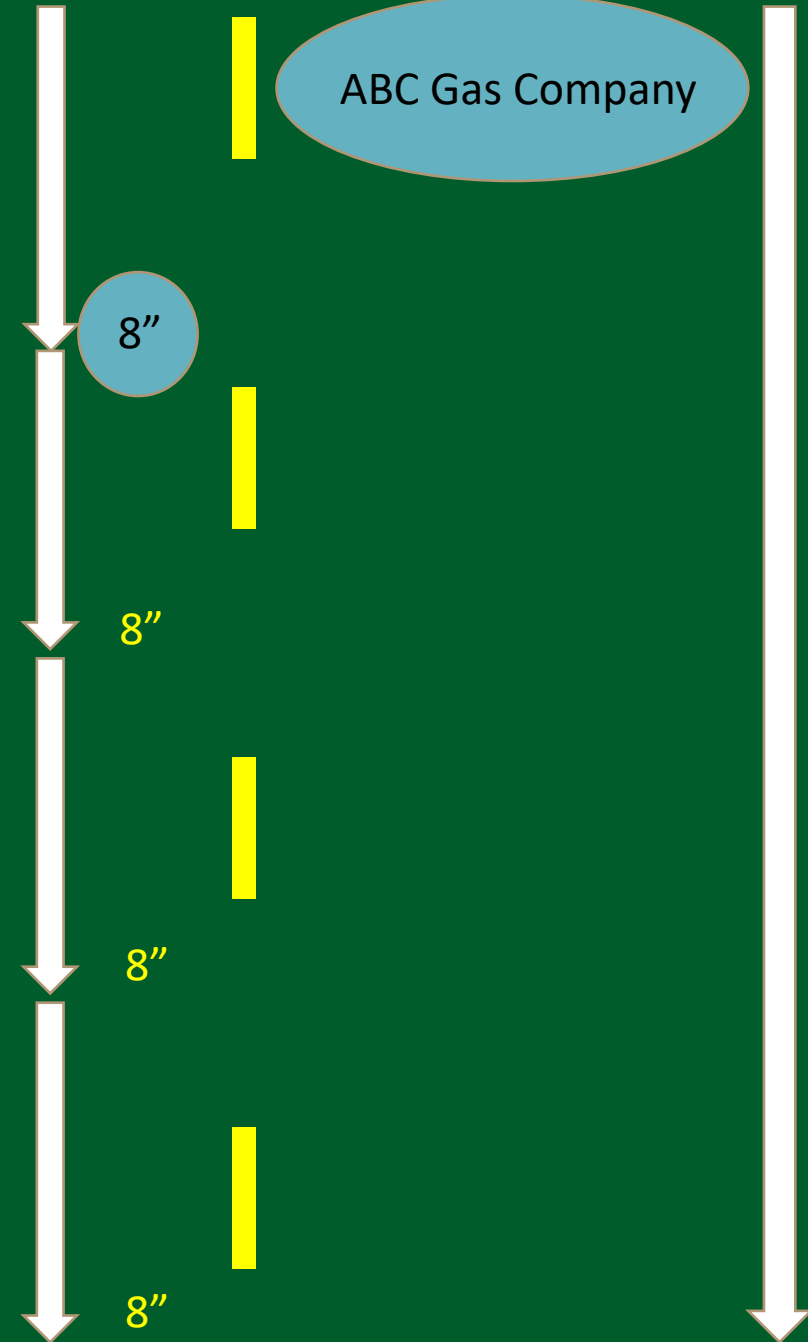
See the Underground Utility Safety and Damage Prevention Act section 87-121 (1a) for marking identity info

PLEASE NOTE

If the diameter or width of the facility is greater than four inches, the dimension of the facility shall be indicated at least every 50 feet in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition. An operator who operates multiple facilities in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition shall locate each facility.

The operator's identity, marked as provided in subdivision (1) of this subsection, in the area where the proposed excavation or demolition is to occur. At a minimum, the operator's identity shall be marked at the beginning point, at intervals of 200 linear feet, and at the end point of the proposed excavation or demolition.

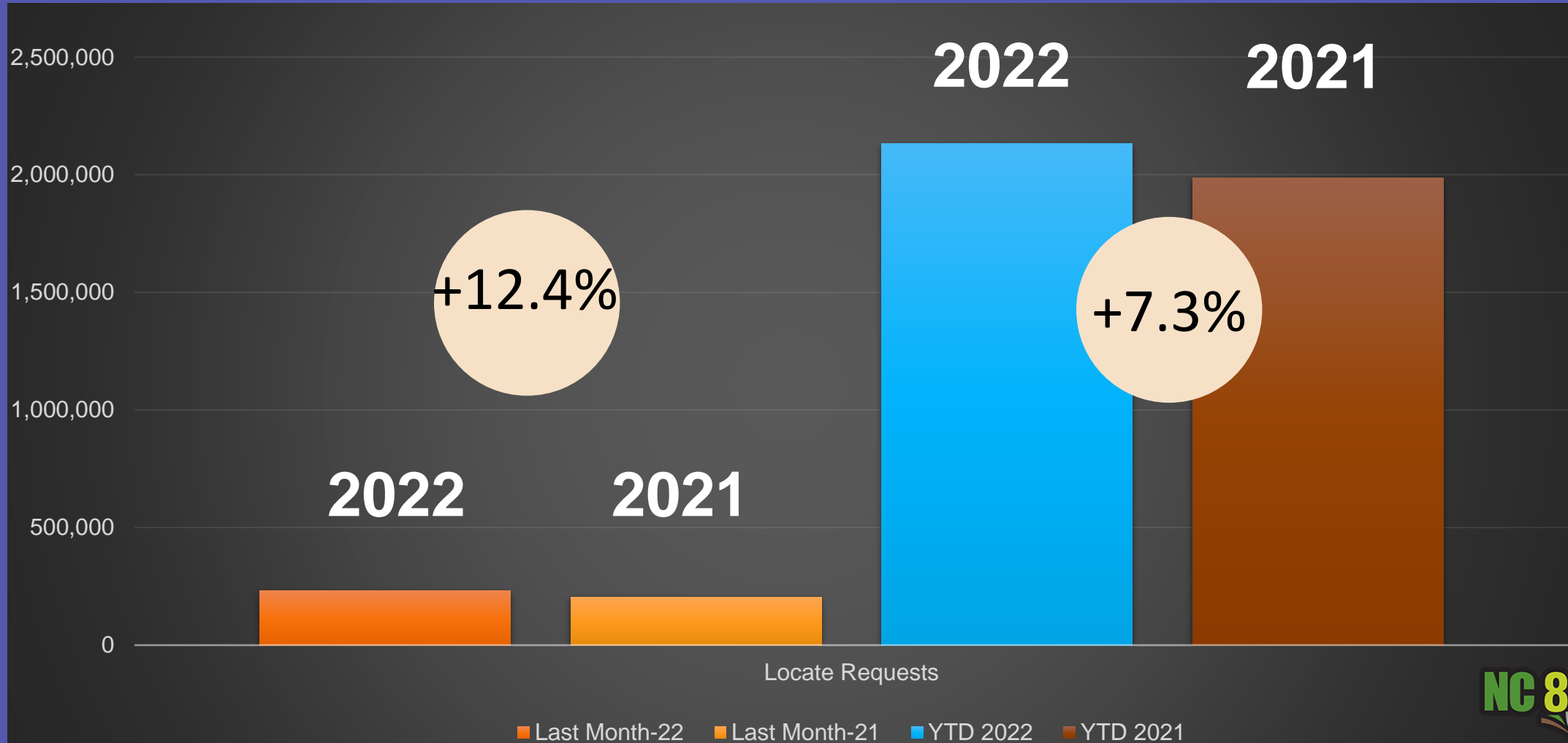

OCT 2022 vs 2021

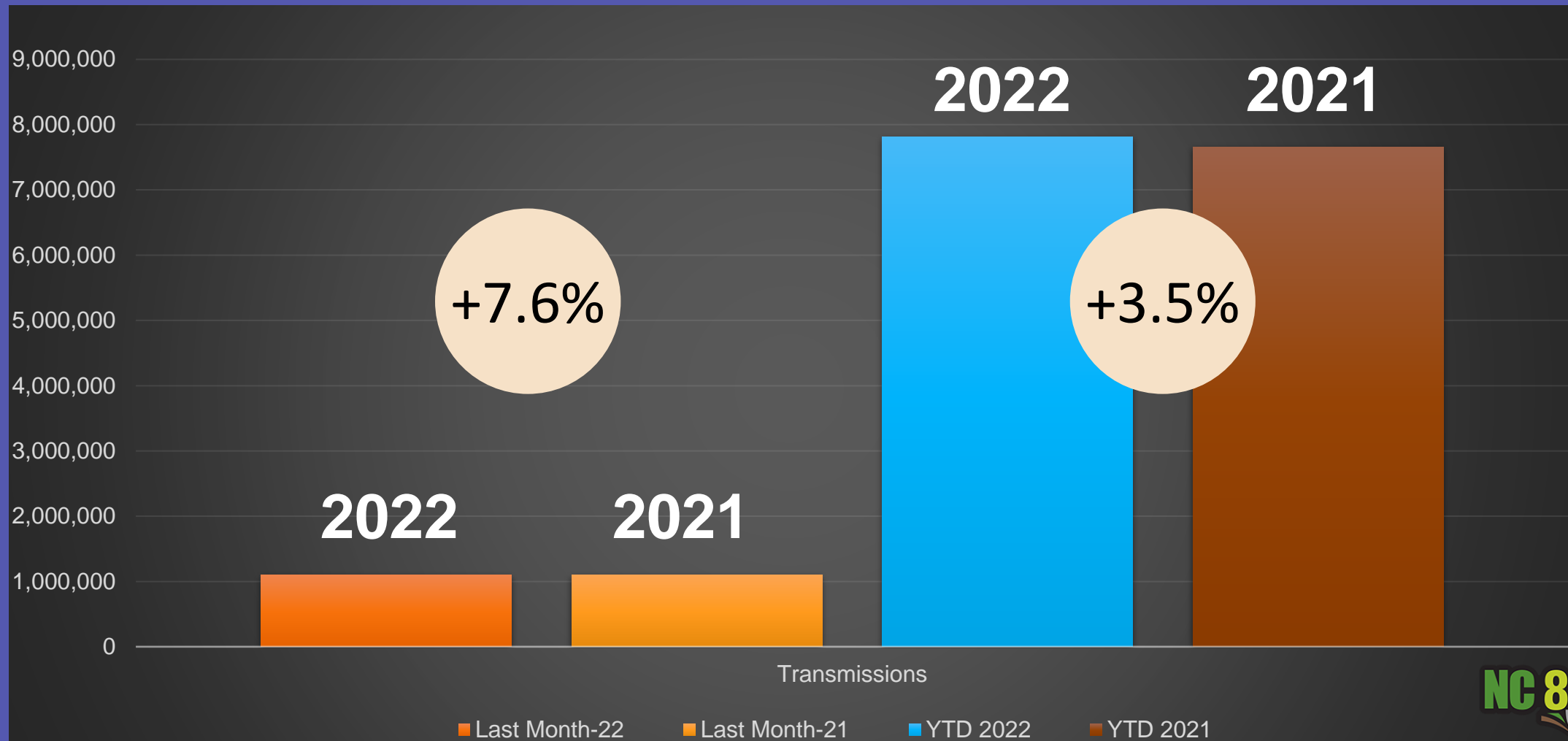
YTD 2022 vs 2021

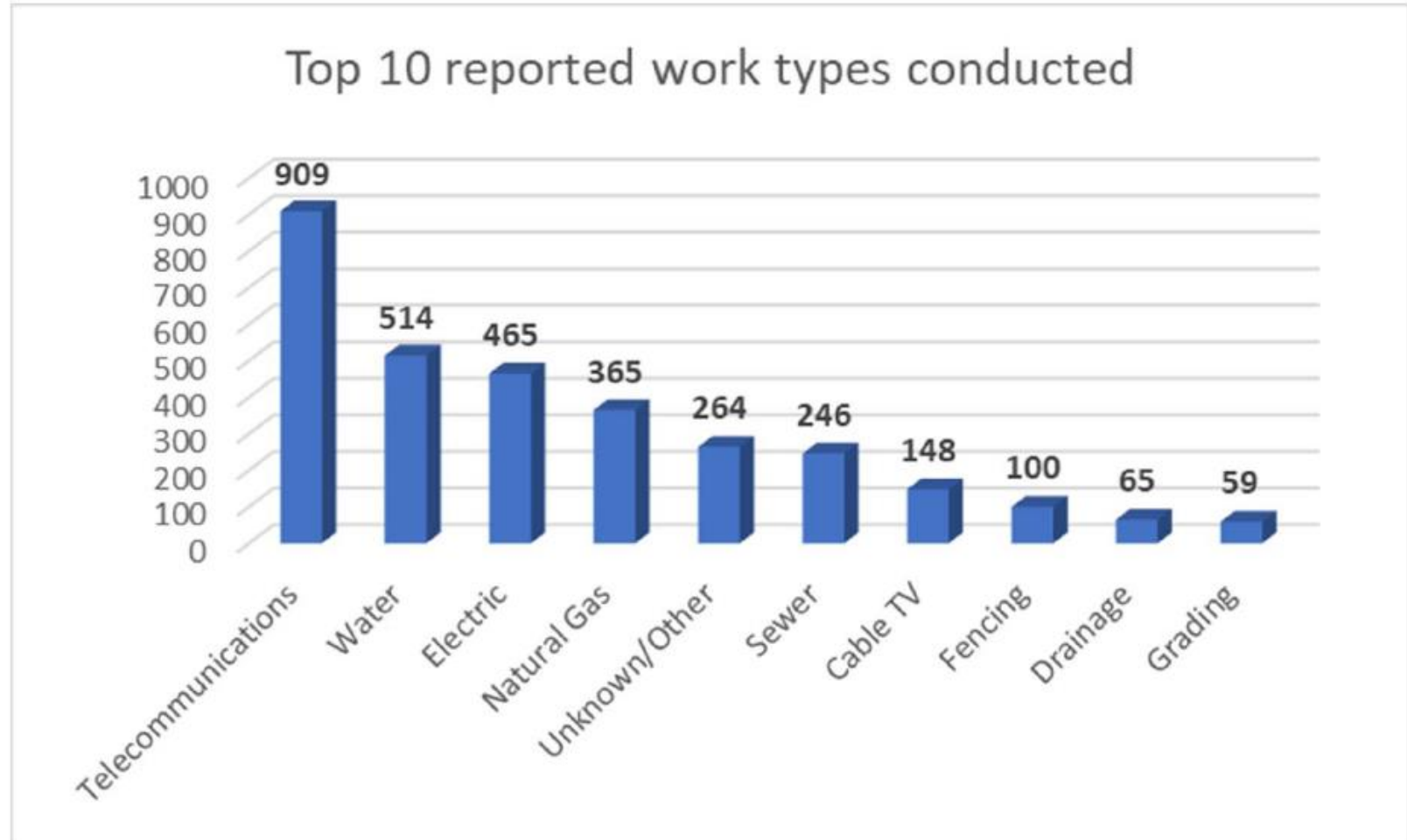

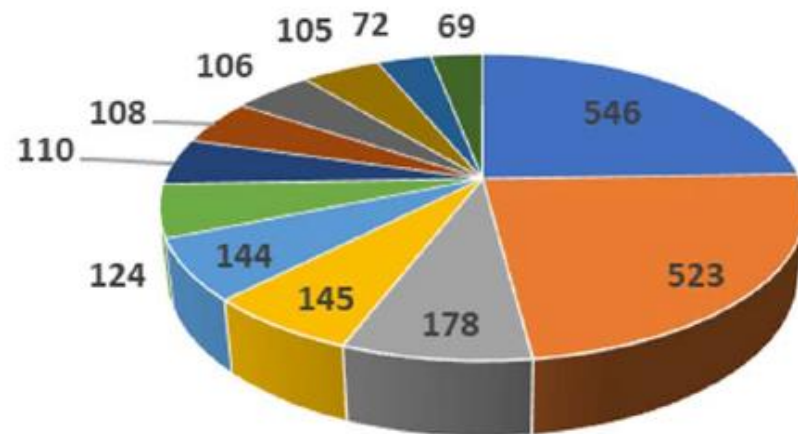

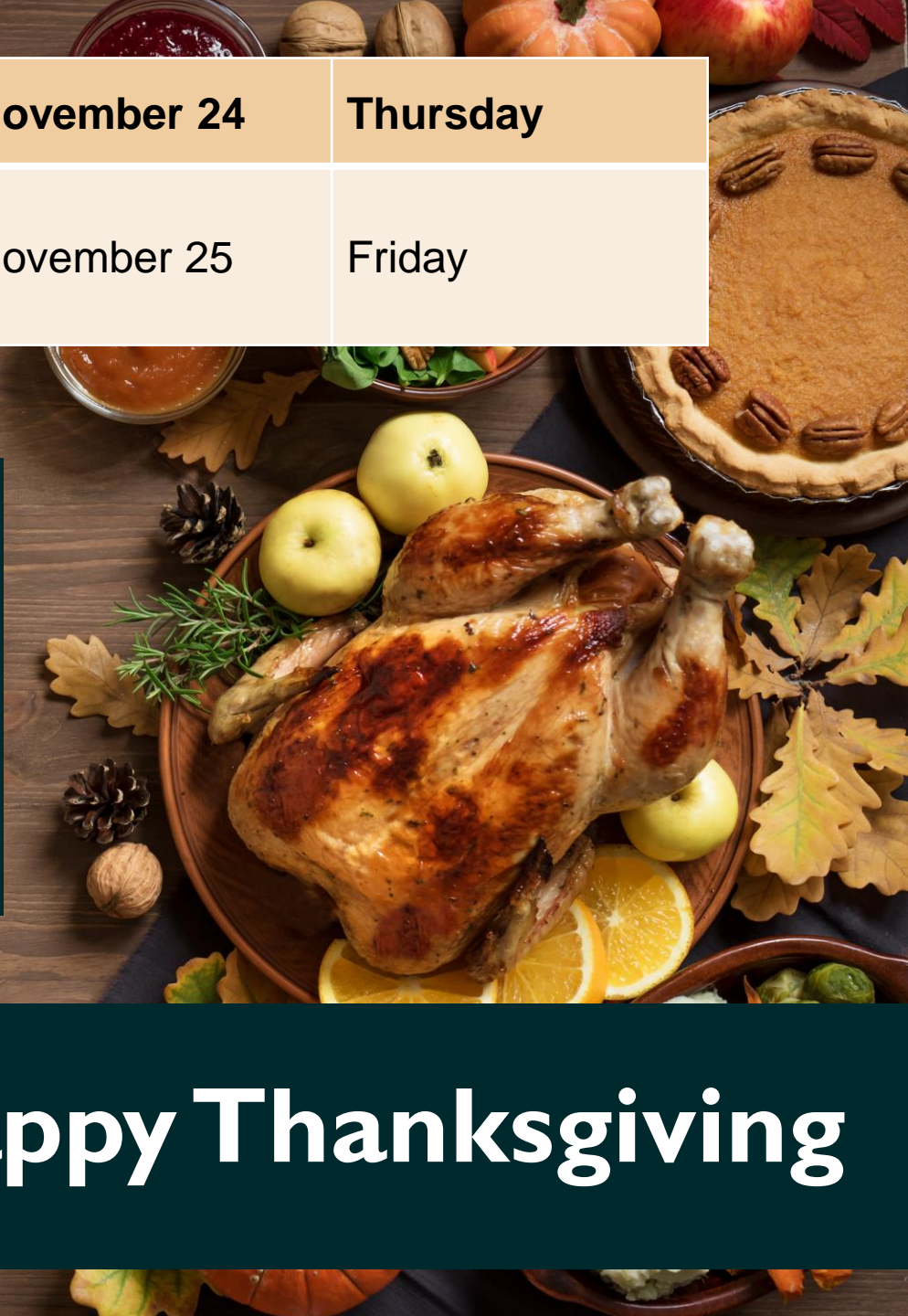

NCDOT – Boggs has started on the 211 project. Duke is ready to being. Lot of pressure on the US Open projects. Lots of regular projects in delay. Possible mega site in Scotland County for Spectrum. That is handled out of Florence SC. Possibility of realigning Hwy 5 at Morganton with DOT but still unknown.

Spectrum – Highway 5 at the golf course. Duke will be going underground at the par 3 course. Par 3 is part of Pinehurst. Morganton Road to the low clearance bridge. Railroad is building a new spur. Spectrum and Brightspeed had to move. *Conterra had to shut down a project. Logging truck came by and pulled cable from the hands of an employee who was in the bucket working. Traffic safety is not just for law enforcement/EMS/fire services. Move over for utility workers/locators, etc. Spectrum will be having more of a presence at the meetings.

Southern Pines – Clearing has started for the Target shopping site. Morganton/Patriot – new Walgreens and another commercial store. On Pembroke, moving arial to underground at the chicken restaurant. Do not want overhead.
