

- **I.** Call to Order
- **II.** Narrative: Scott Huffstetler presented NC 811 presentation on behalf of Tyler Ross due to rescheduling meeting and conflicting with an existing UCC meeting.
- III. Round Table Reports
  - Discussed in the meeting excavators calling in tickets 2-3 month prior to work being done and then resubmitting multiple times after project was complete. Mainly fiber projects. Seems to be a continual issue that everyone is dealing with. Also discussed white lining issues. Is there any proposal that white lining will become NC 811 Law. Has several new attendees. Discussed scheduling our monthly meetings in Gastonia, Cherryville, Kings Mtn, Shelby and some other possible location in 2023, All like the idea. Also started some talk about our contractor breakfast in April at the Honey Hunters Ballfield. I have all ready be in touch with them about using their facility. We will need to discuss who is going to pay the \$500 bill to use it in our Feb meeting and biscuits and drinks cost.
