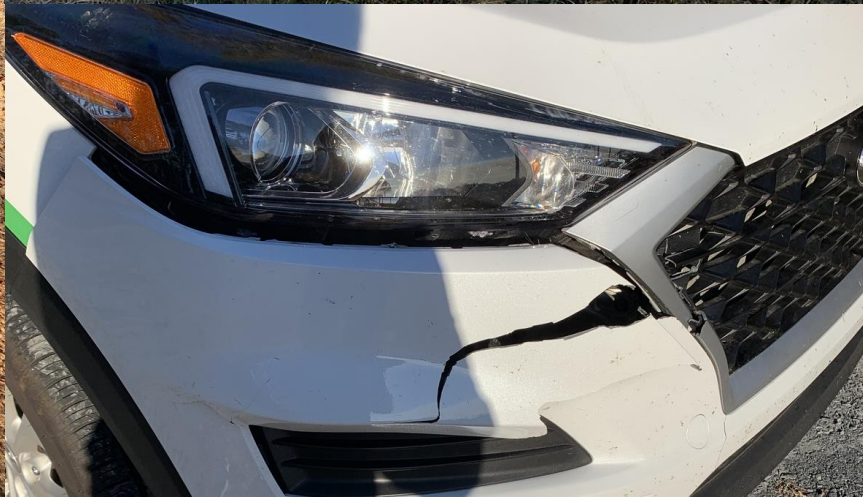

# ID Your Marks



Locators, be sure to identify the facility operator who owns the line being marked.

See the Underground Utility Safety and Damage Prevention Act section 87-121 (1a) for marking identity info

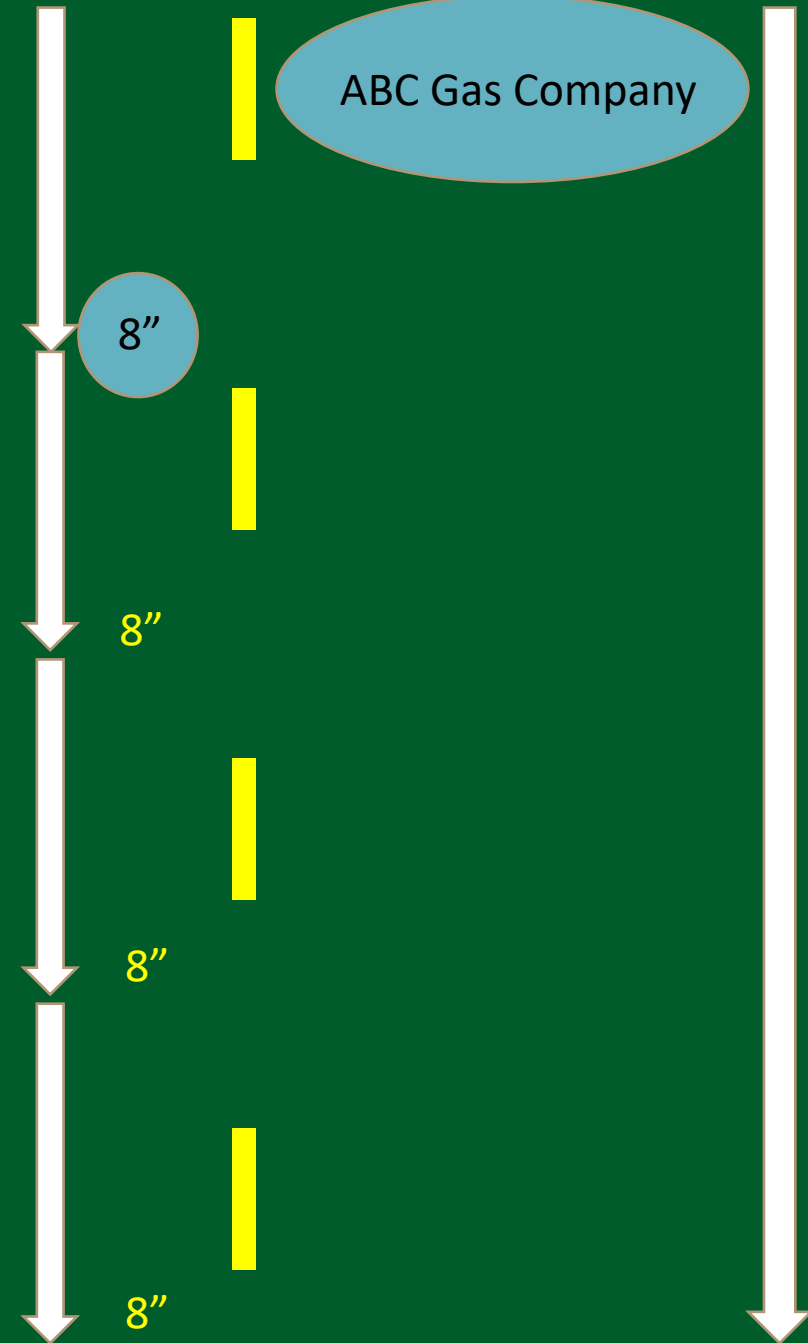


# PLEASE NOTE

If the diameter or width of the facility is greater than four inches, the dimension of the facility shall be indicated at least every 50 feet in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition. An operator who operates multiple facilities in the area of the proposed excavation or demolition shall locate each facility.

The operator's identity, marked as provided in subdivision (1) of this subsection, in the area where the proposed excavation or demolition is to occur. At a minimum, the operator's identity shall be marked at the beginning point, at intervals of 200 linear feet, and at the end point of the proposed excavation or demolition.

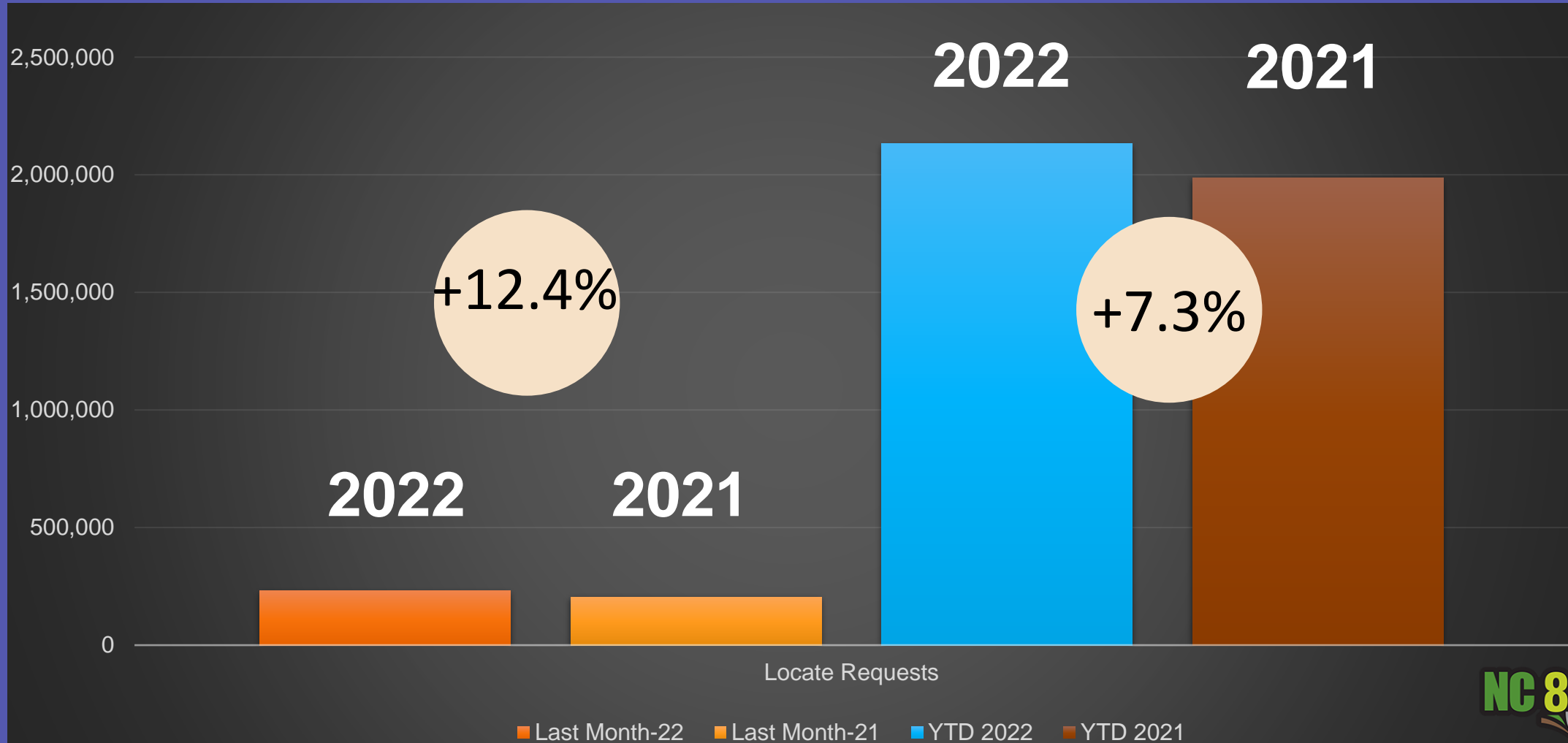




# LOCATE REQUESTS IN NORTH CAROLINA

YTD 2022 vs 2021

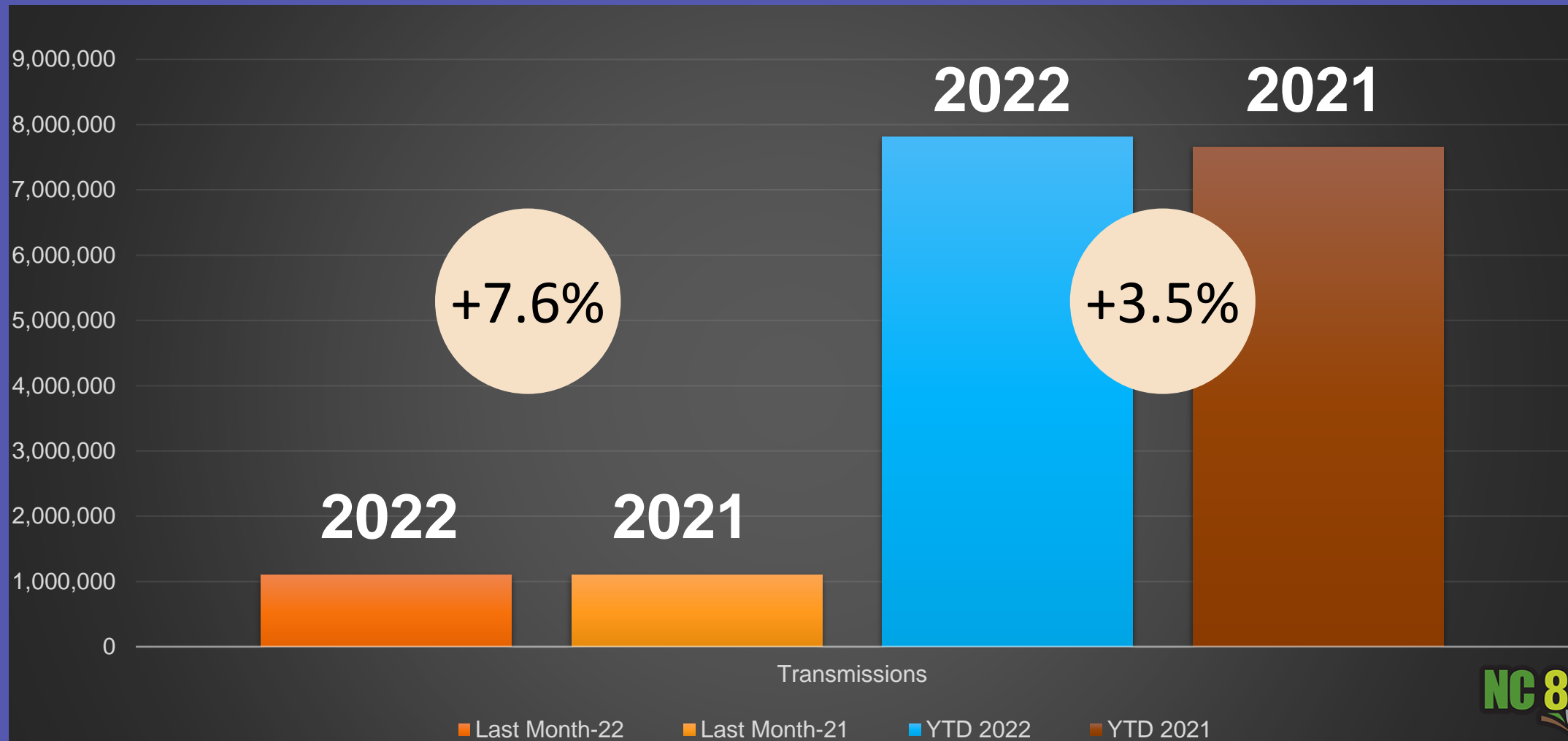

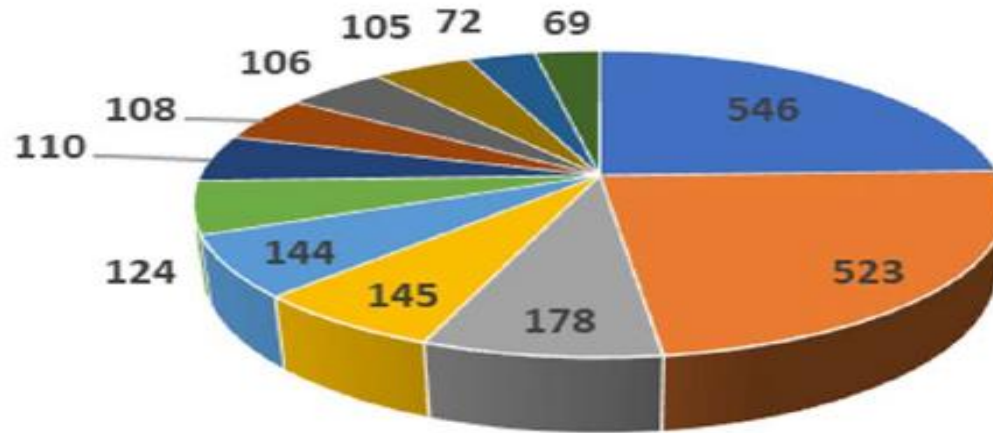

Piedmont Natural Gas had three damages. Two lines struck that were marked, one with no locate request. New pipeline on transmission side. Price Dairy at the bypass to Stanly Co. Blasting. Blasting co is doing locate requests.

City of Monroe- sewer outfall. Gas department had cut services. No locates from homeowners. CSD-Carolina Site Development-no locate requests. Dickerson Blvd-gas line 120' exposed. Gas line ruptured. Subdivisions as always. Lot of work. Ten subdivisions ongoing right now. 49 are on the books. Thirty are approved.

Union County- DH Griffin doing water line for the county. Drilling holes. Blasting at night. CIP Project-very large project.

Rocky River Road-at Ron's. No locates for communications.

Badger-Staying very busy. Happy to provide any help at all. Lots of locates showing no conflict but there are def utilities. Lake Park to Waxhaw. Also doing work in Hamlet. Want to see gas lines-eyes on and depths.
