


County ticket volume and distribution

# NOV 2022 vs 2021 YTD 2022 vs 2021



Piedmont Natural Gas is working on a transmission line to Stanly County.


Union County is working on water project – New Salem Road, Rocky River Road, Highway 138 (Stanfield)

City of Monroe still working a lot of subdivisions. Some small fiber projects on Goldmine Road.


Open Fiber – more volume coming – Indian Trail
