- Entering locate requests prior to even having permits to do the work.
- Updating tickets long after work has been completed. *Big area Cabarrus right now

Eastern NC

• Please make sure you have all approvals, including DOT encroachments, municipal permits, State approvals before you submit your locate request.

Piedmont Triad Area

- We still have callers/folks (like other liaisons) in my area calling in tickets for locate before all permits (state, county & municipalities) have been issued.
- There are still too many updates on tickets that DON'T need to be updated.






County Ticket Volume

Distribution







 - **ALWAYS!** If you hit an underground objective, and you think it is a **Gas Line**, do the following in this order:

- Call 911 to report the accident!
- Call the Gas Company and let them know the specifics concerning the damage!
- Call 811 to report the accident to our office!

- <u>John Leger Town of Rutherford College:</u> Installing a lot of taps. He is not getting notifications of underground work being done in the lake development.
- Kevin Clark Brentwood Water Corp.: Installing quite a few taps. Currently able to work with newer employees locating taps, cleaning out taps and doing valve exercises. Materials and supplies are more readily available now than they have been in previous months.
- Jim Buckner & Rodney Roland Rutherford Electric Membership

 Association (REMC): Still hard to get supplies and materials. Still doing a lot of pole replacements. This is an ongoing project that is going to take several more months.
