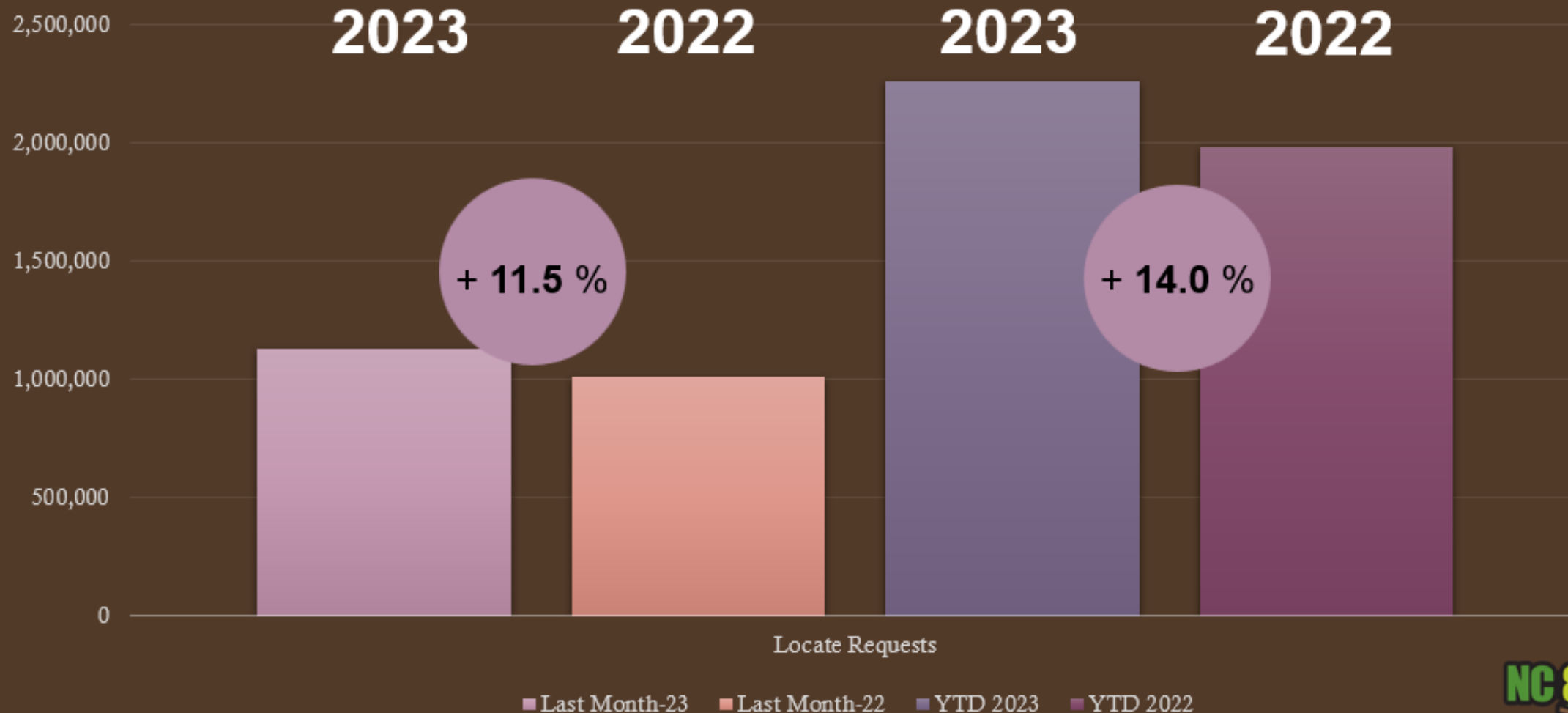

Railroad crossing safety discussion

Piedmont Natural Gas – Still working on the line from Union County to Stanly County. Will need to decommission two lines and then another at the end of the year. There were four damages in Union County. One was a no-call damage.

Union County – Kyle Long with the Water Dept spoke briefly about a couple of damages. No information on the damages. Water main still in work from Lake Tillery to Union Co.

NCDOT – Several roundabouts in the county. Old Charlotte Highway will be in a widening project. A couple of complaints about damages from fiber work. Just a reminder to work safely. There are lists of projects on the NCDOT website for each project.

Lawrence Surveying – nothing to report. Happy to be in attendance.

City of Monroe – Continuing work on residential projects. Lot of gas to residential customers in new subdivisions. One damage to a marked line. It was struck with a shovel.

Open Fiber – Next phase book on the table at PNG to review. One damage to their line. A lid was shut and knocked out service to the county.

DH Griffin has a 30" line from Union to to the City of Monroe. Gas main will be gassed up in the next seven to ten days. Lawyers Road to Price Dairy Road getting ready to merge.

VEA Telecom – nothing to report.
