#### **WCUCC** Meeting

#### January 24, 2023

Level 1 safety brief was conducted- all emergency procedures were reviewed

Morgan Hill welcomed everybody and introduced Howard Corey from NC811.

Howard shared with everyone the NC811 highlights from the month and showed all the community events they have sponsored and been a part of.

Howard reviewed the data for Wayne County for the month of December 2022. From December 2022 vs. December 2021, we had a 5% increase in locate tickets and year to date we have had a 7% increase for the state of North Carolina. During this time frame transmissions also increased a little under 3% for the December-to-December comparison as well as 3.5 % year to date.

Wayne county ticket volume saw a 29% increase from December-to-December with an average of 72 locates per day and year to date Wayne County averaged 84 locates per day. The year-to-date vs previous year showed improvements with 3 hours locate request down almost 60% from the previous year and update tickets showing an increase of 13%.

The towns with the highest ticket volume within Wayne County were/are Dudley, Goldsboro, Pikeville, and Mount Olive. The top 3 callers for Wayne County were Knight Broadband, LLC, Mastec, and Ansco & Associates.

Howard was happy to report that for the month of December there were only 4 damages reported for Wayne County!


