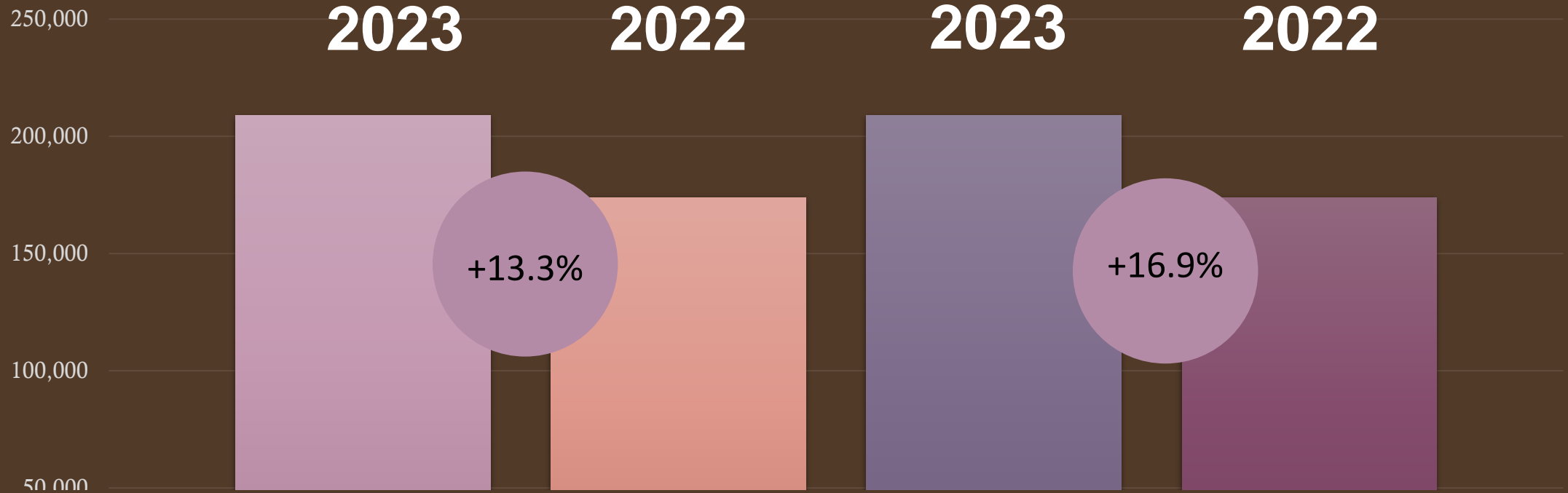

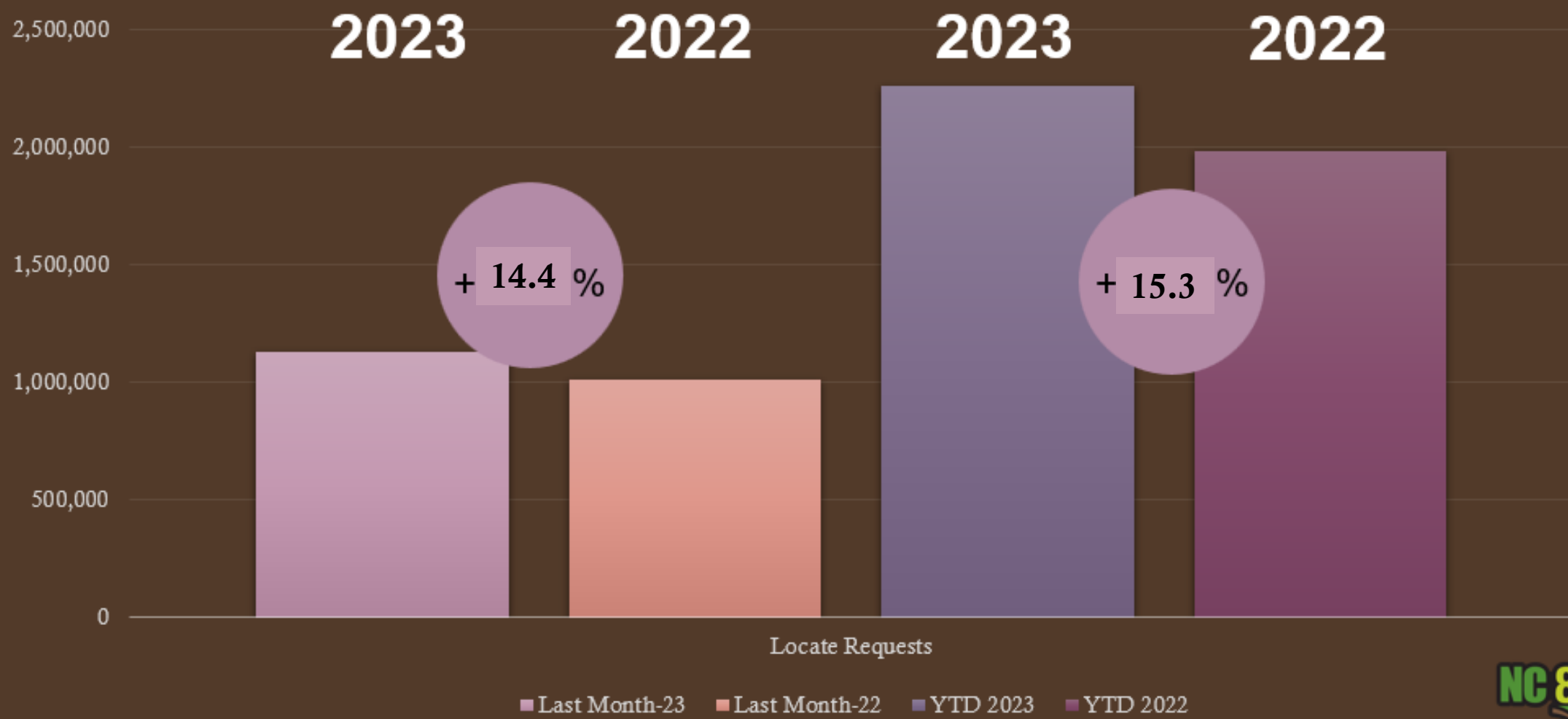

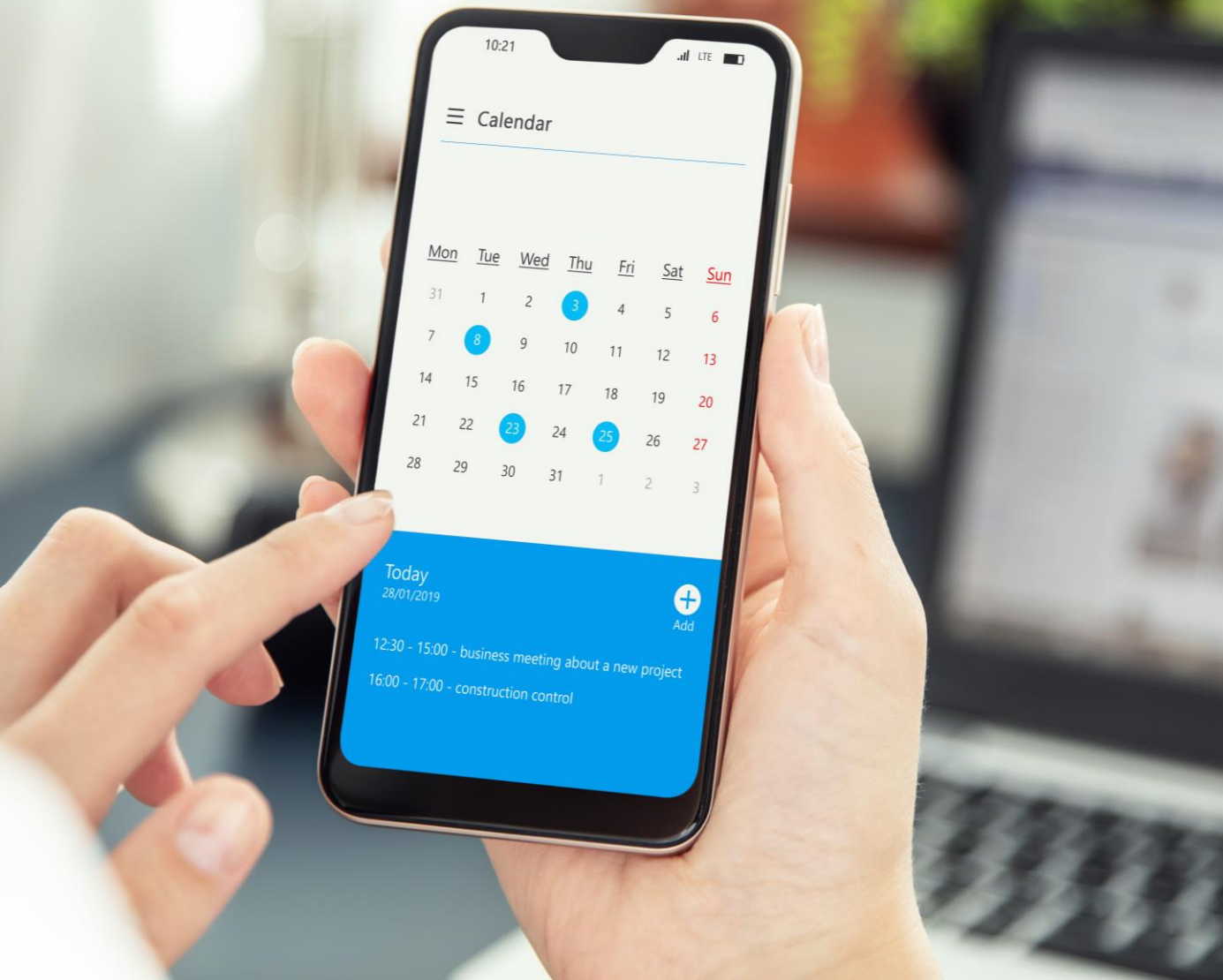

North Carolina 811 presentation given by Tami Groves

Pee Dee Electric – Lots of poultry houses, Bennett Road/Rockingham Road. Airport Road/Osborne pole replacements. Section of bridge removed for DOT at Sandhill Road. Will be replaced on DOT is complete. Spectrum will be doing some joint use on poles. Will require some pole replacements. Co that manufactures ink for potato chip bags and Woodmark on the bypass are both doing additions. TRC will be counting poles for Pee Dee.

Piedmont Natural Gas – Carlos Torres-Diaz has taken John Parsons position. Happy to help. PNG is rerouting lines on transmission and dropping pressure. Have retirements coming for line 88 and line 68. If a line is inactive for five years, it will come out of service.

City of Rockingham – City of a small sewer project Rockingham to Hamlet on US 74 to serve new medical facility in the building process. Otherwise, day to day business.
