
County ticket volume and distribution

#### III. Old Business

- Scott Huffstetler with Dominion discussed taking over as chair for Chase, who has moved into a new position.
- Scott asked for anyone who would be interested in being the vice-chair to reach out
- Scott discussed the desire to move the meeting around to encourage participation from other members who were not present. The January meeting will be at Dominion and Tyler and Scott will work with other members to host in their areas. Tyler will coordinate finding a restaurant that can accommodate per each area.
