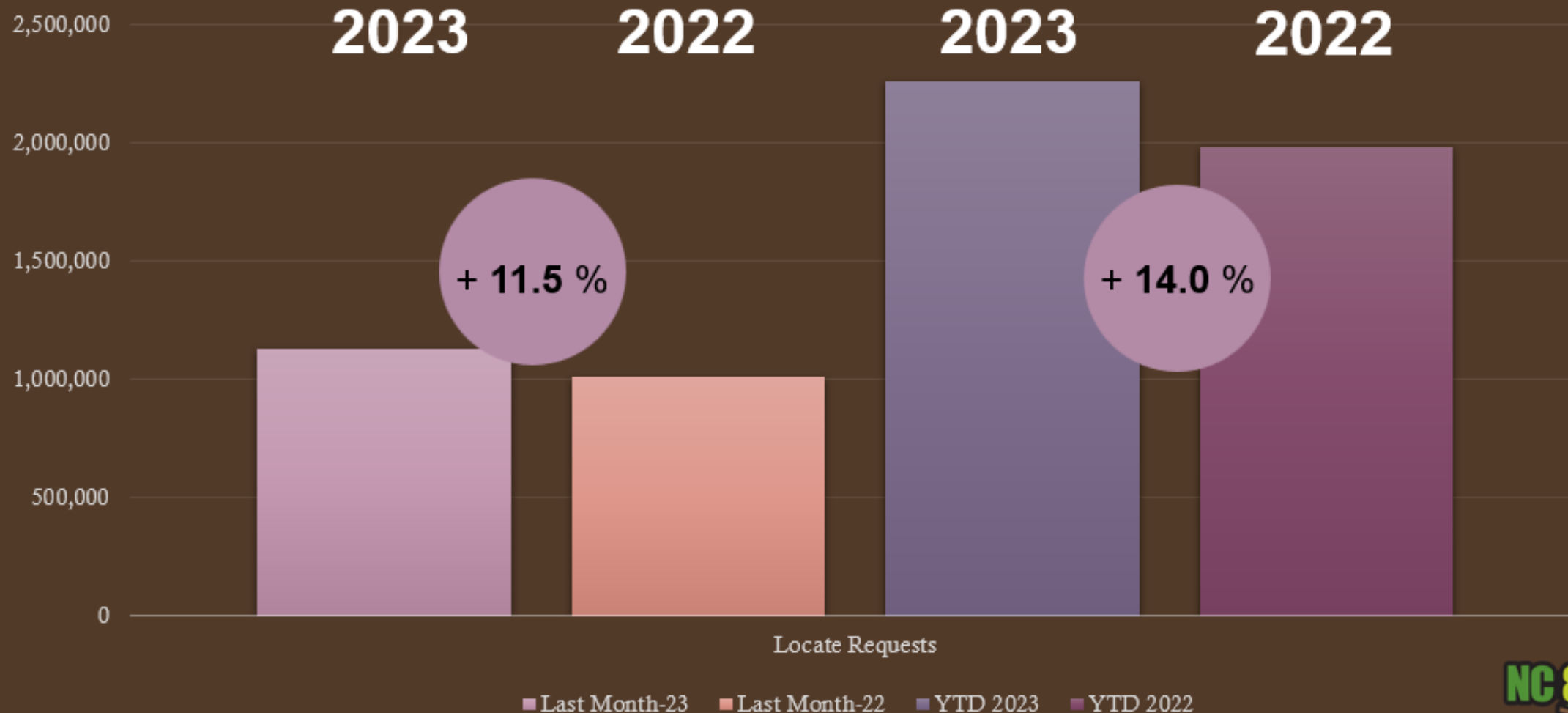

3. **Damage Reporting:** Remember that if you damage an underground utility, it is **your responsibility to report this damage to NC 811 UCC. Offices in Greensboro.**

 - **ALWAYS!** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a **Gas Line**, do the following in this order:
 - **Call 911 to report the accident!**
 - **Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!**
 - **Call 811 to report the accident to our office!**
4. **Round-table Discussions:**
- **David Wortman – Town of Rhodhiss:** Nothing to report. All is going well.
 - **Kevin Clark – Brentwood Water Corp.:** Installing quite a few taps. Several mobile home parks have been installing additional taps, so they can have fewer units on these existing single tap which control the entire park. Things are running smooth right now, allowing training to go forth for two newer employees. Also allowing for general maintenance items to be done.
 - **Doug Suttles – Suttles Surveying:** Finishing up the KFC project in Morganton, across from McDonald's at the West Union Crossroads. The WPCC project is also being completed.
- Note:** Suttles Surveying has been experiencing problems with USIC in general not getting the locates done in a timely manner. In several cases, they simply have not made locate at all!
- **Jim Buckner & Rodney Roland – Rutherford Electric Membership Association (REMC):** Still doing a lot of pole replacements. This is an ongoing

project that is going to take several more months. They currently do not have any major projects in the works.

REMC: Would like Tyler to discuss at the next meeting the changes that are going to be taking place with locates and communications about locates planned by NC 811 for the near future.

The information they have seen is confusing as it relates to how ticket information, fees, and the internet base system will be used.

- 5. NC 811 Banner Distribution: REMC and Brentwood Water Corporation have displayed the NC 811 UCC Banners at their location. In the past, Brian Morehouse of NC 811 actually brought the banners to one of our meetings rather than the members having to go to Greensboro to pick up the banners.
